BULLPEN DAY, EVERY DAY: Through the first two series of the season, only four FredNat starts have lasted four innings or longer. Among the rotation, RHP Leuris Portorreal carries the most professional experience, and has pitched through the fourth inning all three of his starts, accounting for the two longest FredNat starting pitching performances this year. The longest outing overall was thrown by Thursday's starter Alexander Meckley, who tossed five innings out of the bullpen in game two of the year against Augusta on April 4.

ABOUT LAST WEEK: After rolling to a 5-1 start atop the Carolina League North, the FredNats hit a bump in the road to close their first road series at Hill City, dropping the final three games to fall just one game over the .500 mark. The FredNats have not led over their last two games, and only led for two innings in Friday's game at Hill City which started the slide. FredNat hitters struck out 79 times in the series at Hill City, and pitchers walked 29 batters during the final three games of the road trip.

A NEWFOUND RIVALRY: Affiliates of rival DMV ballclubs, the FredNats and Shorebirds have been Carolina League rivals since Minor League Baseball's restructuring brought Delmarva into the Carolina League in 2021. After dropping the first series against Delmarva last season, the FredNats bounced back to win the season series, ten games to eight. The FredNats' all time series with Delmarva includes the most win vs a single opponent in team history (18, 2024) and the most losses (25, 2021).

ABOUT LAST YEAR: The FredNats finished last season at 65-64 overall under Manager Billy McMillon, following the championship in 2024 by winning the North division's second half title to advance to the playoffs for the second straight year. The FredNats season concluded with a two games to none loss to eventual Carolina League Champion Lynchburg in the Division Series.

RIBBIT RIBBIT: The FredNats will debut their Fredericksburg Frogs jerseys this series, wearing them for Wednesday and Friday's games. The jerseys page homage to an African-American team of the same name which competed in Fredericksburg under the same name. The team, competing from 1919 to the mid-1940s, was one of the nation's most amateur teams, but little is still known about them today.

UP TO OUR ARMPITS IN PROSPECTS: The Fredericksburg Opening Day roster is loaded with some of the top talent in the revamped Nationals organization, headlined by Washington's top prospect Eli Willits, the No. 1 overall pick in the 2025 MLB Draft. Willits is ranked as baseball's 9th-best prospect overall by MLB Pipeline. Overall, the FredNat roster has seven prospects ranked in MLB Pipeline's top 20 Nationals prospects.

MACKENZIE'S GONE: The FredNats opening day roster includes two of the five prospects dealt back to Washington from Texas as part of the trade for Nats' top end arm MacKenzie Gore. Last year's 12th overall pick Gavin Fien debuts as the fifth-best prospect in the Nationals organization, and is joined by former Rangers prospect Jeremy Cabrera (Nats No. 20) in the haul back from Texas. Both players bring Carolina League experience to FXBG after finishing last year with the Hickory Crawdads.

THE STAFF: Manager Chris O'Neill leads a coaching staff of seven newcomers to the Washington organization, and the average age of the coaching staff is 28.

WE ARE GETTING YOUNGER: The new staff in Fredericksburg follows a trend of young brainchildren charged with working in the Nationals organization this year, with other notable hires within the organization including President of Baseball Operations Paul Toboni (currently the youngest lead executive in MLB), General Manager Anirudh "Ani" Kilambi (aged 31), and Major League Manager Blake Butera (the youngest manager in MLB since 1972 at 33 years old).

FREDNATS BASEBALL NETWORK IS BACK: Once again, all 132 FredNat games this season will be broadcast live on the FredNats Baseball Network, with Luke West Poley beginning his first season as the lead voice of the team. Home games are broadcast on MiLB.tv and the Bally Sports Live App to go along with the audio-only stream at frednats.com/broadcast or the MiLB App. For road games, the radio broadcast is available at the same link. In addition, all FredNats games preceded by a 20 minute pregame show and postgame coverage following each night of action.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Potomac Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers and winning the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium. The franchise has appeared in the Carolina League playoffs in three out of the last four seasons.

Chris O'Neill - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Hitting Coach/Recruiting Coordinator, Virginia Commonwealth University

O'Neill, 36, joins the Nationals organization after two seasons (2024-25) as a hitting coach/recruiting coordinator at Virginia Commonwealth University. Prior to that, he served as an assistant coach and assistant recruiting coordinator at George Washington from 2022-24.

O'Neill is credited with helping fuel major offensive surges at both VCU and George Washington, as both schools set offensive records and contended for Atlantic 10 championships under his watch. O'Neill spent the 2021 season as the director of operations at Duke University and prior to that, he served as an assistant coach at Bucknell University (2020), Marshall University (2018-19) and the University of Maryland-Eastern Shore (2017).

This season will be O'Neill's first time managing since he led the Grand Lake Mariners (Great Lakes Summer Collegiate League) in the summers of 2016 and 2017. A Pennsylvania native, he received his Bachelor's degree in Education from King's College in 2012. O'Neill and his wife Kate have two boys, Easton and Callum.



Luke Dziados - PITCHING COACH

1st Season | Previously: Pitching Trainer - Driveline Baseball (Tampa, Fla.)

Dziados (D-Zay-Dis), 27, comes to the Nationals organization after spending the last two years as a pitching trainer at Driveline Baseball in Tampa, Fla. He capped his college pitching career at Villanova University in 2023 after pitching at Binghamton University from 2018-20. Dziados earned his Bachelor's degree from Binghamton in 2021 and also earned a Graduate Certificate in Leadership from Villanova in 2023.



Jake Scheiner - HITTING COACH

Scheiner, 30, played seven seasons (2017-23) in the Phillies and Mariners organizations. He appeared in 658 Minor League games before signing in 2024 with Hiroshima Toyo Carp of Nippon Professional Baseball in Japan. A native of San Mateo, Calif., Scheiner was drafted in the fourth round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Phillies out of the University of Houston.



Luis Villanueva - ASSISTANT PITCHING COACH

Villanueva, 24, was a performance coach at LAVR Performance where he designed and led throwing programs to improve overall pitching performance for more than 50 athletes prior to joining Washington's coaching ranks. Villanueva attended and played baseball for both Kansas Wesleyan University and MidAmerica Nazarene University.



Anthony Ray - DEFENSIVE COACH

Ray, 30, joins Washington after spending the 2025 season as a hitting and outfield coach with the Rocky Mountain Vibes of the independent Pioneer League.
