AMAZIN' STARTS HERE BROOKLYN CYCLONES (0-2, 33-35) vs. Jersey Shore Blueclaws (2-0, 40-28)

LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones fell short at the hands of the BlueClaws, 8-0, on Saturday evening...Brooklyn mustered just one hit, an infield single off the bat 1B **Mateo Gil** in the seventh inning...RHP **George Klassen** was stellar for Jersey Shore, hurling five no-hit shutout innings, while striking out eight and walking two...RHP **Dakota Hawkins** was tagged with the loss for the Cyclones, allowing six runs, all earned, over 4.1 innings of work...The loss marked the first time this season the Cyclones have lost a series at home...Brooklyn previously had not lost a home series dating back to August of 2023 against Hudson Valley, when the Renegades took four of six spanning from August 15-20.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On June 23, 2001, due to the success of early ticket sales in the Cyclones' inaugural season, bleachers were added to then-Keyspan Park...The additional 1,000 seats increased the ballpark's capacity to 7,500...On June 23, 2009, the Brooklyn Cyclones transformed into the "Baracklyn Cyclones", wearing specialty uniforms, to honor the 44th President of the United States...On June 23, 2023, C Kevin Parada blasted a pair of home runs — including an inside-the-parker — in Brooklyn's 6-1 win vs. Hudson Valley...RHP Blade Tidwell struck out nine over 6.0 innings for the win, while 3B William Lugo and LF Jaylen Palmer homered, as well.

NICK SQUARED: OF Nick Morabito and IF Nick Lorusso have been two of Brooklyn's biggest offensive contributors as of late...The duo each put together multi-hit games in Friday's loss to Jersey Shore...Lorusso is ninth in the circuit in OPS (.848), 10th in total bases (103), and tied for 10th in extra-base hits (25)...Lorusso is third among New York Mets' full-season minor leaguers slugging (.481), tied for third in triples (3) and extra-base hits (25), fourth in OPS (.848), and tied for fifth in home runs (9) and RBI (35)...Morabito is tied for ninth in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (32) and is tied for ninth in on-base percentage (.437)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is second in the league in steals (21), third in runs scored (29), and tied for 10th in hits (43)...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.327), on-base percentage (.437), and stolen bases (32)... He also tied for first in hits (74), third in OPS (.857) and runs scored (43), and fourth in walks (38).

o SAY, CONSUEGRA: OF Stanley Consuegra is in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season...The 23-year-old tallied a career-high-tying four hits in last Sunday's loss at Hudson Valley...Consuegra has accomplished the feat four times, most recently on April 13, 2023, at Winston-Salem...He is also the second Cyclone to reach that mark in 2024, joining CF Nick Morabito (5/28 @JS)...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, he's hitting .283/.394/.528 with a .922 OPS...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native has scored 14 runs and added eight doubles, six home runs, and 20 RBI... Consuegra has raised his batting average by 56 points (.171 to .227) and his OPS by 204 points (.519 to .723) during the stretch...Since that date, the right-handed slugger is tied for fourth in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (14) and doubles (8), tied for eighth in total bases (56) and 10th in slugging (.528)...On Wednesday, the veteran surpassed UTL Jaylen Palmer (204) for the most games played in franchise history (208)...Consuegra also set the Cyclones' all-time doubles record (40) on June 8 vs. Aberdeen and the all-time hits mark (185) on May 29 at Jersey Shore...He is also the franchise's all-time leader in extra-base hits (81), home runs (35), RBI (121), and outfield assists (19)...Consuegra also holds the single-season mark for home runs (23), and extra-base hits (42), and is tied with INF Ronny Mauricio (63) for single-season RBI.

SUERO SUAVE: C Chris Suero has started to find his rhythm offensively in the South Atlantic League...The 20-year-old capped the last home series vs. Aberdeen with his first career multi-home run game, blasting two-run shots in the fourth and sixth innings...In five games against the IronBirds, Suero was 7-for-16 (.438) at the dish with seven runs scored, a double, three home runs, and an eye-popping 11 RBI...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, Suero has reached safely in 24 of 25 games, hitting .267/.413/.419 with an .832 OPS...The Bronx native has scored a whopping 20 runs with a double, four home runs, 18 RBI, and 21 walks...Since that date, Suero is fourth in the SAL in walks (21) and 10th in on-base percentage (.413)...The third-year pro has also reached in 13-straight contests since June 6...Suero is hitting .289/.441/.511 with a .952 OPS in that span, accumulating 10 runs, a double, three home runs, 13 RBI, and 13 walks to 14 strikeouts.

