## FROM THE CROW'S NEST

POSTSEASON-BOUND: The Marauders are headed to the postseason for the fifth time in franchise history, and the first time since 2016. That 2016 postseason featured Bradenton's first-ever trip to the Florida State League Championship Series, which the Marauders won over Tampa, 3 games to 1.

CAPTAIN E.O.: Ernny Ordonez is batting .343 with 10 RBI in 10 games in September and has three consecutive multi-hit games, the second time he has done so this season (June 10-12). Ordonez ranks third on the team with 20 multi-hit games and second on the club with 14 multi-RBI games.

STAY CLASSY, SAMANIEGO: Left-hander Tyler Samaniego has started strong in his first professional season, allowing just 2 runs (1 earned) over 5 IP. The Alabama native, drafted this season in the 15th round out of the University of South Alabama, has recorded 10 strikeouts while walking just 2, and opponents are batting just .200 against him.

ENDY'S GAME: Endy Rodriguez was named last week's Low-A Southeast Player of the Week, batting .387 with 2 HR and 9 RBI while posting a 1.135 OPS in 7 games. Since the beginning of July (52 games), Rodriguez is batting .320 with a .953 OPS and 40 RBI. He is currently second in the league with 104 hits and tied for second with 68 RBI. He is also tied for the league lead with 43 extra-base hits, ranks second in batting average (.290), slugging percentage (.501), and OPS (.881), and is fourth with a .380 OBP.

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK: Jackson Glenn has reached base safely in each of his first 25 games at Low-A, batting .364 with a .482 OBP. The Pirates' fifth-round draft pick out of Dallas Baptist has hit safely in 22 of the 25 games, and has 21 walks and just 17 strikeouts.

THE OPPONENT: The Flying Tigers are coming off a rain-shortened 4-games-to-1 series win in Port St. Lucie, where weather interfered in some fashion Thursday, Friday, and Saturday. Lakeland's 5-2 loss on Sunday ended a 5-game winning streak, the team's longest of the season. Between May 18-23, the Flying Tigers handed the Marauders their first series loss of the season. Lakeland outscored Bradenton 55-28 in the series.

TOP PROSPECTS: Per midseason prospect ranking updates, the Marauders roster currently includes four prospects in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: **Hudson Head** (#12), **Jared Jones** (#15), **Endy Rodriguez** (#19), and **Maikol Escotto** (#20). Head and Rodriguez came from the Padres and Mets, respectively, in the Joe Musgrove trade in January, while Escotto was one of four prospects obtained from the Yankees in the Jameson Taillon trade.

UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT: New Jersey native Jonathan Johnston is in his first season as Marauders manager. The U.S. Naval Academy graduate spent two seasons as a catcher in the Oakland Athletics system in 2008 and 2011 in between a collective five years in the Navy as a Surface Warfare Officer. Prior to joining the Pirates organization in 2020, he held coaching roles at UC San Diego and UNC Asheville.

MISCELLANEOUS: Bradenton pitchers' 1,248 strikeouts are fourth-most in all of MiLB (San Jose leads with 1,382)... The Marauders own the Low-A Southeast's second-best run differential at +101 (Tampa's +226 is third in all of MiLB)... Seven Marauders players rank within the league's top 10 in home runs: Hudson Head (15 HR, 3rd), Jase Bowen and Endy Rodriguez (14 HR, T-4th), Jack Herman (13 HR, 5th), Dariel Lopez and Alexander Mojica (9 HR, T-9th), and Sammy Siani (8 HR, T-10th).
