INTERNATIONAL LEAGUE INFORMATION

On February 12, 2021, Major League Baseball announced its new plan for affiliated baseball, with 120 Minor League clubs officially agreeing to join the new Professional Development League (PDL).

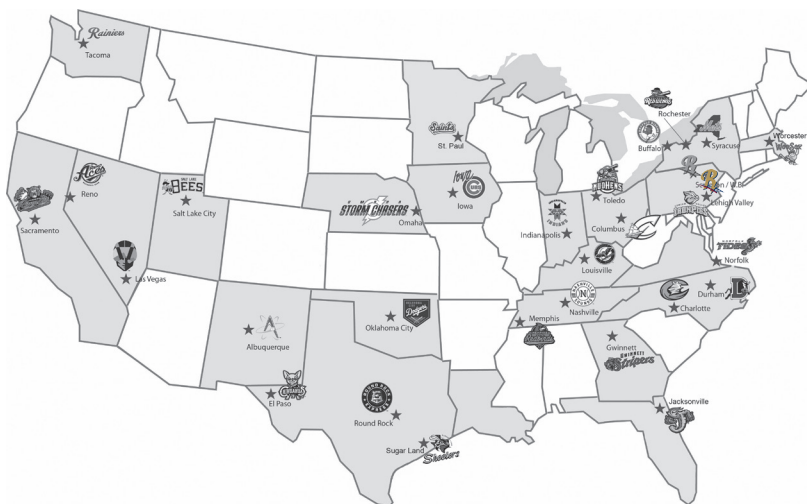
In total, the new player development system includes 179 teams across 17 leagues in 43 states and four provinces. Including the AZL and GCL, there are 209 teams across 19 leagues in 44 states and four provinces. That includes the 150 teams in the PDL and AZL/GCL along with the four partner leagues: the American Association, Atlantic League, Frontier League and Pioneer League.

The long-standing league names return this season after 2021 was played under directional monickers. The International League (formerly Triple-A East) consists of 20 teams; all 14 from the old iteration of the IL, plus teams moving from the old Pacific Coast League, the Southern League and the independent Atlantic League. The Pacific Coast League (Triple-A West in 2021) is comprised of nine former Pacific Coast League teams and one addition from the Atlantic League.

These changes were made to help reduce travel and allow Major League teams to have their affiliates, in most cases, within 200 miles of the parent club (or play at their Spring Training facilities).

DID YOU KNOW?

The original Buffalo Bisons (1877-1970) once played at Offermann Stadium from 1924 to 1960, located just three miles north of their current home at Sahlen Field. Offermann Stadium also served as the home for the Indianapolis Clowns of the Negro American League from 1951 to 1955. The Clowns were the first professional men's baseball team to sign women players long term: Tonie Stone, Mamie "Peanut" Johnson and Connie Morgan, who all played at Offermann Stadium.
