FROM THE CROWS NEST

QUINTANA TOES THE RUBER: Right hander **Yulian Quintana** will make his third professional start today as the Marauders eye a bounce-back win over Daytona. Over five total outings with Bradenton, he has posted a 3.07 ERA over 11.1 innings of work. In the process he has fanned 21 hitters and walked nine. During his last outing in Palm Beach, Quintana struggled for the first time since joining Bradenton. He surrendered six runs (5 ER) over 3.1 innings while walking a career-high five batters. The right hander was promoted to Bradenton on July 26 from the Florida Complex League after posting a 1.53 ERA over 27.2 relief innings. He has allowed just five extra-base hits since his promotion and allowed five in the FCL (4 2B, 13B, 0 HR). He mixes in a sinker (91.9 mph), slider (83.1 mph) and curveball (80.6 mph). Single-A opponents are just 5-for-28 against his slider (.179) and have whiffed at a 50-percent clip against it.

POWER OUTAGE: Despite the Marauders overall power numbers in 2025, they have struggled to hit for extra bases in the month of August. Through 18 games, they're slashing .210/.312/.315 with ten home runs and 39 extra-base hits. This follows a prolific month at the plate where they launched the 20 homers, tying both Palm Beach and St. Lucie for the most longballs in the FSL and all of Class-A. Overall, their 92 longballs this season are the most in the Florida State League and second in Single-A (San Jose - California League, 92). 142 of their 523 total runs have been generated via the long ball (27.1%). They're 34-28 when leaving the yard at least once, and 20-34 when not homering at all. They've seen five players launch 9+ home runs this season, more than any other team in the FSL (**A. Plaz, Y. De Los Santos, K. Griffin, J. Severino, E. Florentino**).

WELCOME TO THE STRETCH RUN: As we approach the end of the second half, Bradenton is 24-26, currently 5.0 games behind the Threshers for the FSL West's final playoff spot (also up 1.5 games up on Dunedin). With 16 games to go, the Marauders are eyeing their first postseason appearance since 2021 when they won their second FSL title. After dropping the season series with Clearwater, the Threshers have the tie-break advantage if the two teams finish with even records at the end of the season. The Marauders currently lead their season series with Dunedin 8-7 and will face the Blue Jays at LECOM Park for six games to complete the regular season.

ELECTRIC EDWARD: Bradenton Marauders outfielder Edward Florentino was named Florida State League Player of the Month for his dominant performance in July. He remains the only Marauders player to be honored this season by Minor League Baseball. Over the 23-game stretch, Florentino slashed .301/.433/.663 with 16 stolen bases and 17 walks. His eight home runs and 23 RBI were the most of any player throughout the Florida State League and Single-A. Florentino was also one of three Single-A players, and the only in the FSL, to tally 15 or more walks and ten or more extra-base hits. Florentino is the Pirates No. 5 ranked prospect according to MLB Pipeline and was promoted to Single-A Bradenton on June 21.

TONY TATERS: Pirates No. 30 prospect (MLB Pipeline) **Tony Blanco Jr.** demolished his first two Single-A homers during the Marauders previous homestand. On July 30, he sent a fastball 415 feet to left field, that cleared the confines of LECOM Park. The ball left his bat at 118.9 miles per hour, marking the hardest-hit ball in Single-A at the time, clearing the next closest batted ball by 4.4 mph. Three nights later, he also demolished a walk-off three-run homer that left the bat at 119.8 mph - the hardest-batted ball in MiLB this season. Only three batted balls at the Major-League level have been hit harder this season. He joins Oneil Cruz (122.9 mph) and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (120.4 mph) on the list. Only him and Cruz (122.9 mph) have left the yard with such batted ball quality. He was activated and assigned to Single-A Bradenton on Saturday, July 19 at Jupiter.

BURNING THE BASE PATHS: **Yordany De Los Santos** stole his 48th and 49th stolen bases on Sunday afternoon, adding to a career-best mark (34 between FCL/Single-A in 2024). In the process, he's passed **Jesus Castillo** (39 - 2023), for the most single-season stolen bases by a Marauder in franchise history. He ranks first in the Florida State League and seventh in Single-A. Moreover, he sits only behind **Konnor Griffin** (59) for the most swipes in the Pittsburgh Pirates system. They are the ninth and tenth 40+ stolen-base seasons in Pirates-MiLB history. The two are approaching **Rich Thompson** for the most in a season by a Pirates minor leaguer since 2005 when he stole 58 that season between Double-A Altoona and Triple-A Indianapolis.

MARAUDERS ON THE MEND: In this year's draft the Pittsburgh Pirates selected RHP **Seth Hernandez** sixth overall in the first round of the 2025 MLB Draft and signed with the organization on Tuesday for 7.25 million dollars, the largest bonus ever for a prep pitcher. Hernandez was recently named 2025 Gatorade National High School Player of the Year and spent the 2025 season as a senior at Corona High School in California (0.39 ERA/53.1IP, 105 K). He was committed to Vanderbilt University. At 19 years old, he was touted as the best prep arm in the draft, and the No. 3 overall prospect in the draft class via MLB Pipeline. His fastball reached 100 miles per hour, paired with an esteemed changeup, curveball and slider.

- Returns to Bradenton in 2025 for his second season as manager of the club
- Sixth year in the Pirates organization
- Prior to 2024, Horner managed the Florida Complex League Pirates (FCL) in 2023, served as a Minor League Assistant Field Coordinator in 2022 and a bench coach for Bradenton in 2021.
- Previously served as hitting coach at Power 5 programs Texas Tech University and Washington State University.
- Last year's promotion marked his first opportunity to lead a full-season affiliate since 2015, when he managed the Jackson Generals, the then Double-A affiliate of the Seattle Mariners, capping a ten-year coaching career in their farm system.
