Today marks games #88 & #89 of the 2021 season, the 4th & 5th games of a 6-game roadtrip, and the 4th & 5th games of a six-game series against the Lake County Captains. This marks the 16th and 17th of 18 games to be played between the Whitecaps and Captains this season. The Whitecaps are a Detroit Tigers affiliate in their 27th season in professional baseball, and first in the High-A Central League. Lake County is in their 17th season of affiliation with the nearby Cleveland Indians. These two teams met 21 times in the 2019 regular season, with Captains winning the season series with a 13-8 record.

Up Next: The 'Caps battle the Lake County Captains for a weeklong series from August 10-15 at Classic Park before returning home for a six-game series against the Fort Wayne TinCaps beginning on August 17 and going until August 22 at LMCU Ballpark.

STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT: The West Michigan Whitecaps failed to hold a three-run lead, and George Valera launched a game-winning home run as part of a 5-4 loss to the Lake County Captains on Friday at Classic Park. Friday was slated to be played as a doubleheader, but a heavy thunderstorm forced the postponement of the nightcap, which is now slated to be played as a doubleheader on Saturday. The home run was Valera's second of the ballgame and third of the series. The Whitecaps built a 4-1 lead on a solo home run by Andrew Navigato in the first and run-scoring singles by Ulrich Bojarski and Daniel Cabrera. In the fifth, Valera tied the game with his first homer of the contest – a two-run shot – before Jose Tena followed by hitting the next pitch for a game-tying solo homer. The homers mark the second consecutive day when Valera and Tena combined for back-to-back home runs on two straight pitches. Tena's home run marked the third of this series. Valera led off the frame with a walk-off solo home run to complete the Captains rally in the seventh. Valera's last seven base hits have all been home runs. The postponement of game two marks the seventh time this season that the Whitecaps have not played an intended ballgame. The game is scheduled to be made up in a Saturday doubleheader beginning at 4:00 pm. Both games will last seven innings in duration, with a 30-minute break in-between contests. Saturday will become the sixth doubleheader for West Michigan this season, with the 'Caps having posted a 7-4 record in those circumstances.

MORE LIKE ERIE DE LA ROSE-UP: On August 12, outfielder Eric De La Rosa was promoted to Eric after enjoying a breakout season in West Michigan, hitting .293 with 22 stolen bases in 59 games. The 24-year-old also gave the Whitecaps their first walk-off home run when he blasted a two-run shot to beat the Dayton Dragons on June 27 at LMCU Ballpark -- which also helped the outfielder from San Diego hit for the cycle in the contest.

RIVERA ONE AWAY: Not only is Detroit Tigers infielder Miguel Cabrera one home run away from his 500th homer, but Whitecaps infielder Rey Rivera is just one home run away from what's believed to be the Whitecaps franchise record for homers with 25 with Jeremy Laster of the 2006-2007 Whitecaps.

RAIN RAIN GO AWAY: The Whitecaps have had six gamedays postponed this season, with three coming in a week-span in late June (24, 26 & 29).

THRIFTY THURSDAYS ALSO FEATURE...: The Whitecaps hold a 10-5 record on Thursdays this season -- their best performance of any day of the week.

SUNDAY NO-FUNDAY: The Whitecaps have lost 7 of their 12 games played on a Sunday this season.

STILL GOT PROSPECTS: Outfielder Daniel Cabrera (#4) headlines a team featuring seven of the Tigers Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. The others include outfielder and #6 prospect Parker Meadows and infielder Gage Workman, who sits ranked #9.

ALUMNI REPORT: 2021 'Caps infielder Spencer Torkelson had a doubleheader that got all of Minor League Baseball talking, going a combined 7-for-7 with three home runs in the Erie Seawolves 15-1 and 6-0 wins over the Altoona Curve on Friday night at UPMC Park. Torkelson improved his batting average by 32 points in the span of the two games, and is now hitting .271-14-35 in 48 games after hitting .312-5-28 in 31 games with the 'Caps to begin this season.

Olson's Ranks Among Detroit Tigers Prospects:
 No. 8 (Fangraphs), No. 13 (MLB Pipeline)

Acquired by the Detroit Tigers on July 30, 2021, from the Milwaukee Brewers in exchange for LHP Daniel Norris, Olson was assigned to the Whitecaps after ranking third in the High-A Central in K/9 ratio.

LAST START: Olson enjoyed a stellar Whitecaps debut, joining the Tigers organization after a trade from Milwaukee to toss six scoreless innings and allowed just two hits and a walk while striking out four as the Whitecaps failed to protect a 1-0 lead, giving him a no-decision before rally for a 4-3 win over the Dayton Dragons on August 6 at LMCU Ballpark.

2021: Began the season with Milwaukee organization, going 5-4 with a 4.30 ERA in his second season with the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers before a trade deadline deal to Detroit. Struck out 79 batters in 69 innings before trade.

2019: Spent first full professional season with Wisconsin, going 4-7 with a 4.66 ERA as a starter and reliever with Timber Rattlers. Battled control to the tune of 47 walks in 94.2 IP with 84 Ks.

2018: Signed with Brewers after being a 13th Round pick of Milwaukee, passing on a scholarship to play baseball at Georgia Tech. Olson went 0-2 with a 5.23 ERA in four games – two starts – for the AZL Brewers in 2018. He walked four and struck out six in 10-1/3 innings pitched.

HIGH SCHOOL: Olson was a junior when North Hall High School won the Georgia State 3A Baseball Championship in 2017. The Bulldogs made the state playoffs again in 2018.

Throws: Fastball, Curveball, Slider, Change. (Regards CH as best)

According to MLB Pipeline: The Brewers were big enough fans of Olson coming out of a Georgia high school in 2018 that they gave him a \$440,000 signing bonus to get him away from Georgia Tech as a 13th-round pick. He was used in a piggyback situation at Class A Wisconsin in his first full season, posting a 4.66 ERA with 84 strikeouts and 47 walks in 94 2/3 innings. He returned to Wisconsin (now a High-A affiliate) following the 2020 layoff and was striking out batters at an improved clip (79 K's in 69 innings) before he was moved to the Tigers at the Trade Deadline for LHP Daniel Norris.

Olson's velocity will sit around 94 mph at this stage of his development, but he'll touch higher when needed. His slider and changeup both look above-average -- the former because of its break in two directions -- while his curveball can flash something similar. The biggest drawbacks are his delivery and lack of average control. The 6-foot-1 right-hander can get violent in his movements and looks like he puts a lot of stress on his throwing shoulder.

If not for those concerns, Olson has enough swing-and-miss stuff to profile as a starter. Instead, it's much easier to see him moving into a bullpen someday where he could really thrive with wicked stuff in shorter stints. It'll be on the Tigers now to mold him into a Major Leaguer in either role.

LAST START: Hill matched his career high by tossing seven innings and giving up three runs (two earned) on seven hits while walking just one batter and striking out five before the Whitecaps fell by a score of 5-4 in 10 innings to the Dayton Dragons on August 9 at LMCU Ballpark.
