### History vs. Beloit

The Nuts are 78-73 all-time vs. the Sky Carp, 36-39 in Lansing and 42-34 in Wisconsin. The Lugnuts did not play Beloit in either 2021 or 2023, going 2-10 vs. the Sky Carp in 2022.

In 2003, the Lugnuts met up with Beloit in the Midwest League Championship Series, sweeping the series in three games. It's the Nuts' most recent of their two titles.

**Tonight:** The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the second game in a six-game series with the Beloit Sky Carp, High-A affiliate of the Miami Marlins. These are the only meetings between the teams this season. Lansing is coming off losing four of six games at home against Cedar Rapids, while Beloit is coming off winning three of five games at Quad Cities. Following tonight, only one game remains in the first half of the 2024 Midwest League season.

**Last Night: Sky Carp 7, Lugnuts 4.** Henry Bolte and Will Simpson homered to wipe out early 2-0 and 3-1 deficits, but the Sky Carp broke a 3-3 tie with two runs in the 7th and two more in the 8th off Blaze Pontes to capture the series opener. Beloit second baseman Josh Zamora finished 4-for-5 with three singles and a two-run homer, scoring three runs to lead the winning effort.

**On the Air:** Today's game is on MiLB TV and Bally Live, with – hopefully – a Lugnuts audio stream via StreamGuys, Adam Jakska on the call? Good luck!

**On Deck:** The Nuts play the Sky Carp through Sunday before returning home for a nine straight days at Jackson Field vs. West Michigan and Fort Wayne.

### LUG NOTES

**Team Effort:** The Nuts' offense ranks 1st in the Midwest League in runs scored (349), base hits (562), total bases (881), doubles (116), triples (28), RBIs (321), slugging percentage (.411) and OPS (.764), and is tied for 1st in batting average (.262) and on-base percentage (.353). The Lugnuts' base hits, total bases and triples also all rank 1st in all of the High-A level.

**Encore Performance:** Tonight marks the first appearances on the mound for Grant Judkins and Jake Garland since the pitching tandem combined on a no-hitter on June 13 vs. Cedar Rapids, finished off by closer Colton Johnson (1 1/3 innings). It was the 4th no-hitter in franchise history and the first no-hitter in Lansing since April 21, 2003, a 15-0 rout of Dayton in which Donnie Hood hit for the cycle, the first time ever a team had thrown a no-hitter and hit for the cycle in the same game.

**Streiking:** OF Cam Masterman went 1-for-4 with an infield single yesterday; he has now hit safely in eight straight games.

**The Athletics Connection:** Which current Major Leaguer suited up for both Beloit and Lansing on his way up the ladder? The answer is Max Schuemann, who played for the Snappers in 2019 and the Lugnuts in 2021 and is now a member of the Oakland Athletics. Schuemann was one of 17 Beloit Snappers from 2019 to go on to play for Lansing when the A's reaffiliated with the Nuts in 2021. Three years later, he made his Major League debut. (If coaches were included in the question: pitching coach Don Schulze, who pitched in the Major Leagues between 1983 and 1989, was the Beloit pitching coach in 2018 and 2019 and has served as the Lugnuts' pitching coach from 2021-present.)

**Prospecting:** Lansing has five MLB Pipeline Top 30 Athletics prospects: pitcher Luis Morales (No. 2), outfielder Henry Bolte (No. 10), first baseman Will Simpson (No. 24), southpaw Will Johnston (No. 27) and outfielder Bryan Buelvas (No. 29).

**Nothing but Goose Eggs:** 2022-23 Lugnuts pitcher Grant Holman has pitched 26 1/3 scoreless innings between Double-A and Triple-A this season, 19 1/3 with Midland and 7 innings with Las Vegas, the most scoreless innings for any MiLB pitcher. Holman tossed another scoreless frame last night, fanning two batters.

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2011:** The Lugnuts owned the Eastern Division for the majority of the first half... but late struggles dropped the team into third place. On the final day of the first half, Lansing needed both a win at Dayton and a Great Lakes loss to Fort Wayne in order to make the playoffs. Jake Marisnick set the tone immediately at Fifth Third Field, leading off the game with a home run, and Drew Hutchison extended his shutout streak to 27 innings with six scoreless frames in a dominant 8-2 victory. Meanwhile, the TinCaps upset the Loons, vaulting the Lugnuts into the playoffs.

**2018:** The Lugnuts hosted their fourth Midwest League All-Star Game, drawing 9,396. In the pre-game Home Run Derby, Bowling Green Hot Rods catcher Ronaldo Hernandez put on an impressive power display to capture the title. Then the Eastern Division beat the West, 3-2, in ten innings, thanks to a two-out game-winning RBI single from Dayton Dragons first baseman Montrell Marshall, driving in teammate Stuart Fairchild from second base.

**Last Outing: History:** On June 13, relieved Jake Garland beginning in the 6th inning and tossed 2 2/3 hitless innings, walking one and striking out three, as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 no-hitter of the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the 4th no-hitter in franchise history and the first home no-hitter since 2003.

**Family of Athletes:** Father, Rob, played college baseball at Central College of Iowa, located in his hometown of Pella, as did both of his brothers, Jordan and Blake; his mother, Shannon, played golf in college.

**At Pella High School:** 2016 Iowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-Iowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... in his high school career, won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

**Onward to Des Moines:** Entered the Big Ten ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player in 2017, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten... No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)... No. 2 starter in 2020 before season was halted early due to the pandemic: 2-0, 3.00, 4 GS, 21 IP, 24 K, 5 BB... signed with the Athletics following the shortened five-round draft.

**International Stage:** With Iowa, took part in the 2017 World University Games in Taipei City, winning a silver medal (fell to Japan in the gold medal contest)... part of the first American team to ever advance to the gold medal game as well as the first American team to ever medal, period... team finished 5-2, losing only to Japan... started five games, four at first base, one at pitcher.

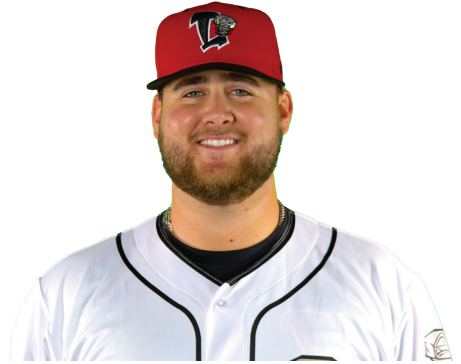

**Hometown Hero:** Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands thus all root for Boston-area teams.

**Jupiter?** How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

**The Bandit Connection:** Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

**The U:** Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

**Path to Lansing:** After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings... opened 2023 pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of **California League Pitcher of the Week** with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... dominated in Lugnuts debut May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win.
