Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Rorik Maltrud** to the mound tonight, looking to take control of the series (Clippers are 12-8 in Maltrud's starts). The Saints will counter with RHP **German Marquez**. Columbus is 51-36 (.586) versus right handers this year. Marquez has never pitched against the Clippers in his career, as tonight will be his second career game in the IL (17G in the PCL).

vs. the Saints

Columbus went 5-5 against the Saints in Ohio last year (2G cancelled), on the way to a 9-7 series record, and has won 53 of the last 87 overall opposing the Saints (477-378 run differential; 15 of 32 losses by a single run, only 12 losses by more than two runs). Individually, **David Fry** has hit .333 (20x60) with 4HR and 15RBI in 18G against St. Paul in his career (**Kahlil Watson** has 5HR and 18RBI in 18G).

Aside from That...

If no homers had been hit this week, Columbus would be outscoring St. Paul by a total of 12-1, as the Saints have scored 21 times thanks to 14HR. For their part, the Clippers have scored 20 runs off 11HR. Columbus pitching has held the Saints to a measly .053 (1x19, HR) with runners in scoring position (Clippers are 10x28 with 4HR), but St. Paul is hitting .277 (31x112) with 13HR in all other situations.

Start with a Bang

Over the last 20G, the Clippers have plated a total of 153 runs (most in the IL, 7.7 per), with 101 tallied in the first four innings of the game (35 scored in the 1st), including seven innings of 5+. Grabbing the early lead has been of the utmost importance for Columbus, as the Clippers are the only undefeated team in the IL when leading after the 7th (47-0, 57 straight wins since 8/22/25 vs. Omaha).

Homer Time

The Clippers gained 18 in the homer column over 17G from 7/28-8/19 (45-27; out-homered 36-21 in 19G prior), but they have been out-homered 12-6 in the last 3G. Dating to 7/28, they have hit more homers (51) than any team in pro baseball, while giving up the 6th most (39; leads IL). Huntington Park has been breached 60 times in the last 14G (2.9 per game on the year, 3rd in the IL; St. Paul is 1st: 3.6).

Ingle is Back

In 31G since his option, **Cooper Ingle** is 41x122 (.336), drawing 26BB (.450OBP) with 16XBH (6HR, .566SLG). He is the only batter in the IL hitting .300/.400/.500 (26PA from permanently qualifying for rate statistics), but is just 7x42 in his last 12G (.167; has drawn 15BB for a .386OBP, also has 18K in 57PA). At catcher, Ingle has a 1.303OPS (15HR) in 44G (.635OPS, 3HR in 37G between DH and LF).

Little Heater

Daniel Schneemann turned in a multi-hit game last night for the fourth time in his last 5G (9x19, .474 since 8/15). Schneemann has a trio of doubles and a homer among those hits, to go along with 4BB and only 1K (22PA since; 4K in last 10G, 8K in 5G prior). Dating to 4/25/24, he has played 50G in the IL, batting .320/.439/.569 with 43 runs scored (14 runs in last 14G) and 36RBI (5RBI in last 14G).

King Ralph

Dating to 7/28, **Ralph Velazquez** leads the IL in HR (13, +5), RBI (26, +4; RBI in 15 of 19G) and SLG (.903, +111). Last night saw his 12G his streak snapped (.417, 20x48, 10HR and 19RBI from 8/4-8/20), but he has not gone hitless in consecutive games since going 0x21 in 6G at St. Paul from 7/21-7/26 (aside from that trip, hitting .338/.416/.675 since 6/18). At home, he has 11HR in 37G (.639SLG).

All or Nothing

Over his last 19G, since 7/25, **Kody Huff** is mired in a 10x65 (.154) slump, though he has connected for 6HR (19HR on the season; had 18HR in career prior). He leads the team in both runs (70) and RBI (67) and is set to become the fourth 70-70 Clipper since 2019 (**Johnathan Rodriguez**, **Jhonkensy Noel**, **Juan Brito**). Last night's homer established a new career high in hits (83).

Making a Run

Milan Tolentino enters tonight just 3HR and 5SB short of his second straight 20-20 season (last year, at 21HR and 20SB, was first such season in franchise history). Dating to the start of 2025, his 38HR are tied for most in the IL (35SB are tied for 29th), and he recently popped his first off a LHP (8/7 at Syracuse). At Huntington Park this year, he has just 8HR in 154AB (14HR in 195AB last year).

This Date in Clipper History

8/22/1983

The Clippers dropped a heartbreaker to the Red Wings 7-5, but the silver lining was **Brian Dayett's** 2HR game. The 2HR gave him 35 on the season, a total that stands as the single-season franchise record. His 35HR also led the League in '83, marking the 4th straight season in which a Clipper was the IL Home Run King (**Marshall Brant**- '80, **Steve Balboni**- '81 & '82). Columbus' 9 HR Kings since '77 are the most in the IL.

First Half Wrap

Despite being eliminated from playoff contention on the penultimate Sunday of the first half, the Clippers were 41-33 and finished with their first winning record in the front half since the season was split in 2023 (averaged 32 wins from 2023-25, topping out at 34-38, .472, last season). From 4/22-6/17, they spent every day between 3.0 and 6.0 games off the lead, while occupying anywhere between 4th and 13th in the standings. A late push (15-6 from 5/16-6/9) got them to within 2.5 before derailing with a 3G losing streak at Indy to seal their fate. On the back half, Columbus has posted just one winning record, clinching a playoff berth in 2024 with a mark of 48-26 (.649).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,486 to 1,433).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 174-136 (.561) in pitch reviews, with batters going 90-82 (.523) and pitchers/catchers going 84-54 (.609). They have run out of challenges in 46G and have not challenged in 6G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 5-4 in extra innings this year, after having gone .500 in each of the last two seasons. Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 55-37 when playing past regulation (.598, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 27-17 at home (.614; 5-7 in last 12G). Of the 92G to require extra play, 73 have been resolved after one frame (including nine DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 on 9/20/22 at Toledo).

