SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels blanked the Baysox, 8-0. Richmond starting pitcher Jake Dahlberg worked six innings, Soloman Bates navigated the seventh and eighth innings and R.J. Dabovich pitched the ninth to complete the shutout. The Flying Squirrels took a 1-0 lead in the bottom of the first with a solo home run by Sean Roby, his seventh of the year. Will Wilson added a three-run home run in the fifth to open a 4-0 lead. In the eighth, Brandon Martorano hit a three-run double and later scored on an RBI single by Tyler Fitzgerald. It was the first shutout win of the year for the Flying Squirrels.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Today marks the Flying Squirrels' third night game in the last nine games since last Sunday's series finale at The Diamond against the Curve. The Flying Squirrels and Baysox met for a three-game set in Bowie to open the season from April 8-10, with Richmond picking up two wins. After this week's six-game series, the two teams will meet for three more games in Richmond from July 22-24. The Flying Squirrels travel to Bowie for a six-game set from June 28-July 3 and again from September 6-11.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won three of the last five games. Last week, they dropped four of six in their road set at Erie. It was the first series loss of the year for the Flying Squirrels. They opened the season taking two in a three-game series at Bowie from April 8-10 before winning four games in a six-game set against Altoona in their first homestand from April 12-17. The Flying Squirrels have the most offensive strikeouts in the league (184) and are tied for first in home runs (23).

THE BAYSOX have lost three straight after winning their previous four games in last week's home series against the Akron RubberDucks. After dropping two of three against the Flying Squirrels at home to begin the season, the Baysox won three of five at Binghamton from April 12-17, with one game postponed until June. Bowie's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including Gunnar Henderson (3), Jordan Westburg (6), Joseph Ortiz (15), Hudson Haskin (16), Drew Rom (17) and Adam Hall (28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Kai-Wei Teng makes his fourth start of the season and his second against the Baysox. He last pitch in the second game of the double-header on Thursday at Erie and allowed a season-high three runs in a season-low 4.1 innings of work while issuing a career-high five walks. He faced the Baysox in Bowie on April 9 and struck out six over five scoreless innings, allowing two hits, in his Double-A debut. Teng spent the entire 2021 season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, going 5-6 with a 4.33 ERA in 21 starts. For the season, Teng led the High-A West with 142 strikeouts, ranked tied for second with 21 games started, tied for first with one complete game and sixth with 95.2 innings pitched. He also ranked fourth in the Giants system in strikeouts. Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins out of Taiwan in 2017. During his second season in 2018, he was traded to the Giants along with outfielder Jaylin Davis in exchange for right-handed pitcher Sam Dyson. For more on Teng, see page two.

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Ryan Watson makes his first start of the season and his third overall appearance. He made his Double-A debut out of the bullpen on April 13 at Binghamton and worked four perfect innings with seven strikeouts. He followed with another perfect four-inning outing in his home debut last Wednesday against Akron and struck out three. For the season, Watson has not allowed a baserunner in eight innings and has struck out 10. In his professional debut season last year, Watson made 11 appearances for Low-A Delmarva, including three starts, and went 3-1 with a 2.14 ERA. He was promoted to High-A Aberdeen on July 20 and went 3-2 with a 4.94 ERA in 11 appearances, including one start. Watson was signed as a non-drafted free agent in 2020 by the Orioles. A native of Auburn, Ala., Watson attended his hometown school at Auburn University and helped the Tigers reach the College World Series for the first time in 18 years in 2019.

SCORELESS STARTS: Flying Squirrels starting pitchers have held the Baysox scoreless in three of the four meetings between the two teams this season. In those four games, Richmond starters have a 1.93 ERA (4 ER/18.2 IP). On April 8, Jake Dahlberg tossed 4.1 scoreless innings to open the season at Prince George's Stadium. Kai-Wei Teng followed on April 9 by working five scoreless frames. In the final of the season-opening series, Bryan Brickhouse allowed four runs in 3.1 innings. Dahlberg started the opener of the current series and pitched six scoreless innings in a combined shutout. Richmond starters overall have a 3.60 ERA (28 ER/70.0 IP)

