GAME 102: After winning dropping their third game of the week last night in a rain-shortened five inning affair, the FredNats will go for the series split today in Lynchburg against the Hillcats. RHP Travis Sthele looks to continue the best stretch of his professional career on the mound today facing the Hillcats for the third time this season. Sthele is currently working on an 11-inning scoreless streak, and he's allowed just two total runs in his last four starts. In four starts in July, he went 3-0 with an 0.86 ERA. He faces Hillcat righty Jervis Alfaro, who is debuting in full-season professional baseball today with Lynchburg.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Alex Clemmey did not get out of the first inning in his Washington organizational debut, throwing 34 pitches in the first and allowing three runs on a hit and three walks. The game started an hour late due to weather and mismanagement of the radar by the Hillcats, and the rain hit again around 8:45 p.m. in the middle of the 5th inning. The Hillcats led 3-0 at the time, and we had just made it so that it could be an official game. Rafael Ramirez Jr. hit a triple for FXBG.

HE'S SOMETHING ELSE: Travis Sykora has proven to be one of the most dominant pitchers in the Washington organization since he joined the FredNats for his professional debut on May 1. He's tied for 8th in all of Minor League Baseball in strikeouts per nine innings (13.50), 11th in hits per nine (5.18), and tied for 11th in opponent average (.165). In his last five starts covering 22 innings, Sykora is 1-0 with a 1.64 ERA, the opponents are hitting just .110 against him, and he has 39 strikeouts against just nine walks.

DON'T LET HIM GET HOT: Elijah Green homered in the first two games of this series, and has an extra-base hit in four out of five games this week as well. Since July 1, Green is slashing .269/.372/.493/.865 and has posted a wRC+ of 150 (100 is league average), and a wOBA of .402 (.313 is league average). He also cut his strikeout rate by 9% from June, and his walk rate in July was 14%. Green also has five career home runs in Lynchburg's Bank of the James Stadium, three this year and two last year.

LEADOFF BRENNER: Friday night, Brenner Cox crushed the first pitch of the baseball game over the right field wall to get the FredNats off and running. It was Cox's sixth home run of the year, and the third time this season the FredNats have led off a road game with a home run. Among qualified hitters this year, Cox leads the team with a .715 OPS, and he's third on the team with 34 RBIs depsite missing a month with a thumb injury. Cox is also second on the team in outfield assists with 11.

CLUBHOUSE SWITCHER00: When the Nationals traded Lane Thomas to the Cleveland Guardians on Monday, the trade had repercussions in this series. Cleveland sent back Top-30 prospects Alex Clemmey and Rafael Ramirez Jr., both of whom were on Lynchburg's team prior to the trade. Both have switched clubhouses, and Ramirez Jr. will make his third straight start tonight, while Clemmey will make his Washington organizational debut tonight in a start. Ramirez has three hits in three games against his old team.

YO!: 2023 FredNat and top Washington infield prospect Yohandy Morales is off to a red-hot start in his first three rehab games with FXBG, homering twice and picking up five total hits. Morales broke his thumb in Harrisburg in late May and had not played since then. Last year's second round pick out of Miami, Morales played in 18 games for the FredNats after last year's draft, slashing .390/.448/.571 for an OPS of 1.019. Morales is currently ranked as Washington's 4th-best prospect.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 198-164 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

TODAY'S START: Travis Sthele makes his 16th start of the year this evening, against the Lynchburg Hillcats. A 12th round pick by the Nats in 2023, Sthele joined the FredNat rotation late in the 2023 campaign. Sthele has been mainly a starter, but has worked in the piggyback role twice this season.

A YEAR AGO: Sthele took his lumps after joining Fredericksburg last season. He posted a 7.36 ERA over four starts, to go along with a 1.82 WHIP. Travis struck out six hitters over 11.0 IP but showcased strong command, walking just three men.

TRENDING UP: After a rough start to the season, Sthele has made marked improvements as the summer goes along. In his last five starts covering 26.0 IP, Travis has allowed just three earned runs, which works out to a 1.04 ERA. He's struck out 21 men in that span, with opponents hitting .169 against him.

LAST TIME OUT: Sthele turned in five shutout innings against the Shorebirds in the series finale last week, striking out five and not walking a man in a no-decision.
