This Day in Baseball

2010 - On the third anniversary of his 500th home run, **Alex Rodriguez** hits the 600th homer of his career off Toronto's Shaun Marcum, becoming the youngest player - and only the seventh all time - to reach the milestone. The Yankees win, 5 - 1, and with Tampa Bay's 2 - 1 loss to Minnesota, regain a share of first place in the AL East.

2019 - TinCap pitchers **Joey Cantillo**, **Sam Keating** and **Jose Quezada** toss the 13th one-hitter in franchise history in a 8-0 win at Parkview Field against West Michigan. Cantillo led the charge, punching out 7 batters across 6.0 frames.

2024 - With a 13 - 7 loss to the Twins, the White Sox's losing streak reaches historic proportion at 20 games. It is a new franchise record and tied for third all-time, trailing only the 21 losses by the 1988 Baltimore Orioles to start that season, and the 23 consecutive losses by the 1961 Philadelphia Phillies.

APPLE SLICES

SWEET-SWINGING ALEX MCCOY: Minor League Baseball announced on Monday that TinCaps outfielder **Alex McCoy** is its Midwest League Player of the Week for July 28 to Aug. 2. Across five games, the No. 16 Padres prospect batted .421 (8-for-19)/.542/.947, ranking second in the league in slugging percentage (.947), OPS (1.489), runs (8), and home runs (3). McCoy finished tied for fourth in batting average (.421), on-base percentage (.542), and total bases (18), fifth in stolen bases (3), seventh in walks (5), eighth in hits (8), and 10th in RBI (6). McCoy is the first TinCap to win Player of the Week since MLB's No. 2 prospect **Leo De Vries** became the first-ever TinCap to win the award in back-to-back weeks from April 21 to May 4, 2025. The 24-year-old outfielder leads the Midwest League with 26 doubles this season, is tied for second in hits (94) and extra-base hits (42), and ranks third in total bases (167). He also leads the team in home runs (15) and RBI (53), as well as multi-hit (26) and multi-RBI (14) games. Earlier this season, McCoy earned Midwest League Player of the Month honors for April, becoming the sixth TinCap player to win the award since the Midwest League began issuing it in 2013. He joined De Vries, current Cleveland Guardians left-handed pitcher **Joey Cantillo** (June 2019), DH **Hudson Potts** (August 2017), C **Austin Allen** (April 2016), and OF **Nick Shultz** (August 2014).

ABOUT LAST WEEK: Fort Wayne is coming off a series at Dow Diamond against the Great Lakes Loons. The 'Caps took 4 of the first 5 games before the final contest on Sunday was suspended in the 5th inning due to rain. It's the first time this season that the 'Caps have won consecutive series, after they won 4 of 6 games at home two weeks ago against the Lake County Captains. The 'Caps have now won seven of their last eight games and are a game back of the top spot in the Eastern Division Second-Half Standings.

SO LONG, FRIEND: On Monday, the Padres traded TinCap left-hander **Kash Mayfield** to the Detroit Tigers as part of a deal that brought right-handed starter Casey Mize to the Padres. Mayfield posted a 3.54 ERA across 15 starts with the 'Caps this season to go with his 1.16 WHIP in 53 1/3 innings tossed. The Padres' 2024 first-round draft pick participated in the MLB Futures Game at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia on July 12. This marked the fifth-straight season an active TinCaps player has appeared in the Futures Game. Three of those five have been traded at the subsequent trade deadline (Rober Hassell III in 2022, Leo De Vries in 2025). Mayfield took home Midwest League Pitcher of the Week honors following his performance on May 15 against Cedar Rapids and was the 10th TinCap to win the award since the Midwest League moved to High-A in 2021.

OLD FRIENDS TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS: Former 2025 TinCap starters **Miguel Mendez** and **Luis Gutierrez** did not allow a run in their rehab outings with Fort Wayne last week. Mendez worked a 1-2-3 first frame on Tuesday, and Gutierrez worked a pair of hitless innings on Wednesday. Mendez made 12 starts and posted a 7-3 record with a 1.32 ERA across 61 1/3 innings. The former No. 4 Padres prospect took home Midwest League Pitcher of the Month honors in July, becoming the third TinCap ever to do so. On Monday, the Padres traded Mendez with 2022 TinCap Jackson Wolf in a deal for Robbie Ray. Gutierrez made 13 starts with Fort Wayne last season and posted a 3.74 ERA over 65.0 innings. The southpaw dominated at Parkview Field, posting a 2.18 ERA and a 2-1 record in six starts, with opponents hitting .210 against him.

