TODAY marks game #46 of the 2023 season, the first game of a six-game roadtrip, and the first game of a six-game series against the against the Dayton Dragons. These two teams played 24 times during the 2022 regular season, with the Whitecaps going 11-13. The Whitecaps are a Detroit Tigers affiliate in their 29th season in professional baseball, while Dayton is in their 23rd year of affiliation with the Cincinnati Reds.

UP NEXT: The 'Caps return home for a six-game series against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (Milwaukee Brewers) at LMCU Ballpark from June 6-11, kicking off playing three of their next four series in Comstock Park, with the exception being a six-game series at Lake County from June 13-18.

### STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

**LAST TIME OUT:** Solid pitching and late offense helped the West Michigan Whitecaps rally past the Lake County Captains 5-3, securing the series victory in front of 6,768 fans Sunday evening at LMCU Ballpark. Whitecaps pitching was exceptional with runners in scoring position, holding Lake County to a 1-for-13 mark as the offense rallied for two runs in the eighth inning to secure the series win. Lake County loaded the bases in the second inning but couldn't convert, as catcher Joe Donovan flew out to end the frame. West Michigan struck first in the third inning as Izaac Pacheco roped an RBI double, scoring Ryan Kreidler and jumping in front 1-0. 'Caps first baseman Chris Meyers extended the lead in the fifth inning, smoking a two-run single to go up 3-0. The Captains responded in the sixth as third baseman Dayan Frias blasted his first home run of the season - a three-run shot - tying the game at 3-3. Lake County put runners on second and third base with one out in the eighth but couldn't capitalize, as Whitecaps reliever Cristian Tortosa retired the final two batters to keep the game locked at 3-3. The Whitecaps responded swiftly, as Austin Murr added an RBI in the bottom half before Kreidler drew a bases-loaded walk to storm in front 5-3. The Captains failed to rally in the ninth, as West Michigan closer Erick Pinales retired the side in order, earning the save and the slim 5-3 victory. The Whitecaps improve to 26-19 and sit four games behind the Great Lakes Loons for first place in the Midwest League East division. The Captains fall to 22-23. Tortosa (2-3) tossed a scoreless inning with a strikeout, securing his second win of the year as Pinales collected his first save. Captains reliever Lenny Torres Jr. (0-1) suffered his first loss, allowing two runs through 0.2 innings. The Whitecaps registered two stolen bases in the victory - the first time they have done so in 2023.

**DON'T KRIED FOR ME, ARGENTINA:** The Whitecaps received infielder Ryan Kreidler on May 26 as part of a Minor League Rehab Assignment. The 25-year-old ranks as the Tigers No. 9 Prospect, according to Baseball America, and has played 37 games between the 2022 and 2023 season with the Detroit Tigers.

**JUSTICE BEING SERVED:** After going 13-for-20 in a series in Mid-May against the Lansing Lugnuts, Whitecaps OF Justice Bigbie collected his first-ever Midwest league Player of the Week award. Bigbie tallied four doubles, three home runs and nine RBI as the 'Caps took 4 out of 6 games with the 'Nuts from May 9-14 at LMCU Ballpark.

**ENTERING ELITE COMPANY:** With a 11-10 victory over the Great Lakes Loons on May 16, Whitecaps Manager Brayan Peña collected his 151st victory to pass former West Michigan and one-time Baltimore Orioles manager Phil Regan for 5th place on the all-time 'Caps wins list by a manager.

**DIFFERENT STRENGTHS:** The Whitecaps have stolen just 10 bases this season, the fewest in MiLB. The next closest team is Triple-A Reno with 21.

**BRINGING THE PENA:** On May 4, Whitecaps pitcher Carlos Pena was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Month for April. The 24-year-old pitched to a 0.47 ERA in five starts, covering 19.1 innings in the first month of the season, as he allowed one earned run and held opponents to a .200 average. Pena struck out 26 batters and was unscored upon in his first nine innings and his last nine innings of the month. Pena, 24, was signed by Detroit as an international free agent out of Santiago, DR, on March 6, 2019.

**HE HIT THE POLE!:** In a game against the Captains on May 23rd, the 'Caps hit home runs off each of the two foul poles - one by Josh Crouch and the other by Luis Garcia - at LMCU Ballpark. It is believed to be the first time in 'Caps history that West Michigan has accomplished the feat in a single game.

**PROSPECTS APLENTY:** The Whitecaps hold nine of the Top 30 Detroit Tigers prospects. Players include those mentioned near the top right corner of this page.

**HEALTH REPORT:** The 'Caps IL holds seven players in pitchers Jackson Jobe, Tanner Kohlhepp, Tyler Mattison and Matt Walker, infielder Carlos Mendoza, outfielder Justice Bigbie, and catcher Eduardo Valencia.

**LAST START:** *Pena posted a fairly mundane stat line in his appearance against the Lake County Captains on May 24 at LMCU Ballpark, allowing three runs (one earned) on five hits in five innings while striking out two as West Michigan lost by a score of 4-0.*
