LUG-NOTES

Robinson vs. the Whitecaps: Lansing starter Kyle Robinson made three starts against West Michigan last year. On May 6, he took the loss despite pitching into the 7th inning (6 2/3 IP, 9 H, 2 R, 0 BB, 3 K) in a 2-0 loss. May 11, he suffered another defeat (4 IP, 8 H, 5 R, Jack Penney two-run HR, 1 BB, 3 K) in a 6-2 Whitecaps win. And on August 21, the Whitecaps beat Robinson for a third time (5 IP, 6 H, 4 R, Izaac Pacheco solo HR, 2 BB, 3 K), 6-1. All three games were held at LMCU Ballpark.

Castillo vs. the Lugnuts: On the other side, West Michigan starter Rayner Castillo lost to Lansing on May 8 (4 2/3 IP, 7 H, 4 R, 1 BB, 3 K), 4-2, one of only three Nuts wins against the Caps all 2025. Castillo took a no-decision on June 13 (4 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 1 HBP, 2 BB, 2 K) despite receiving 20 runs of support, 13 in the 3rd inning, in a 20-6 West Michigan rout. And on August 21, Castillo was on the other side, outdueling Kyle Robinson with his best start of the year (6 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 4 K).

Congratulations! The first Midwest League Player of the Week was 23-year-old Lansing C/3B Davis Diaz, who batted .611 (11-for-19) while reaching base 16 times and scoring nine runs in five games at Fort Wayne last week. Diaz added four doubles, four walks, one HBP, and two runners caught stealing. He is tied for 1st in the Midwest League in runs scored (11, with teammate Bobby Boser), tied for 1st in doubles (5), 2nd in batting average (.480), 2nd in OBP (.606), 3rd in OPS (1.286), and tied for 3rd in base hits (12).

Miller Time: The most dominant former Lugnut in the Majors right now is untouchable Padres closer / 2022 Lugnut Mason Miller. In nine appearances / 9 1/3 scoreless innings this season, batters are 1-for-29 with a single, a walk, and 23 strikeouts against Miller. As Sarah Langs observed, Miller has three separate stretches of striking out at least 75% of batters over a span of nine appearances. No other pitcher in baseball history has done this once. Miller has tossed 30 2/3 consecutive scoreless innings, bringing him within three innings of matching San Diego's franchise record.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster now has No. 8 (Devin Taylor), No. 15 (Gavin Turley) No. 16 (Steven Echavarria), No. 19 (Zane Taylor), No. 26 (Nate Nankil) and No. 30 (Bobby Boser) on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects.

All Aboard: Shortstop Bobby Boser has reached base in all 12 Lugnuts games.

Milestone Watch: Lansing is 12 wins away from the 2,000th win in Lugnuts history and 3 players away from 1,000 players all-time.

Cooperstown Bound: 18-year-old Carlos Beltrán was in the very first Lugnuts starting lineup on April 5, 1996. Over the course of his ensuing 20-year career, he was voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series. This summer, on July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, becoming the first Lugnut to be enshrined.

Major League Nut: The 201st Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues, 2023 Lugnuts catcher Daniel Susac, has opened his career batting .563 (9-for-16) through eight games with the Giants. Susac debuted on April 1 and hit safely in his first five at-bats, setting a new Giants modern-day franchise record and coming up one shy of the Major League modern-day franchise record set by Boston OF Ted Cox in 1977. Susac was taken in the Rule 5 Draft by Minnesota and traded to San Francisco.

APRIL 18TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2014: Kendall Graveman, who would eventually go from Lansing on Opening Day to Toronto by the end of the season, pitched 8 1/3 no-hit innings at Beloit before No. 9 hitting catcher Jose Chavez reached on an iffy infield single to shortstop. Griffin Murphy relieved Graveman and allowed a single to Chih Fang Pan before wrapping up a Lugnuts 5-0 victory with a double play, ending the Nuts' seven-game losing streak. The game finished in 2:18. Because of broadcast difficulties at the ballpark, broadcasters Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Trey Wilson called the game by talking directly into his laptop computer's microphone.

2019: The Golden Cycle. Ryan Gold went 4-for-5 with a first-inning single, a third-inning two-run triple, a fourth-inning RBI groundout, a sixth-inning grand slam, and – after Dayton third baseman Juan Martinez dropped a foul pop – an eighth-inning double, becoming the seventh Lugnut to hit for the cycle in franchise history in a 12-4 victory over the Dragons at Cooley Law School Stadium.

In a Nutshell: Earned the victory (first pro win) in the Lugnuts' first win of 2025, pitching in relief on April 6 at Fort Wayne... promoted to Double-A Midland on May 20th, returning on August 1st... roots for the Philadelphia Eagles and the LSU Tigers... got engaged shortly after getting drafted in 2025... turned in seven different outings of at least six innings in 2025... piggybacked Zane Taylor in 2026 debut, tossing final four innings in 5-1 win, April 2.

High School: Played four years on varsity for George C. Marshall High School (Falls Church, Virginia)... named All-Conference First Team as sophomore, junior and senior... named Conference Pitcher of the Year and Conference Player of the Year as a senior: 66 2/3 IP, 1.49 ERA, 60 K... George C. Marshall is best known for the Marshall Plan, which saw the United States give \$13.3 billion to help rebuild Western European economies; it earned Marshall the 1953 Nobel Peace Prize.

Texas Tech: Robinson opened up his time in Lubbock as a reliever in 2022, appearing in 12 games (including nine appearances without allowing an earned run)... as a sophomore, was named to the 2023 Collegiate National Team; posted 5.36 ERA in 45 1/3 innings before finishing strong, posting five scoreless innings with eight strikeouts in the Big 12 Tournament against Oklahoma State to earn a nod on the All-Tournament Team, then limited No. 2 Florida to two ER in five innings in the NCAA Tournament... as a junior, led the Red Raiders with 76 IP in 15 starts, with a 5.09 ERA; struck out 11 in six innings at Oklahoma State on May 11, 2024... drafted following junior year.

Welcome to Pro Ball: Signed for \$150,000 after being selected with the first pick of Day 3 by the A's... made pro debut for Stockton on August 23, 2024 (2 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 2 K)... made three starts in total before Stockton's season ended, allowing exactly two earned runs in each outing... lefties hit .333 (6-for-18) with 1 BB / 6 K, while righties hit .273 (3-for-11) with 2 BB, 3 K... base-stealers went 2-for-2... pitched in the 2025 Crosstown Showdown, tossing two scoreless innings against Michigan State in relief of Yuniur Tur.