LOOKING FOR HITS: The Flying Squirrels have been held to 15 hits over the last three games since Saturday, hitting .170 (15-for-88) with 31 strikeouts. Over the first 13 games of the year from April 8-22, Richmond hit .250 (106-for-424), which was third in the league, and led the circuit with 21 homers. After being held without a homer on Saturday and Sunday, the Flying Squirrels went deep twice in Tuesday's game.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 23 home runs this season, which is tied for first in the Eastern League and second in all of Double-A. After hitting three homers in the season-opening series at Bowie from April 8-10, the Flying Squirrels hit 12 home runs over six games in their first homestand against Altoona last week. They added four homers in the two games of last Thursday's double-header in Erie and went deep twice last Friday night. After being held without a homer on Saturday and Sunday, the Flying Squirrels hit two on Tuesday in the opener against the Baysox. On April 13 against the Curve, the Flying Squirrels set the franchise record for homers in an inning with four in the fourth, and set a team record with five homers in the game. **Sean Roby** is leading the league with seven homers on the season, with six coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 198 home runs.

ROBUST: Sean Roby leads the Eastern League with seven home runs on the season. He is one homer away from matching the Flying Squirrels' franchise record for most home runs in a calendar month, which is eight by Jarrett Parker in May 2013. Six of his home runs have come at The Diamond, including five in the first home series of the season against Altoona from April 12-17. Roby hit a homer in the series opener against the Baysox on Tuesday. Through just six home games played, Roby is tied for the 12th-most home runs hit at The Diamond in a season by a Flying Squirrels player. He is tied for the team leader in homers at home from 2012, 2015 and 2017 and has more homers than team leaders in 2010 (3) and 2019 (4). His seven total home runs on the season are tied for the sixth-most in all of Minor League Baseball. Roby also has the fifth-highest home-run-to-fly-ball rate (HR/RB) in all of MiLB at 63.6 percent.

SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny is batting .346 (9-for-26) with a double, a homer and five RBIs in his 11 games played this season. On Friday, he reached base four times, picking up a double and two walks. On Saturday, Matheny came off the bench to drove a go-ahead, two-run single, breaking a scoreless tie in the top of the seventh inning in the Flying Squirrels' 2-1 win at Erie. He worked a walk in his first plate appearance on Sunday, marking the sixth consecutive plate appearance he had reached base. He has walked nine times this year, totaling a .514 on-base percentage and a 1.014 OPS.

HEATING UP: After hitting .071 (1-for-14) in his first five games, **Franklin Labour** is batting .276 (8-for-29) in his last nine games since April 14. Last Thursday night, he picked up his first Double-A homer, driving a go-ahead, three-run home run to break a 3-3 tie in the top of the seventh in the second game of the double-header at Erie.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Sean Roby is first in the Eastern League in homers (7), tied for second in RBIs (13), third in SLG (.745), third in OPS (1.142) and tied for second in total bases (35). Ryan Walker is tied for first in wins (3). Jake Dahlberg is tied for third in strikeouts (24) and second in innings pitched (20.1).

THE DENNIS PELFREY ERA: On March 3, Dennis Pelfrey was named the new manager for the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Last year in his first season as a manager in affiliated baseball, he led the Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship. Pelfrey, 44, played six professional seasons in independent baseball from 1999-2004. He began his coaching career at South Grand Prairie High School in Texas in 2006, a position he held through 2015. He continued that role as he began his professional coaching career in 2011 with the Gary SouthShore RailCats, where he spent four seasons. Pelfrey landed his first managerial job in 2015 with the Florence Freedom of the independent Frontier League, a role he held for five seasons through 2019. He was hired by the Giants entering the 2020 season to manage High-A San Jose before the season was canceled due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic. Under his direction last year, the Emeralds went 69-50 before topping Spokane in the High-A West Championship Series.

REWRITING THE RULES: New experimental rules are in effect during the Flying Squirrels' season. With runners on base, pitchers will risk automatic baserunner advancement if a third pick-off attempt or step-off within the same plate appearance is made without recording an out. The size of the bases has increased from 15 inches square to 18 inches square in an attempt to reduce injuries. Defensively, teams must have a minimum of four players on the infield and two infielders complete on either side of second base.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have seven players ranked in Baseball America's Top-40 Giants prospects, including Will Wilson (14), R.J. Dabovich (17), Tristan Beck (30), Tyler Fitzgerald (34), Diego Rincones (36) and Kai-Wei Teng (40). Franklir Labour is rated by Baseball America as having the "Best Outfield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Dabovich (17), Wilson (22) and Brett Auerbach (28).
