### LAST GAME

On Sunday, the Bowie Baysox dropped their fifth game in their last seven contests when they fell to the Akron RubberDucks, 4-2 in 10 innings. Not to be lost in the outcome is the performance of Garrett Stallings, who threw six shutout innings, allowing just two hits and walking none. Bowie struck first when Heston Kjerstad crossed home in the bottom of the first without the Baysox registering a hit. However, from there the offense stalled until the bottom of the eighth, when Cesar Prieto notched an RBI single, tying the game at two at the time. The RubberDucks found their success against the Baysox bullpen, scoring a run in the seventh and eighth inning off Antonio Velez. The Baysox had the game-winning run, represented by Donta' Williams, thrown out at home plate on a flyout to center field by Kjerstad to end the ninth, before Akron's Raynel Delgado hit a two-run opposite field home run in the top of the tenth to give the RubberDucks a lead they would not relinquish. The loss is already Bowie's second in extra innings this season.

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Altoona Curve are off to a 3-6 start and currently bottom of the Southwest division, albeit only two games out of first place. The Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, Altoona currently roster six of the organization's top-30 prospects, via MLB Pipeline. Headlining the roster is C Henry Davis (No. 3 PIT/No. 57 overall), who is hitting .226 entering the series with a pair of home runs, six runs batted in and an OBP of .385. Other top prospects include INF Llover Peguero (No. 6 PIT), RHPs Jared Jones (No. 11 PIT) and Kyle Nicolas (No. 20 PIT), along with OF Matt Gorski (No. 17 PIT) and Matt Frazier (No. 23 PIT). Notable standouts through the first nine games include Frazier, who's hitting a team-high .313 and slugging a team-best .594. His 10 hits and five extra-base hits are both fourth-most in the Eastern League. As a team, the Curve enter the series tied atop the Eastern League with 12 home runs and second with a .730 OPS. However, Altoona also enters tied for the most errors in the league with 13, along with the second-worst team fielding percentage at .960. The Curve are led by first-year manager Calix Crabbe, who managed in the Pirates' system in High-A Greensboro last season.

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Altoona is set to kick off the series by sending right-hander Kyle Nicolas to the mound. The No. 20 prospect in the Pirates' system, Nicolas has struggled in his first two starts of 2023. He allowed three earned runs on just one hit, accompanied by four walks across 4.2 innings on the Curve's Opening Day clash with New Hampshire, before allowing five earned runs on eight hits over 3.1 innings this past Wednesday in Erie. His current 9.00 ERA is a staff-high for Altoona, though no pitcher has thrown more than nine total innings for them so far this season. Nicolas sported a casual 3.97 ERA in 2022 with the Curve, but kept much firmer command of the strike zone than he has thus far in 2023, with just 47 walks to 101 strikeouts across 90.2 innings a season ago. His .216 opposing average in 2022 was third-lowest on the team for any player over 45 innings. Against Bowie last season, Nicolas made four appearances (three starts) and allowed five earned runs over 13 innings with seven walks, a pair of hit batters, and 13 strikeouts. Initially a Competitive Balance Round B pick by the Miami Marlins in 2020, Nicolas was sent to the Pirates organization in November of 2021 as a part of the Jacob Stallings trade. He pitched collegiately at Ball State, where he was three-year teammates with tonight's projected Baysox starter, Chayce McDermott. Nicolas features a mid-high 90s fastball with 20 inches of induced vertical break, along with a mid-80s slider and low-80s curveball. He also has a changeup he utilizes on occasion.

### HESTON IS BESTON

OF/1B Heston Kjerstad leads all of Double-A baseball with five home runs this season. Kjerstad launched four homers last week against Akron, including a home run in three consecutive games for the first time in his professional career. All five of Kjerstad's long balls are solo shots so far this season. Kjerstad also leads Double-A with 28 total bases and 11 runs scored, while his seven extra-base hits are second-most at this level. Beyond his potency at the plate, he has also shown defensive versatility with three starts at first base this season for the first time since his final collegiate season at the University of Arkansas in 2020.

### HAIL CÉSAR

INF César Prieto has had a phenomenal start at the plate to begin the 2023 season. Prieto leads the Eastern League with 14 hits. Prieto has also matched a career-best 8-game hitting streak at the Double-A level, including four multi-hit games. Prieto had an 8-game hitting streak for Bowie last season that spanned from 5/28-6/7, including a 8-for-22 (.364) series in Altoona. Prieto's longest hit-streak in Minor League Baseball is 12 games, with 10 of those contests coming at the High-A level with Aberdeen before he was initially called up to Bowie on 5/24/22 for the final two games of that streak.

### GETTING STARTED ON THE RIGHT FOOT

The Baysox have gotten off to stellar starts throughout the early phase of the 2023 season. Bowie is the only team in Minor League Baseball to score first in every game its played this season, with seven of those opening scores crossing the plate within the first two innings. On the mound, the starters have also played their part. Baysox starters hold a collective 2.03 ERA on the season, after yielding nine runs across 40 innings thus far. The Baysox have gotten four starts of at least five shutout innings in their opening nine games, after taking 22 games to get four such starts last season. Right hander Garrett Stallings logged Bowie's first quality start of 2023 with his six shutout innings on Sunday.

## CAREER NOTES

- Pitched to a 6.08 ERA in Bowie across 6 starts and 26.2 innings last season. Held opponents to a .179 average but struggled with 20 walks and 7 home runs given up in a Baysox uniform.
- Made his Double-A debut for Bowie on 8/17 after making two brief appearances with High-A - his first two in the Orioles system. Surrendered 14 earned runs in his first two starts (8 IP) for Bowie, before finishing the season by allowing 4 ER in his final 4 starts (18.2 IP).
- Played two-plus seasons at Ball State. Originally drafted by the Houston Astros in the 4th round of the 2021 draft.
- Struck out 199 batters for Ball State in two seasons, across 139 innings. Redshirted his first season at Ball State in 2018 while recovering from Tommy John Surgery.
- Comes from a long legacy of Indiana basketball. Older brother Sean, played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season, and collegiately at Butler. Mother, Kim, played at Indiana State. Grandfather, Alan Danner, was a high school basketball coach who won two Indiana state titles, also in the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame. Uncles, Linc and Tige, played at Purdue and Appalachian State, respectively. Uncle Linc was head men's basketball coach at D2 Florida Southern and won a national championship in 2015 - also coached Wisconsin-Green Bay and reached the March Madness tournament in 2016. Linc was Associate Head Coach at Ball State in 2022.
