LAST NIGHT: The Amarillo Sod Poodles (1-4) defeated the Northwest Arkansas Naturals (3-2), 10-6, Wednesday night at Arvest Ballpark. Amarillo's offense was on fire early, scoring in each of their first three turns to bat. The Sod Poodles broke the game open in the top of the second inning as part of a six-run outburst highlighted by Gavin Logan's grand slam. In total, Amarillo combined for six extra-base hits, including Danny Serretti's first home run of the year and Junior Franco's two-run double in the seventh. Avery Short pitched with conviction in his first start of the season, allowing just one run over four innings pitched. Roman Angelo managed the bulk of the workload for the bullpen, earning his first win of the year after tossing three frames and giving up just one run. The Naturals slowly crawled back into the game in the late innings, but Amarillo emerged victorious with the 10-6 win.

THE LEFTORIUM: Despite facing a strict diet of southpaws for the first six innings of Wednesday's game, the five left-handed hitters in the Amarillo lineup batted .357 (5x14) and slugged .714 against them on Wednesday... entering the night, Amarillo lefties were hitting just .125 (3x24) in same-side matchups on the year.

ROMAN EMPIRE: Continuing to be effective out of the bullpen after his outing last night was Roman Angelo...despite making 23 starts for Amarillo last season, he has proven he can be a long man when he's on the mound...he was credited with Amarillo's first win of the year following a season where he posted an 0-8 record over his first 15 starts in 2025...he currently leads the Sod Poodles bullpen with 6.0 innings pitched after another three-inning outing last night...through the first two games, opponents are hitting just .105 (2x19) against him while posting a 0.83 WHIP.

BOTTOM FEEDERS: Over Amarillo's first five games of 2026, the 7-9 hitters in the order are batting a combined .340 (16x47), good for second in the Texas League, trailing only Springfield (.373)...the Soddies have seven extra-base hits, 11 RBI, and a 1.043 OPS from the 7-9 spots so far.

DOWN IN THE DESERT: Former Soddie LuJames Groover had a monster night at the plate as part of Triple-A Reno's 14-8 victory last night over Salt Lake (Los Angeles Angels)...he set a new career-best by driving in six runs as part of a three-hit night which included an his first career grand slam.

- Is only the eighth player in Presbyterian College's history to be drafted...Eagen's teammate at Presbyterian Joel Dragoo was drafted in the 7th round by the Phillies that same year, becoming the first players drafted out of Presbyterian since 2013 when the Diamondbacks selected Bud Jeter, a right-handed pitcher, in the 25th round.
- Over 35 games (27 starts) in his collegiate career, went 7-7 with a 5.02 ERA over 131.0 innings from 2022-24.
- Made 14 starts in 2024 as the Friday starter for the Blue Hose, setting a program record for strikeouts (122) to the tune of a 2.67 ERA...struck out a program record 14 batters on April 5, 2024 against Radford.
- Earned Big South Pitcher of the Year honors in 2024 as well as First Team All-Big South...Named Big South Pitcher of the Week six times in 2024.
- In high school, ranked as the 17th-best RHP in North Carolina (per Prep Baseball Report)...his 2020 high school team (Fuquay-Verona HS) ranked 10th in the nation.