ANOTHER BATTLE OF THE 'CAPS: West Michigan comes to Fort Wayne for the first and only time all season this week. The two teams have only met one other time this season, the week of July 7-12 in Comstock Park. The Whitecaps won 4 of the 6 games entering the All-Star break at the beginning of what was Fort Wayne's longest road trip of 2026.

JD JUST DOING IT: Fort Wayne shortstop **Justin DeCriscio** is third in High-A and in the Midwest League with 31 hits since July 3 (21 games). The 23-year-old launched his ninth home run of the season to get things going at the plate for Fort Wayne in the first frame on July 26 in the series finale against Lake County. On Sunday, June 12, at West Michigan, DeCriscio went 3-for-5 with a 2B, HR, and a career-high 5 RBI. Following Friday night's 2-for-5 effort, the former NC State Wolfpack now has 20 multi-hit games with Fort Wayne since being promoted on May 12, with seven of those being three-hit showings.

HE GETS ON BASE: DeCriscio has played in 34 of the last 35 games for Fort Wayne and has reached base safely in 31 games of those games dating back to June 18. He is slashing .306/.377/.493 with a .870 OPS in the stretch, with 5 HR, 10 doubles, a triple, and 22 RBI. DeCriscio is second in the Midwest League with 44 hits in this stretch and is fourth in total bases with 71. The 23-year-old has the only grand slam hit by a TinCap this season (June 12), and 6 of his 9 home runs have been on the road. The Padres' 10th-round pick in 2025 is second in the Midwest League with 59 hits dating back to May 31, with a .296 average in that stretch.

THE WORLD OF WIDEMAN: TinCaps center fielder **Ryan Wideman** is fourth in the Midwest League in hits since July 21, going 17-for-46 (.370) with five multi-hit showings in the stretch. Wideman had eight multi-hit games in July and had three consecutive three-hit affairs to conclude the series two weeks ago against Lake County at Parkview Field. The 22-year-old leads all of Minor League Baseball with 60 stolen bases this season. The Padres 2025 third-round pick out of Western Kentucky slashed .314/.389/.504 with a .893 OPS in 65 games with Single-A Lake Elsinore to begin this season before his promotion to High-A on June 23. Wideman has a hit in 9 of his last 10 games.

CANTWELL COMING THROUGH: Fort Wayne first baseman **Luke Cantwell** is on a team-leading seven-game hit streak following his sixth-inning single on Friday. The 2025 20th-round pick is 10-for-24 (.417) across the stretch, including his fourth homer with the 'Caps this season on July 25 at home against Lake County. The former Pitt Panther has six multi-hit showings in 17 games since joining the club on June 23. The Warrington, PA native made his professional debut with Fort Wayne on Sept. 2 last season, being the second 2025 draft selection of the Padres to join the 'Caps directly from draft camp.

DUGIE KEEPS CLIMBING: Fort Wayne third baseman **Rosman Verdugo** hit his 12th home run of the season on Saturday, his first since June 26 at Classic Auto Group Park against the Captains. Verdugo now has 26 across his TinCaps career, passing Tom Knauss (1993-94, 96-97) for sole possession of seventh in franchise history. Verdugo is the 10th player in Fort Wayne franchise history to hit the 20-career home run mark. After leading the 'Caps with 13 home runs in 2025, 9 of Verdugo's 12 home runs in 2026 have come on the road. The 21-year-old's RBI double in the 8th frame on Friday was his 8th of the campaign and first since he collected a pair on July 1 at Parkview Field against the Loons.

JACK ATTACK: Fort Wayne first baseman **Jack Costello** launched his 12th home run of the season on Friday night and finished a triple shy of the cycle on the day. It marked Costello's second 3-hit showing of the season and in the last week, having also done so on July 26 at home against Lake County. Costello has 22 homers in his TinCaps career and is now 1 of 11 players in franchise history to hit the 20-home-run mark. The solo blast on Friday put the 25-year-old into sole possession of 9th in career home runs, surpassing Fernando Tatis Jr (2017). Costello has led the MWL since the start of 2025, with 12 of his 22 home runs against left-handed pitching, four ahead of his own teammate, Jake Cunningham.

