Today: It's a Dog Days of Summer, with dogs welcome to the ballpark, as the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, playing the second game of a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers. Lansing is 9-7 against Great Lakes this year and 145-145 all-time after prevailing in the series opener yesterday. The Nuts are currently 4-3 during their 12-game, 13-day homestand vs. Fort Wayne and Great Lakes.

Last Night: Lugnuts 6, Loons 5. Following a 25-minute rain delay, Great Lakes seized a 3-0 first-inning lead behind a Kenneth Betancourt three-run double, and then fell victim to the strength of Daniel Susac. The Nuts' catcher cranked a pair of two-run homers to help Lansing score six unanswered runs en route to the series-opening win. Shortstop Jacob Wilson drove in Clark Elliott twice to support an 11-hit offensive effort.

On the Air: Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa are re-creating the game on the audio stream while Brad Tunney calls the action on Bally Live and Mil.B.TV.

Among the League Leaders: Daniel Susac ranks 3rd in the league in batting average (.304), with Danny Bautista, Jr. ranking 10th (.274); Susac is also tied for 3rd in base hits (100), 7th in slugging (.453) and 9th in OPS (.818), while Bautista, Jr. is tied for 6th in hits (98). Mac Lardner is tied for 1st in the league in wins (7)

Two Sweet: With his performance yesterday, Daniel Susac joined Lazaro Armenteros, Jonny Butler, Junior Pérez and Caeden Trenkle as Lugnuts who have hit two home runs in a game this season.

Home Cooking: All seven of Susac's roundtrippers have come at home this year, which fits a theme: Lansing is the best home offense in the league, topping the circuit in home batting average (.258), home base hits (456), home triples (16), and home total bases (723), and ranks third in home home runs (48). Overall, the Nuts are third in the league in average, second in hits, second in steals and are the second toughest team to strike out in the Midwest League.

Pitcher's Best Friend: The Nuts lead the Midwest League with 99 double plays turned, nine more than second place Peoria and 40 more than last place Quad Cities.

Saying the Day: The Lugnuts have been playing closer and closer games as the season has gone on. By month; seven sayes in 20 games in April (35%), nine in 27 games in May (33%), 15 in 24 in June (63%), 20 in 24 games in July (83%), and 10 in 13 games played in August (77%).

Turnaround: Outfielder Junior Pérez opened the year batting .082 (5-for-60) in his first 20 games, including a streak of 32 consecutive hitless at-bats. Since then, he is hitting .275 (76-for-276). His slash line by month: April - .089/.192/.089, .281 OPS; May - .238/.295/.438, .733 OPS; June - .256/.326/.372, .698 OPS; July - .262/.361/.393, .754 OPS; August - 16-for-49, three doubles, one triple, two home runs, five walks, four stolen bases, .327/.389/.551, .940 OPS. He has reached base 32 times in the last 16 games thanks to 23 hits and nine walks.

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

The Cycle: On June 21 at Wisconsin, Jack Winkler went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: Corey Patterson (7/5/99 at South Bend); Donnie Hood (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); Chip Cannon (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); Travis Snider (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); Brad Glenn (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); Edward Olivares (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and Ryan Gold (4/18/19 vs. Dayton).

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has three players acquired via trade by the Oakland Athletics on its roster: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea, and a 2021 member of the Fort Wayne TinCaps); and Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster has the A's last two first-round selections in catcher Daniel Susac, taken 19th overall out of Arizona last year, and shortstop Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall pick this year from Grand Canyon University. The A's 2021 first-round selection, shortstop Max Muncy, opened the year on the Lugnuts roster after first joining the team last year, where he was teammates with 2020 first-rounder Tyler Sodestrom. Muncy is now withMidland; Soderstrom is in the Majors.

Big League Nuts: Eight Lugnuts have made their MLB debuts in 2023, totaling 181 all-time. Those eight: Ryan Noda on March 30; Hogan Harris on April 14; Mason Miller on April 19; Garrett Acton on May 14; Samad Taylor on June 18; Tyler Soderstrom on July 14; and Lawrence Butler and Hagen Danner on August 11. Davis Schneider, who debuted with Toronto on August 4, played for the Nuts in the 2017 Crosstown Showdown but did not play in any regular season Lansing games.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2012: Rain was forecasted, so the Lugnuts got tricky - a little too tricky for their own good. Scheduled starter Noah Syndergaard was replaced by spot-starter Kramer Champlin, just in case the game started and then immediately went into a rain delay (which would cause the Lugnuts to burn their starting pitcher). Champlin pitched fine, blanking Fort Wayne in three innings - no sign of rain. Brandon Berl gave up two runs in relief in the fourth inning - no sign of rain. Syndergaard finally came out of the bullpen in the 5th inning – boom, rain ended his day after three hitless innings in a 2-0 loss to the TinCaps at Cooley Law School Stadium, shortened by rain to only seven innings.

