**THAT WAS FUN:** After throwing the first nine inning no-hitter in franchise history last night, the FredNats turn around to play a 7-inning doubleheader today against the Carolina Mudcats to make up for Thursday's rainout. LHP Alex Clemmey makes his home debut after being traded to Washington from Cleveland before the deadline in the Lane Thomas deal. Clemmey is currently ranked as Washington's number six overall prospect according to MLB Pipeline. This is the third doubleheader the FredNats and Mudcats have played at Virginia Credit Union Stadium this year, with Fredericksburg sweeping the first two twinbills.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Travis Sykora, Angel Roman and Merrick Baldo combined to throw the first nine inning no-hitter in Fredericksburg Nationals history. In the inaugural 2021 season, the FredNats threw a 7-inning no-hitter in game one of a doubleheader, but last night's game was the full nine innings. Sykora began it with six perfect innings, tying his career-high with 10 strikeouts. Roman walked one hitter in two scoreless innings, and Baldo walked two in the ninth. There were two defensive mistakes in the ninth behind Baldo, but he struck out Filipo Di Turi to end it. It was the 32nd total no-hitter in the Minors, but only the 16th nine inning no-no. Only 20 of the 32 total no-hitters in MiLB this year came outside of Complex League play. Elijah Green and Cristhian Vaquero both homered on offense to power the FredNats to the eventual 7-1 victory.

**HE'S SOMETHING ELSE:** Travis Sykora has proven to be one of the most dominant pitchers in the Carolina League since arriving in Fredericksburg on May 1. He has not allowed a hit or a run in his last two starts, covering 11 innings, and he's faced the minimum in both of those starts. In six starts since July 1, Sykora has allowed a total of four earned runs in six starts for an ERA of 1.29 in that time frame. He's got 49 strikeouts and nine walks in those six starts, and the FredNats have won five out of the six games. The opponents are hit .088 against him in that time frame, and .151 for the entire season.

**PITCHING HARDWARE:** For his efforts last week, Travis Sykora was named the Carolina League's Pitcher of the Week, which was the first time this year a FredNat hurler earned a weekly award. Then, his former rotation mate Marc Davis was announced as the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for July after posting an 0.45 ERA in 20 innings across four July starts. Davis was promoted to High-A Wilmington on July 26 for his efforts.

**DON'T LET HIM GET HOT:** Racking up his team-leading 11th home run last night, Elijah Green has been one of the best power hitters in the Carolina League in the second half. Since July 1, Green is slashing .262/.374/.488/.862 and has posted a wRC+ of 150 (100 is league average), and a wOBA of .406 (.313 is league average). He's cut his strikeout rate by 10% from early in the season, and since July 1, his walk rate is nearly 15%.

**WIN 200:** Wednesday night's win was the 200th for FredNat Manager Jake Lowery since he took over Managerial duties in 2022 in Fredericksburg. Lowery won 76 games in 2022, 65 games in 2023, and his 59th victory of this season last night gave him 200. Lowery led the FredNats to a second half title in 2022, a feat the Freddie's hope to replicate this year.

**THE SKIP IS BACK:** The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 201-165 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

**THE STAFF:** The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals. He was the Pitching Coach for the High-A Wilmington Blue Rocks in 2021 and the Double-A Harrisburg Senators in 2022 before coming to FXBG in 2023 and spending the last two seasons here.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with ZSP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Alex Clemmey makes his second start as a FredNat tonight, taking on the Carolina Mudcats. It's the lefty's 21st start overall, having made his first 19 starts with Lynchburg.

Alex was acquired as a key piece in the Nationals' return for Lane Thomas from Cleveland. Coincidentally, the trade was made right before the FredNats and Hillcats were scheduled to start a series, so Clemmey simply had to switch dugouts.

**WELCOME TO PRO BALL:** Clemmey faced a rude introduction to the Carolina league, as the southpaw struggled mightily in his first month playing professionally. Alex sported a 12.60 ERA over five starts (15.0 IP), as opponents hit .306 against him.

**QUICK CHANGE:** Once the calendar flipped to May, Alex almost insantly figured out his April issues. Since his first start of May (5/5), Clemey has posted a 2.48 ERA in 14 starts (54.1 IP), with a 2.34 K:BB ratio, and hasn't allowed more than three earned runs in any outing.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Clemmey struggled in his FredNat debut, recording just two outs before being lifted in the first inning against his former teammates in Lynchburg.

**TODAY'S START:** Travis Sthele makes his 17th start of the year this evening, against the Carolina Mudcats. A 12th round pick by the Nats in 2023, Sthele joined the FredNat rotation late in the 2023 campaign. Sthele has been mainly a starter, but has worked in the piggyback role twice this season.

**A YEAR AGO:** Sthele took his lumps after joining Fredericksburg last season. He posted a 7.36 ERA over four starts, to go along with a 1.82 WHIP. Travis struck out six hitters over 11.0 IP but showcased strong command, walking just three men.

**TRENDING UP:** After a rough start to the season, Sthele has made marked improvements as the summer goes along. In July, the righty went 3-0 across four starts (21.0 IP), with a 0.86 ERA, a .155 BAA, and 19 strikeouts against seven walks.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Sthele took a bit of a step back in his last start, after a brilliant July. Lynchburg tagged him for eight hits and four runs over five innings, in a no-decision for Travis.