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to top 800 again (on pace for 837, would rank as 4th most all-time; record is 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 142 through 121G (on pace for 173SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 43CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (52; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

Crazy Eighth's

From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored an IL-best 173 runs while crafting a .895OPS (nearly 100 points better than all other teams). On the flipside, Columbus has given up 111 runs from the 8th on, resulting in a +62 run differential (Clippers are getting outscored 277-178 from innings 5-7).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 80 grand slams and 1,987RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.43 through 121G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). Additionally, the staff is pacing to give up 205HR (2nd most in franchise history; 214HR allowed in 2023).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 7th in the IL this year (.981), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 66G this season (39-27, .591), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Good Baseball

CJ Kayfus bunted a runner into scoring position with a single on 7/5 vs. Louisville, with that runner kicking off a 5-run inning that led the Clippers to victory. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 90-23 (.796) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 7-2 mark this season (.778, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers have the 8th most last at bat wins this year (14, four off the lead) while playing in the 12th most games decided in the last at bat (27, Norfolk has 39). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 101G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 48-53 (.475, 16th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**- '79, **Joe Altobelli**- '80, **Frank Verdi**- '81, **Bucky Dent**- '87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**- '10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 451-462 (.494), 421-416 with Columbus (.503).

June Swoon:

In his first 10G of the year (March-May), Maltud gave up 15ER in 50.2IP (2.66ERA), holding the opposition to a .195 average (38x186, 4HR). He gave up multiple runs in each of 5G in June (17.1IP, 15ER) and struggled in July also (22.0IP, 12ER), as he posted a 6.18ERA (39.1IP, 27ER) over the two months. Opposing hitters batted .294 (48x163) with 10HR in 10G from June-July (9HR to last 107BF). Since the calendar has flipped to August, Maltud has regained his early season form, turning in a 1.72ERA (15.2IP, 3ER) through his first three outings.

Undecided:

Through the month of June, Maltud was the only pitcher in the IL with at least 10GS that had not taken a loss and his lone win (4/11 at Worcester) made him the only starter with a single decision. He is 4-1 in 8G since the start of July, winning back to back starts to begin the month and suffering his first loss of the year in his 17th start (7/22 at St. Paul). Despite a 3.78ERA as a starter and run support of 5.6 per game, Maltud has left with the lead only 10 times because the offense is averaging 2.8 runs while he is the pitcher of record, including 11G with two runs or fewer (5G with zero runs).

Efficiency is Key:

Through 109 innings started in 23G, Maltud has retired the side with fewer than 10 pitches on 13 occasions, including a 4-pitch inning on 4/3 vs. Indianapolis, while turning in 21 innings of more than 20. He has hit 30+ three times, thanks to an 11-pitch battle vs. Iowa's **Pedro Ramirez** on 4/17 (walk, 34 in the inning) and a 14-pitch skirmish with Buffalo's **Yohendrick Pinango** on 4/23 (groundout, 30 total). He ranks 3rd in the IL with 15.5 pitches per inning (17.0 per from 6/2-7/28).

Among the Leader Beans:

Entering today's game, Maltud is 4th in the IL with a 3.83ERA (13 qualifiers, dropped out of the top five after allowing 7ER in 3.2IP at St. Paul on 7/22). From his quality start win on 4/11 at Worcester through his quality start on 5/25 at Toledo, he crafted the 2nd best ERA in the IL, at 2.14ERA (42.0IP, 10ER). Additionally, Maltud's 0.95WHIP in that time ranked 2nd best (1.26WHIP on the season places 3rd).

Stepping Up:

With runners in scoring position this season, Maltud has held the opposition to a line of .165/.255/.224, surrendering just 1HR in 85AB. With a runner at first base, he has struggled to a line of .288/.352/.500 while allowing 4HR (80AB) and with the bases empty, the bad guys have hit .255/.309/.420 with 10HR in 243AB.

Pitch to Contact:

Maltud's Triple-A debut on 3/28 at Iowa was the 44th game of his career and marked his 37th consecutive start (reached 41GS before relief appearance on 4/30 vs. Toledo, all 7G in relief of career have come on starter's rest and been at least 3.0IP). He did not punch out any Cubs in that game (15BF), marking his second straight game without a strikeout (37BFwith 0K from, 9/10/25-4/3/26; had at least 1K in all 42G prior). Among 102 pitchers in the IL that have at least 240BF this year, Maltud has the 19th best walk rate (7.6%; 34BB to 448BF) and the 59th best strikeout rate (20.8%, 93K; had worst rate, 11.9%, through first month of the year).

In Relief:

Maltud has pitched three times in relief this season (previous 5G out of the bullpen came among first 7G as a pro), piggybacking **Trenton Denholm** on 4/30 vs. Toledo (3.0IP, 40 pitches), **Daniel Espino** on 6/2 vs. Omaha (4.0IP, 81 pitches) and **Austin Peterson** on 8/9 at Syracuse (3.1IP, 47 pitches). He has registered a 4.35ERA out of the bullpen (10.1IP, 15H, 5R, 5ER, 2BB, 16K).
