YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the RubberDucks, 13-7, to pick up their sixth straight win. Richmond opened a 4-0 lead in the first with a two-run double by Shane Matheny, an RBI single by Brady Whalen and an RBI single by Victor Bericoto. In the second, Matheny drove a two-run homer to open a 6-0 lead. Akron cut the lead to four in the top of the third, but Andy Thomas scored on an interference call and Yoshi Tsutsugo hit a grand slam to push the lead to 11-2.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. The two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond from May 16-21 and split another six-game series at Canal Park from July 18-23 coming out of the All-Star Break.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 42-26 in their last 68 games since June 18, the best record in the Eastern League in that span, and have gone 8-1 in their last nine games. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.99 ERA is third-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 478.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 643.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.82 ERA, which is the fourth-lowest in Double-A. Richmond hitters have homered 32 times over the last 16 games since August 22, which is the most in the minors during that time frame.

THE RUBBERDUCKS are 6-13 in their last 19 games, including dropping six straight from August 18-24 and all four games so far this week. Akron's roster includes two of Baseball America's top-30 Guardians prospects, including 2B Juan Brito (No. 7) and OF Petey Halpin (No. 22). MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects list includes six Akron players, including Brito (No. 6), RHP Tanner Burns (No. 19), Halpin (No. 20), LHP Doug Nikhazy (No. 26), LHP Will Dion (No. 27) and INF Milan Tolentino (No. 29).

Bullins (No. 19), Halpin (No. 20), LHP Doug Nikilazy (No. 20), LHP will Diot (No. 27) and No. Millian rolenano (No. 27). FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Hayden Birdsong makes seventh Double-A start. He last pitched on Sunday at Hartford and allowed four runs (three earned) over three innings in a no-decision. Among MiLB pitched (min. 90 IP) this season, Birdsong ranks third in strikeout percentage (34.8) and third in K/9 (13.3). Among Giants minor league pitchers, he ranks third in strikeouts (137) and 10th in innings pitched (92.2). He began the season with Low-A San Jose and pitched 12 games (10 starts). With San Jose, he led the California League in strikeouts (70) pirot to his promotion to High-A Eugene on June 13. With the Emeralds, he went 2-1 with a 1.55 ERA in his final six starts before being promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 4. During his time with Eugene from June 13-July 30, he led the Northwest League in WHIP (0.92) and ranked second in strikeouts (46). Birdsong was selected by the Giants in the sixth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Eastern Illinois University, where he played two seasons minutes from his hometown. Birdsong is rated by Baseball America as the No. 12 Giants prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com. For more information on Birdsong, see page two.

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Juan Zapata makes his Double-A debut. This season, he has pitched at three different levels in the Cleveland organization, mostly working out of the High-A Lake County bullpen. He last pitched on Wednesday for the Captains against Lansing and threw 2.2 scoreless innings. Zapata began the year with Low-A Lynchburg and pitched four games (three starts), going 0-1 with a 3.77 ERA. He was promoted to Lake County on May 7 and posted a 5-2 record with a 4.28 ERA in the Midwest League this season. He has also pitched twice for Triple-A Columbus. Zapata signed with Cleveland in January 2018 as an international free agent.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels are leading the Double-A level in total attendance (412,652) and average attend (6,348) this year. They are also 14th in the minors in average attendance. Last year, Richmond led all 30 Double-A teams in attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history.

PLAYOFF CHASE: With eight games remaining in the regular season, the Flying Squirrels are in first place the Southwest Division Second-Half standings, one games ahead of the Ere SeaWolves, who have already clinched a spot in the postseason by winning the division's first half, and two games ahead of the Bowie Baysox. Akron is eight games back in fourth. The winner of the second half in the Southwest Division will face Erie in the first round of the playoffs, unless the SeaWolves win the second half, which would lead to the second-place team (determined by winning percentage) in the second half advancing to the postseason. The Flying Squirrels are aiming to reach the playoffs for the fourth time in team history. They reached the postseason in 2011, 2014 and 2022.

DWER SURGE: The Flying Squirrels have homered 32 times in their last 5 games dating back to August 22, which is the most in the minors uring that span. Last Thursday in Hartford, the Richmond hitters comined for eight home runs, which set a new single-game franchise repord. It was also tied for the most homers by a team in a single game in a minors this year, even with an eight-homer performance by Sugar and at Albuquerque on May 7. It was also the most homers in an East-rn League game since the Harrisburg Senators homered eight times terie on June 18, 2006. In this week's series, they have homered eight mes.

YOSHII: Yoshi Tsutsugo has gone deep twice in his three games played in this weeks series against the RubberDucks. On Tues-day, he hit a solo homer. On Friday night, he hit a grand slam in Richmond 13-7 win. Through his eight games with Richmond, Tsutsugo is hitting .333 (9-for-27) with three homers and eight RBIs. Tsutsugo is the first player born in Japan to play for the Flying Squirrels in the franchise's history.


ERICOT BASHING: In his last 19 games since August 16, **Victor Bericoto** is batting .310 (22-for-71) with six homers, six doubles and 19 RBIs. On August 17 against Harrisburg, he hit walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning to cap a four-run comeback, which was tied for the largest ninth-inning comeback win in franchise history. Bericoto hit a game-tying homer in the last inning of Game 2 of the August 27 doubleheader at Portland. On the year, Bericoto leads the Giants system with 25 homers (16 with Eugene and nine with Richmond) and also leads the organization with 82 RBIs.

LONGBALL LOGAN: Logan Wyatt is batting .340 (16-for-47) with five homers, three doubles and 14 RBIs in his last 14 games since August 20. He has homered four times in his last 10 games since August 26. On August 27 in the second game of a double-header, he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer with two outs in the seventh to lift Richmond to a 10-8 win over the Sea Dogs. Last Wednesday at Hartford, he launched a go-ahead, solo homer in the top of the seventh for a 5-4 win. His 17 homers between Eugene and Richmond this season are tied for the third-most in the Giants organization. Wyatt also hit a go-ahead single on Thursday in the eighth inning to beat Akron.

GLOW SHOW: Jimmy Glowenke is has picked up 19 hits in his last 15 games dating back to August 23, batting .432 (19-for-44) with three homers, two doubles, 10 walks and eight RBIs. He started this most recent hot stretch on August 23 at Portland, when he hit a two-run homer and picked up two RBI singles, matching his season high with four RBIs for the game. On the year, Glowenke is batting .355 (39-for-110) in road games, including all seven of his Double-A homers, compared to .173 (19-for-110) at The Diamond. Since July 1, Glowenke is batting .315 (27-for-149) with seven homers and 28 RBIs in 47 games. On Monday, Glowenke was named the Eastern League Player of the Week for his performance at Hartford last week.

ALL ABDARD THE SHARE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base 71 times in his last 39 games since July 25 (38 hits, 32 walks, 1 HBP), hitting .277 (38-for-137) with seven homers, eight doubles, two triples and 28 RBIs. On Friday night, he had an RBI double and a two-run homer. He is now tied with **Sean Roby** and **Devin Harris** for third in Richmond franchise history with 27 career home runs. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 140 walks, ahead of **Ricky Oropesa** (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

PR0SPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 5 - on IL), OF Vaun Brown (No. 7 - on IL), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 12), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 16), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 17 - on IL) and RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 28). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and Jose Cruz as having the best changeup. MLB. com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23).
