SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

RUNS? HOW ABOUT NO: Over the first two games of this week's series with the M-Braves, the Shuckers pitching staff has allowed one run over 18.0 innings, one of 13 teams in Minor League Baseball to allow one run or fewer over that span... Prior to a run with two outs in the eighth inning on Wednesday, the Shuckers' pitching staff had not allowed a run over their last 18.2 innings of work dating back to Sunday's series finale against the Tennessee Smokies... In 23 games against the M-Braves in 2023, the Shuckers' pitching staff has allowed five runs or less in 16 games.

CREEPING UP ON 20: With a 115 MPH home run on Wednesday, C/1B Wes Clarke is now one home run away from becoming the fourth player in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015) to hit 20 home runs in a season... Clarke would join OF Corey Ray (27, 2018), C/OF Jakson Reetz (22, 2022) and INF Cam Devanney (20, 2022) with his 20th home run.

Since the All-Star Break, Clarke has hit 10 home runs, the second-most in Double-A and tied for the seventh-most in Minor League Baseball... Clarke is hitting a home run every 9.7 at-bats, the seventh-best rate in Minor League Baseball since the All-Star Break.

A RECORD-SETTING PERFORMANCE: With a seventh-inning two-RBI double on Tuesday, OF Carlos Rodriguez became the first Shuckers' player to record multiple hits in six straight games, setting a new franchise record... Rodriguez broke the previous record, set at five by OF Jackson Chourio, OF Sal Frelick, OF Brice Turang and OF Garrett Cooper... Rodriguez's six-game multi-hit streak is tied for the longest in the Southern League in 2023.

During Rodriguez's six-game multi-hit streak, he was 12-26 (.462) with three doubles and eight RBI... Over that span, he's raised his average from .268 to .285, a 17-point increase.

CLOSING IN ON THE RECORD BOOKS: OF Jackson Chourio enters today three home runs away from becoming the first teenager in Double-A or Triple-A to record 20 home runs and 20 stolen bases in a season since OF Delmon Young in 2005 with the Montgomery Biscuits (TB).

Chourio's 73 RBI are the second-most in a single-season in Shuckers' history (since 2015)... Chourio is one away from tying the single-season franchise record (74), set by OF Corey Ray in 2017.

PLAYOFFS? WE'RE TALKING ABOUT PLAYOFFS: Entering today, the Biloxi Shuckers would qualify for the 2023 Southern League Playoffs, their first appearance since 2019... The Shuckers have two paths to make the playoffs; win the South Division in the second half OR finish runner-up in the division if the Pensacola Blue Wahoos win the second-half title in the division... The Shuckers have a one-game lead on the Montgomery Biscuits and a three game lead on the Blue Wahoos for the division lead... The Shuckers would face the Blue Wahoos in the South Division Championship Series if they qualify.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP TOBIAS MYERS (6-4, 5.47): RHP Tobias Myers is set to make his seventh appearance against the M-Braves in 2023, and his first at Trustmark Park since a scoreless relief inning on June 11, his only relief appearance of the year... Myers has gone at least five innings in each of his last six starts, and allowed three earned runs or less in four of the six starts... Myers enters today 23 strikeouts away from his career-high of 146, set in 2021 in the Tampa Bay Rays organization.
