NOTES

LAST TIME DUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Richmond Flying Squirrels, 4-3, in 10 innings on Saturday night at The Diamond. Richmond had a walk-off win on a catcher's interference. The Ponies erased a 3-0 deficit on **Rowdey Jordan**'s two-run hit and **Alex Ramírez** scored on **Matt Rudick**'s double. **Brandon Sproat** struck out six batters over five innings, while allowing three runs. **Cameron Foster** tossed a scoreless inning. **Trey McLoughlin** pitched two scoreless frames, his 9th-straight scoreless outing.

THE BULLPEN: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies bullpen has been solid since the team's previous 10-game win streak began on July 4. Binghamton has used 13 different relievers over the last 17 games, and they've combined to go 6-1 with five saves, and a 1.59 ERA over 68.1 innings with 68 strikeouts and just 27 walks. The bullpen has held Binghamton's opponents scoreless in six of the last 17 games and has allowed just 12 ER in that span.

PARADA PARTY: Mets No. 9 prospect **Kevin Parada** singled twice on Friday and is riding a season-long 20-game on-base streak, dating back to June 27, which is tied with Ryan Ritter (Hartford) for the longest active on-base streak in the Eastern League. Over his 20-game on-base streak, Parada is slashing .311/.400/.514/.914 with three home runs, six doubles, eight runs batted in, and 23 hits. Parada has upped his season average from .205 to .234, after his 20-game on-base streak. In 17 games in July, the 22-year-old is hitting .323 with a .941 OPS, three home runs, four doubles, and eight runs batted in. Parada has recorded three multi-hit games over his last four games and six multi-hit games over his last 10 games. He has at least one hit in 13 of his 17 games this month.

CLIFFORD CRUSH: Mets No. 3 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 70 overall prospect **Ryan Clifford** recorded another hit on Saturday. In 18 games in July, Clifford is hitting .319 with a .395 OBP, a .992 OPS, 23 hits, four home runs, eight doubles, 13 runs batted in, and 15 runs scored. Clifford has recorded at least one hit in 15 of his 18 games in July. The 21-year-old has the fourthmost home runs in the Eastern League with 13. In 41 games since the start of June, Clifford is hitting .262 with a 1.001 OPS, 12 home runs, and 31 RBIs.

RUDY: Outfielder **Matt Rudick** doubled twice and reached base four times on Saturday. Rudick has hit four doubles in this series and currently leads the team with 20 doubles this year. He recorded his 17th multi-hit game on Saturday, which is tied for the second-most on the team. Rudick has three multi-hit games over his last seven games, after the All-Star break. Of his eight hits in that span, five have gone for extra bases.

ICE TREY: Right-handed reliever **Trey McLoughlin** pitched two scoreless frames on Saturday night. McLoughlin has recorded nine-straight scoreless outings. He has two saves, has allowed three hits, and has 11 strikeouts over his nine-straight scoreless appearances, with opponents batting .094 against him. Earlier this season, McLoughlin did not allow an earned run in 10-straight appearances from April 23 to June 12. McLoughlin is approaching Binghamton's longest scoreless streak of the season, which Wilkin Ramos holds after he did not allow a run over his first 13 appearances.

-Reid Brignac (pronounced Brin-yac) is coming off leading the Rumble Ponies to the postseason last season, for the first time since 2017. -AJ Sager was named the 2023 New York Mets Minor League Staff Member of the Year for his efforts last year. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five saves and a 5.36 ERA. Sager was originally drafted by
