- The Blue Jays wrapped up their 12-game road trip with a 12-7 victory over Clearwater on Sunday at BayCare Ballpark.
- After Eduardo Tait belted a game-tying, two-run homer in the bottom of the eighth to tie the game, the Jays scored five runs in the top of the ninth inning, highlighted by an Eddie Micheletti grand slam.
- Micheletti finished the contest 3-4, reaching base in his final five plate appearances.
- With the win, Dunedin finishes the season 8-1 at BayCare Ballpark.

ROAD WARRIORS

The Blue Jays finished their 12 game road trip (at Bradenton, at Clearwater) with a 9-3 record, taking the series at Clearwater five games to one. Dunedin hit .248 with a .754 OPS as a team on the trip (both second-best in the league during that span), averaging 6.3 runs per game.

BACK ON THE HOMESTEAD

Dunedin returns to TD Ballpark for their final homestand of the season this week. The Blue Jays have struggled on their home turf lately, going 3-9 across their last two home series.

GAINING GROUND

With 13 games remaining, the Blue Jays sit 5 games out of a playoff spot (and one game behind second place Lakeland). The Blue Jays have no head-to-head matchups remaining with Fort Myers.

STAYING UP LATE

Across six games last week at Clearwater, the Blue Jays scored 23 runs in the seventh inning or later, including six runs on Sunday to win the game.

THE BIG INNING

The Blue Jays used big innings to propel themselves to a series win last week in Clearwater. In the six game series, Dunedin scored four or more runs in an inning in five frames - including two five-run innings in Sunday's win.

ABOVE AVERAGE IN AUGUST

Dunedin's offense has proved to be the cream of the crop in the Florida State League in August. The Blue Jays .252 average, .755 OPS, .369 OBP, 17 HRs and 121 runs scored all lead the circuit this month.

ARJUN'S AWESOME AUGUST

Toronto's No. 5 prospect Arjun Nimmala has been a driving force in Dunedin's successful month. In 17 games in August, Nimmala is hitting .313 with a .928 OPS and 12 extra base hits. Of Nimmala's 14 home runs in Single-A this season, 11 have come in the second half

DURAN, DURAN

Edward Duran's 4-5 performance on Friday night marked a new season high in hits for the Jays backstop. Duran has had a strong month of August, hitting .300 in 13 games, boosting his second-half average to .287 - the highest mark on the team among players with at least 16 games played.

FIVE INNING FUN

Gilberto Batista became just the second D-Jay starting pitcher to pitch five innings or more this month with five shutout frames on Friday, joining Daniel Guerra. The average Dunedin start has lasted just 3.1 innings in August (67.1 IP in 21 games).

REHAB CITY, USA

With Adam Macko's start last night, Dunedin has hosted a whopping 25 MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. Other notable rehabs include top prospect Ricky Tiedemann, Joey Votto, Alek Manoah, Damiano Palmegiani, and Riley Tirotta.

TOOLED UP

Baseball America released its annual MiLB Best Tools lists this month, voted on by league managers across Minor League Baseball. Three Blue Jays earned recognition from Florida State League skippers: Christian Feliz was named best power prospect in the FSL, Fernando Perez was picked to have the best command, and Jose Mayorga was named the best managerial prospect.
