NOTES AND NUGGETS

2ND HALF SLUGGERS

While Omaha has had a slow start to the 2nd half, a few hitters have had a hot start offensively to the back half of the season.

✦ **Carter Jensen** joined Omaha for the 2nd half and despite a slow start, he leads the club with 9 homers and 26 RBI since arriving, while 66 total bases are tied 1st ... 18 of his 29 hits have gone for extra-bases (8 doubles, 1 triple & 9 homers) ... his 19 walks lead the team, while batting .252 (29-for-115) with the Chasers.

✦ **MJ Melendez** is hitting .286 (36-for-126) in the 2nd half and leads the team with 11 doubles, tied for the team lead with 66 total bases ... he is 2nd with 37 hits and 3rd on the team with 18 RBI, 16 walks and 5 homers.

✦ **Harold Castro** is hitting .257 (37-for-144) since June 24 ... his 7 home runs and 19 RBI this half rank 2nd on the team while 61 total bases are 3rd.

WHAT A RELIEF

While Omaha's starting pitching has struggled at times in 2025, the bullpen has stepped up to help win games for the Storm Chasers.

✦ In August (13 games), Omaha's bullpen has pitched to a 4.30 ERA (28 ER in 58.2 IP), 6th in the 20-team International League ... the last two nights are the only times in August they have allowed more than 3 earned runs or 6 hits.

✦ Omaha's relievers have combined for a 4.79 ERA (280 ER in 526.1IP), while the starting pitchers have pitched to a 6.04 ERA (328 ER in 488.2 IP) ... the bullpen ranks 12th of 20 teams in the league in ERA while the starters rank last ... the relievers rank 5th in the league in K/BB (2.31) and tied 6th in K/9 (9.92).

✦ The bullpen has combined for 24 scoreless efforts, most recently 5.2 hitless innings in Wednesday's game, the relievers' longest hitless outing of the year.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

The Storm Chasers are not near the league lead in stolen bases, but Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

✦ Omaha has successfully stolen 141 bases this year, and only been caught 27 times ... 141 steals rank 6th in the International League and 10th in Triple-A.

✦ 141-for-168 in steal attempts is a 83.9% success rate, the 4th-best stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and tied 8th among the 120 full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 87.6%, 113-for-129).

NEVER GONNA GIVE YOU UP

Dallas Keuchel made his Storm Chasers debut July 12, becoming the latest player with significant Major League service time to appear in a game for Omaha in 2025.

✦ With 10 years and 30 days of MLB service, Keuchel is the 2nd most-experienced MLB pitcher to play for Omaha this year, trailing only **Rich Hill** (14 years, 141 days MLB service), who made 9 Omaha starts.

✦ Keuchel is the 11th player to appear in a game for the Chasers this year with 4 or more years of MLB service (through 2024) ... there have been 15 Storm Chasers players this year with 2 or more years of MLB service time.

✦ **Bobby Dalbec** is the 16th player to appear in a game for Omaha this year at the age of 30 or older ... by comparison, Omaha had 18 players in their 30's appear between the last two years (2023 & 2024).

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Omaha has played many close games this season ... with mixed success.

✦ Tuesday marked the Storm Chasers' 7th 1-run win this year, ... Omaha is 7-19 in 1-run games this year, with 7 wins in 1-run games tied for the fewest among full-season Minor League teams.

✦ Last Tuesday's extra-inning win in Indianapolis was Omaha's first 1-run win since June 10 @ Toledo, a 9-8 win over the Mud Hens ... the Storm Chasers had lost their previous 10 1-run games.

✦ This Tuesday was the team's 25th "comeback" win of the year, a win after trailing at some point in the game ... Last Tuesday was the 2nd time Omaha overcame multiple deficits to win, the 10th time winning while trailing for more than 2.0 innings.

DON'T STOP ME NOW

Last week, the Storm Chasers won their 4th series of the season, just the team's 2nd 6-game series win of the year ... they've also come up short a few times.

✦ Omaha took 3 of 5 from Norfolk in April, won all 6 at Toledo in June and won 2 of 3 at Buffalo in July ... last year, Omaha won 15 of 27 regular season series, including 11 6-game series.

✦ In addition to the 4 series wins, Omaha has 8 series splits this year ... of the 7 series splits that were 6-game series, the Storm Chasers have lost the final 2 games 3 times.

✦ Omaha has split both of its 6-game series with St. Paul this season ... last year, the Storm Chasers and Saints split the season series, with 9 wins each.