PACKING PARKVIEW: The Fort Wayne TinCaps ranked **sixth in Minor League Baseball total attendance from July 21-26, 2026, welcoming in 40,057 fans** to Parkview Field for its series against the Lake County Captains.

The third-largest six-game homestand in Parkview Field history and third to eclipse 40,000 since Minor League Baseball moved to the format in 2021 included three straight sellouts from Thursday to Saturday, while all six games ranked inside the top 10 in Minor League performance.

Fort Wayne on the week ranked higher than 29 of 30 teams at the High-A/Single-A levels, higher than all 15 Double-A teams in action, and ranked higher than 11 of 15 Triple-A teams.

Manager

Age: 54

- **FROM:** Centerville, IA
- **COLLEGE:** Indian Hills Community College (Iowa) and the University of New Orleans
- **PLAYING CAREER:** Drafted in the 42nd Round of the 1994 MLB Draft by the Colorado Rockies, played one season
- **COACHING CAREER:** Mathews returns to Fort Wayne for his third stint with the organization and second as the team's manager. Began coaching career at the University of Iowa and then in the Minnesota Twins' organization after his playing career. Became the hitting coach for the High-A Fort Myers Miracle in 1997, before managing the rookie-level Elizabethton Twins in 1998 and '99. Returned to alma mater, coaching at Indian Hills and taught economics from 1999-2012 before returning to professional baseball. Mathews coached in the Baltimore Orioles' farm system in 2013, and Arizona Diamondbacks' system from 2014-2016 before joining the Padres organization in 2017 as their major-league outfield coach. He first spent time in Fort Wayne as the TinCaps hitting coach from 2018-2021 before assuming the same role with Triple-A El Paso in 2022. He took over as the Fort Wayne manager in 2023, leading the TinCaps to a second-half east division title and first playoff appearance since 2017. He has spent the last two years as a minor league hitting coordinator.

Yorman Bazardo

Pitching Coach

Age: 42

- **FROM:** Maracay, Venezuela
- **SIGNED:** July 19, 2000 (Florida Marlins) as international free agent
- **CAREER:** Made 25 big league appearances, including eight starts across four seasons from 2005 to 2009. He also played 10 seasons in the minor leagues, accruing 1,112 innings pitched and a 3.91 ERA. He ended his playing career in 2017 after multiple seasons away from the states in Venezuela, Mexico, and Italy.
- **COACHING:** Became a pitching coach in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization in 2018, acting as a pitching coach in the DSL before going stateside in 2021. He then joined the Padres organization in 2023 and spent 2025 as the pitching coach for Single-A Lake Elsinore.
- **RELATIONSHIP:** Older brother of Seattle Mariners reliever Eduard Bazardo, who made nine appearances in the playoffs in 2025.

Luis Mendez

Bench Coach

Age: 33

- **FROM:** San Juan de los Morros, Venezuela
- **CAREER:** Mendez played in the minors for nine seasons all of which in the Rangers organization totaling 506 games in the minor leagues. Retired from playing after winter league stint in 2018-19.
- **COACHING:** After retiring from playing in 2019, Mendez began his coaching career with the Tri-City Dust Devils before the COVID-19 pandemic cut down the 2020 season. Mendez then spent the next three seasons as the manager of the rookie-level Dominican Summer League (DSL) Padres. In 2024, Mendez managed the Arizona Complex League (ACL) Padres. He returns for his second season as the TinCaps bench coach.

About Parkview Field

- **BACKGROUND:** In 2007, the Fort Wayne City Council approved the Harrison Square Project to build a new ballpark downtown as well as other amenities.
- **DEBUT:** Opening Day for Parkview Field took place on April 16, 2009. The TinCaps played in front of a sold-out crowd and beat the Dayton Dragons 7-0.
- **CAPACITY:** 8,100
- **RECORD CROWD:** 9,508 (July 4, 2019)
- **DIMENSIONS:** 336 feet to the left-field foul pole... 377 feet to left-center field... 400 feet to straight-away centerfield... 383 feet to right-center field... and 318 feet to the right-field foul pole.
- **WALLS:** Range from 10 feet tall, from center to right-center field, up to 15 feet tall in the outfield corners as well as a small section of left-center field.
- **MORE THAN BASEBALL:** Parkview Field hosts hundreds of special events yearly, including concerts such as Florida Georgia Line, Dierks Bentley, Zac Brown Band, and Nelly.
