### Playing Two

The Fightin Phils remain on the road for a season-long two week, and 13-game road trip, at New Hampshire and Portland. The trip starts in New Hampshire for a seven-game series, continuing on Wednesday morning. It is the seventh/eighth-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and second and third-of-seven at Delta Dental Stadium in Manchester, New Hampshire. Following this week, the Fisher Cats return to Reading from June 30-July 5 to finish the season series. The series series is tied at three as Reading took three-of-five games from New Hampshire at First Energy Stadium from Apr. 21-26. Please note, game two of Wednesday's doubleheader will feature Reading as the home team, since this game is being made up from Apr. 25 at FirstEnergy Stadium.

### Dropped a Slug Fest to Open the Series

The Reading Fightin Phils fell 9-5 to the New Hampshire Fisher Cats on Tuesday night at Delta Dental Stadium despite home runs from Bryan Rincon, Kehden Hettiger and Raylin Heredia. Rincon opened the scoring with a solo homer in the first inning, his seventh of the season, before New Hampshire answered with a two-run shot from Jay Harry. Heredia tied the game in the second with a solo blast, and Rincon later drove in Cade Fergus on a groundout to give Reading a 3-2 lead in the third. The Fisher Cats responded in the fourth when Patrick Winkel connected on a three-run homer to reclaim the lead. Hettiger cut the deficit to 5-4 with a solo homer in the sixth, but New Hampshire broke the game open with four runs in the bottom half of the inning, highlighted by Adrian Pinto's three-run double. Gabriel Barbosa took the loss after allowing five runs over 4.1 innings, while Chris McElvain earned the win for New Hampshire. Rincon finished 3-for-5 with three RBI and a run scored as the Fightins dropped to 16-17 on the season.

### Winning Ways

The Fightin Phils enter play on Wednesday with a 16-17 record, and with a doubleheader sweep on Wednesday, it would mark the latest point in the season that Reading has a record over .500 since the conclusion of the playoff bound 2019 season. Last year's team didn't claim its 16th win until May 25th, when they defeated the Portland Sea Dogs on Memorial Day Weekend Sunday. Additionally, Reading has not dropped a six-game series yet this season, with their only series loss being a three-game sweep by Akron from Apr. 2-4 to open the season.

### Makin' Moves

Entering the start of the series on Tuesday, the Phillies announced a variety of transactions to the Fightin Phils roster. Following a stellar start to the season, Levi Stoudt was promoted to Triple-A Lehigh Valley. Stoudt had not allowed an earned run over 10 appearances and 11.2 innings pitched. Additionally, Catcher Lou Albrecht will join the IronPigs, providing catching-depth for the Triple-A club. Joining the Fightin Phils will be Cade Fergus for his second stint this season and Pitcher Jean Cabrera will re-join the R-Phils after the 24-year old made 26 starts with the Fightin Phils last year and posted a 3.81 ERA. Additionally, Ryan Dromboski was transferred back to High-A Jersey Shore, clearing way for Braydon Tucker's return from the injured list.

### Money McFarlane

It was another stellar week for Phillies' No. 17 prospect Alex McFarlane against Somerset, as the 24-year old did not allow a run over three appearances and three innings of work. McFarlane has not allowed a run over his last seven outings (7.0 IP) and has not allowed a run in 12-of-13 appearances this season. He has also allowed one or zero hits in every appearances he's made this year. Amongst Eastern League pitchers with at least eight appearances this season, McFarlane is second in ERA at 0.73 (1 ER, 12.1 IP).

### Tale of Two Halves for the Pitching Staff

Last week's series against Somerset was nearly a tale of two halves. Over the first three games of the series, Reading's pitching staff allowed 30-earned runs over 27 innings, which was a 10.00 ERA. Across the final three contests of the week, the staff surrendered just seven-earned run over 27 frames, good for a 2.33 ERA. If you factor out six-Somerset runs on Friday, the Fightin Phils pitching staff allowed just one-earned run over the final 18 innings of the series (0.50 ERA). Reading's defense helped a ton too, turning an Eastern-League best nine double plays on the week, including three twin killings on Sunday.

### Hammering Homers

Last week's series against Somerset lived up to its billing, as the top-two home run hitting teams in the Eastern League combined for 20 long balls over six games, good for over three per game. Entering play on Wednesday, the Patriots still lead the league with 60 home runs and Reading sits in second with 51, while no other Eastern League squad has launched more than 42 so far this season. The Fightin Phils are currently pacing for 213 home runs this year, which comes after Reading hit 118 last season. The franchise record for single-season home runs is 185, hit by the 2016 team that featured Rhys Hoskins and Dylan Cozens.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

### Calling the Cats

New Hampshire enters play today with a 20-11 record, which leads Hartford in the Northeast Division standings by four games. The Fisher Cats finished off a five-game series with Portland last week, winning four-of-five; as they were victorious in the first-four games and dropped the season-finale on Sunday. After this week, New Hampshire remains at home next week and welcomes Hartford for a six-game series. The Fisher Cats roster features eight of the Blue Jays' top-30 prospects: Arjun Nimmala (3), Gage Stanifer (6), Victor Arias (12), Fernando Perez (16), Sean Keys (17), Javen Coleman (23), Cutter Coffey (25) and Adrian Pinto (29).

### On the Bump for New Hampshire

Righty Richard Gallardo starts game one of the doubleheader and is 2-0, with a 2.25 ERA over six outings so far, along with 25 strikeouts in 28 innings. Gallardo earned a no-decision on May 7 at Portland, allowing three runs over five innings, while recording a season-high eight strikeouts. Lefty Mason Olson gets the ball for game two and it will be his first start of the season. Over five relief appearances, Olson is 2-0, with a 5.84 ERA, along with 18 strikeouts in 12.1 innings of work. Olson last tossed two innings of relief on May 5 at Portland, allowing one run on three hits, with four strikeouts, while picking up a win.