JUNIOR MINTS: INF Junior Tilien saw his 26 game on-base streak come to an end in Saturday's loss to Jersey Shore...The streak is tied for the third-longest of the year in the South Atlantic League...Only Rome INF Sabin Ceballos (27) and Greenville's INF Kristian Campbell (34) put together longer streaks...The 21-year-old accumulated a .268/.357/.402 slash line with a .759 OPS during the streak, adding five doubles, a triple, two home runs, 13 RBI, and 14 walks...The infielder is the first Cyclone to

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn returns home for a six-game series, including the final three games of the season's first half, against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...Jersey Shore boasts seven of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: INF Aidan Miller (2), OF Justin Crawford (4), INF William Bergolla (11), OF Emaarion Boyd (16), OF Hendry Mendez (22), LHP Sam Aldegheri (23), RHP George Klassen (28)... The Cyclones split both series played in 2024 at Shore Town Ballpark, going 6-6 in 12 contests...Brooklyn does not return to Jersey Shore in the 2024 regular season, hosting the final 15 meetings...In 2023, Brooklyn dropped the season series to the Jersey Shore, 15-11...The Cyclones were 11-6 in Lakewood and 4-5 on Coney Island...Dating back to 2021, Brooklyn leads the all-time series, 53-47 (.530).

record an on-base streak of 20 or more games since INF **José Peroza** reached in 31-consecutive games from July 29 until September 2, 2022... Tillen also posted a 10-game hitting streak from May 26 until June 9...He slashed .375/.409/.550 with a .959 OPS in that time.

OH, HENRY!: The Cyclones added RHP Henry Henry from Single-A St. Lucie on Tuesday...The 25-year-old made his Brooklyn debut on June 19th vs. Jersey Shore, tossing one scoreless inning of relief work where he accumulated two strikeouts and allowed one hit...Signed by New York as a minor league free agent on May 16, the San Cristóbal, D.R. native spent the first eight seasons of his professional career in the San Diego Padres...Between High-A Fort Wayne and Double-A San Antonio, Henry was 3-4 with a 5.19 ERA (29 ER in 50.1 IP) with 35 walks and 37 strikeouts in 34 appearances (three starts) in 2023...Henry Henry is not to be confused with former Pittsburgh Pirates infield prospect Henry Henry or the Cyclones' legendary on-field emoee King Henry.

WALK THIS WAY: INF William Lugo has had a keen eye at the plate in 2024, drawing 48 walks...That number ranks second in the South Atlantic League, while his 19.7% walk rate is first...Among minor leaguers with 240 or more plate appearances, Lugo sits fourth in walk rate...Lugo's former Cyclone teammate and Double-A Binghamton's IF/OF Ryan Clifford checks in at second in Minor League Baseball (21.9%), behind only Norfolk INF and Major League Baseball's top prospect INF Jackson Holliday (22.0%).

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: RHPs Dakota Hawkins (5.0 IP), Joey Lancellotti (1.0), and Joshua Cornielly (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history June 4's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP Brandon Moore tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...It is one of four no-hitters in Minor League Baseball in 2024...The effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP Joander Suárez hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford...It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP Sal Maglie tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 61 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-3 record with a 2.35 ERA (26 ER in 99.2 IP) and 7 saves, walking just 24 and striking out 88.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his first loss of the season on May 31 at Jersey Shore...Surrendered a season-high-tying three runs (two earned) on four hits over 2.1 innings...Walked one and struck out one... Tossed 41 pitches and 26 strikes (63.41%)...Relieved by RHP **Victor Castañeda** with runners at second and third and one out in the bottom of the third inning and Brooklyn trailing 3-0...The two bequeathed runners did not score...The BlueClaws went on to defeat the Cyclones, 7-2.

WELCOME BACK: Orellana was reinstated off the Cyclones' 7-day injured list on Sunday afternoon...The 22-year-old was placed on the IL back on June 6.

DOU NOT ENTER: Orellana enters the day with a stellar 1.49 ERA (6 ER in 36.1 IP)...Among South Atlantic League pitchers at least with 36.0 innings of work, Orellana leads the circuit in ERA (1.49)...Rome's RHP **Owen Murphy** (1.54) is second...His .554 opposing OPS and .191 batting average against are also sixth and ninth in the SAL, respectively...Orellana's 1.49 ERA is the lowest at the High-A level and the 11th-best in Minor League Baseball among pitchers with 36.0+ innings on the hill.