2013: Emilio Guerrero went 6-for-6 to tie the team/league record, including a third-inning grand slam amid a nine-run rally, and the Lugnuts destroyed the Whitecaps, 14-5.

2019: The Lugnuts set a new franchise record for margin of victory with a 19-1 victory over Fort Wayne at Cooley Law School Stadium. Griffin Conine, Ryan Gold and Rafael Lantigua each hit a two-run homer in the win. The TinCaps finished the game with two different position players, Tyler Benson and Kelvin Alarcon, combining to pitch the eighth. Benson recorded the first two outs, allowing five runs, before Alarcon recorded the final out.

Home Cooking: Also from Tucson: Alex Verdugo, four-time All-Star Ian Kinsler, two-time All-Star J.J. Hardy, Cardinals All-Star catcher Tom Pagnozzi and Ron Hassey... in all, Tucson ranks second behind Phoenix in producing Major Leaguers from the Grand Canyon State.

Glory Days: Boasting a 96 mph fastball, Dicochea was highly regarded coming out of Sahuarita High School, ranked the No. 1 prep prospect in Arizona by Baseball America entering the 2019 draft... twirled a no-hitter in the state semifinals... signed for \$400,000... signing scout: Scott Cousins... signed away from commitment to University of Arizona... senior year stats: 1.30 ERA, 54 IP, 24 H, 10 ER, 11 BB, 86 K... in addition to pitching, also starred at shortstop.

Minor League Path: Dicochea opened his professional career in the 2019 Arizona League after signing, but his 2021 campaign was halted in Single-A Stockton due to injury on June 6 after only six appearances, five starts... returned from Tommy John surgery on August 12, 2022, and made two appearances in the Arizona Complex League before returning to Stockton on August 26, 2022... finished the year with three appearances for the Ports.

Bagels in April: Opened 2023 as the Ports' No. 4 starter, firing four scoreless innings at Fresno on April 11... that was the start of three consecutive scoreless outings to begin the year, finishing April with 13 2/3 scoreless innings... didn't allow first run until May 3 vs. Fresno, entering in relief in the fifth inning and allowing two runs in the fifth and two more in the seventh in a 5-4 Ports win... in total with Stockton, posted a 2.42 ERA with a .132 average against in five road starts (22 1/3 IP) compared to 4.24 ERA, .200 avg. in four home appearances (17 IP)... lefties hit .111/.243/.175 compared to righties' .205/.279/.308... base stealers went 2-for-2.

Rave Reviews: Dicochea was promoted from Single-A Stockton to Lansing on June 13 to replace Jack Perkins, who was transferred up to Double-A Midland... coincidentally, an article about Dicochea had just been written by MLB.com A's beat writer Martin Gallegos a day earlier, quoting A's GM David Forst in including Dicochea's name among the top pitching prospects in the system (Royber Salinas, Gunnar Hoglund, J.T. Ginn and Joey Estes). Wrote Gallegos about Dicochea, "Dicochea, an eighth-round selection by the A's in the 2019 MLB Draft out of Sahuarita (Ariz.) High School, ranks just outside Oakland's Top 30 Prospects list. But his inclusion in that group from Forst speaks volumes about how highly he is viewed. In nine games (seven starts) for Single-A Stockton this season, Dicochea holds a 3.20 ERA with 47 strikeouts against 17 walks in 39 1/3 innings. He has held opposing batters to a .163 average, which ranks lowest among all California League pitchers with at least 30 innings pitched. Dicochea's development hit a snag early in his pro career after he underwent Tommy John surgery in 2021. Since his return from injury, the 22-year-old right-hander is taking a big step forward this season, showing off a fastball that consistently hits 95 mph along with a solid slider and a changeup he's recently added to his mix. A's assistant general manager and director of player personnel Billy Owens added, "He's off to a promising start. Averaging well over a strikeout per inning. Overall, his command has taken a step forward. He's definitely an interesting arm on the horizon."

Life in Lansing: This is the first time that Dicochea is starting for the Lugnuts on a Wednesday... he had previously made one start on Tuesday, three starts on Thursday, three starts on Friday, one start on Saturday and one relief appearance on Sunday... limiting Midwest League lefties to .231 avg. (though they have hit both of the home runs he has allowed)... allowing .226 avg. with runners in scoring position.