DOUBLE-DIGIT DOUGLAS: Orellana set a personal and team season-high with 10 strikeouts on May 11 at Rome....It was the second double-digit strikeout game of Orellana's career...The Caraças, Venezuela native punched out a career-high 11 over four frames in Game 2 of a doubleheader for the Florida Complex League Mets on July 14, 2022...Orellana was the first Cyclone to strike out 10+ hitters in a single game since RHP **Robert Colina** punched out 10 in six innings in a win at Greenville on September 2, 2023.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS: Orellana had his season-high 12.0-inning scoreless streak come to a close on May 5 vs. Aberdeen...During the stretch, he surrendered just three hits and fours walk, adding 13 strikeouts...The 22-year-old started the season by tossing a bevvy of zeroes too...The right-hander did not allow a run over his first two appearances and 8.1 innings...Orellana yielded only four hits and three walks in that span, while striking out eight.

DOUGIE HOWSER: The Caraças, Venezuela native was untouchable out of the bullpen on April 24 vs. Wilmington...The 22-year-old retired all 15 batters he faced — striking out six — in five shutout innings of relief, earning the hold...Orellana became the first Cyclone since at least 2005 to throw five or more innings out of the bullpen without allowing a hit...RHP **Benito García** (8/12/23 vABD), RHP **Daison Acosta** (6/21/22 vJS), and RHP **Chris Schwinden** (6.0 IP; 7/18/08 @ONE) each posted 5.0+ innings, but allowed only one hit...Orellana is just the third Brooklyn pitcher in any capacity since 2005 to toss five or more innings without yielding a hit at all...However, the other two allowed a man to reach on a hit-by-pitch...LHP **Nelson Pereira** (5.0 IP) was the last to do it in a 2-1 win over 14 innings on August 15, 2010, at Williamsport.

2023: Orellana spent the entire 2023 season with current Brooklyn manager **Gilbert Gómez** and pitching coach **Dan McKinney** at Single-A St. Lucie...In his age 21 campaign, the right-hander made 23 appearances and 18 starts, tallying a 4-4 record and a 4.53 ERA (45 ER in 89.1 IP) with one save...Orellana issued 50 walks, but struck out 112 hitters...He finished fifth in the Florida State League in strikeouts and second on St. Lucie's roster behind LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** (114)...Orellana finished the season by being named the FSL's Pitcher of the Month for September...He permitted only two runs (one earned) on five hits in 10.2 innings, accruing two walks and 16 K's.



LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision on Tuesday night vs Jersey Shore...Tossed 4.1 innings and allowed two runs on three hits...Walked one and struck out four...Tossed a wild pitch...Threw 76 pitches and 47 strikes (61.84%)...Relieved by RHP **Jimmy Loper** with the bases empty and one ou in the top of the fifth inning with Brooklyn trailing 2-1...Cy-clones tied the game in the bottom of the fifth, but the BlueClaws scored two in the seventh and three in the ninth to win, 7-2.

PROSPECT RADAR: After a stellar 2023 season, De La Cruz was deemed the New York Mets' No. 39 prospect entering the 2024 campaign by Baseball America.

HOME COOKING: De La Cruz has been outstanding on Coney Island in 2024...Through his first six starts of the campaign, the southpaw is 1-2 with a 2.03 ERA (6 ER in 26.2 IP), 11 walks, and 35 strikeouts...De La Cruz has not seen the same level of success on the road...The 23-year-old holds a 2-3 mark in visiting parks, but yields a 6.35 ERA (16 ER in 22.2 IP), with 10 walks, and 24 strikeouts...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with at least 24.0 innings pitched at home, De La Cruz ranks seventh in ERA (2.03).

FELIP-IN' AMAZIN': The 23-year-old celebrated his birthday by shutting out Hudson Valley on May 25 over 6.0 innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts...De La Cruz was one shy of the single game Brooklyn franchise record of 14 set by LHP Mike Cox (8/25/01 vs. HV) and RHP Brad Holt (7/24/08 vs. VER)...He was the first Cyclone to strike out 13+ hitters in a single contest since RHP Rob Gsellman accomplished the feat on August 24, 2013, at Vermont...De La Cruz is the sixth Cyclones pitcher ever to hit the 13 punchout threshold sixth Cyclones pitcher ever to hit the 13 punchout threshold and the third to strikeout 13 or more in 6.0 or fewer innings.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: The 22-year-old joined the Cy clones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 trikeouts. strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all six innings in the lid-lifter of a doubleheader on August 31 at Greenville...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **José Butto** accomplished the feat, tossing six innings in a seven-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021... After making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz ranked third in the circuit in WHIP (0.94), fifth in batting average against (.183), and sixth in ERA (2.65).

FLORIDA STATE FELIPE: De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023... Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22-year-old led the circuit in strikeout rate (28.7%)...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.5%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.68)...In 21 appearances (19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz was 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.
