LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox shut out the Richmond Flying Squirrels on Thursday night by a final of 9-0 at the Diamond. The Baysox jumped out to a 3-0 lead in the first inning after a two-run double by **Frederick Bencosme** and an RBI single by **TT Bowens**. **John Rhodes** made it 4-0 after an RBI single in the third. Starting right-hander **Ryan Long** threw four scoreless innings with a season-high seven strikeouts. He and the bullpen combined for a season-high 17 strikeouts for Bowie's second shutout win of the season. A four-run ninth added insurance, including an RBI double from **Donta' Williams**.

SIZING UP THE FLYING SQUIRRELS

The Flying Squirrels enter this week at a 7-8 record after splitting their last two series, including most recently against Harrisburg on the road. Richmond is hoping to make the postseason for a third year in a row after falling to eventual 2023 Eastern League champion Erie last year. Richmond's roster includes six of the Giants' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline - RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), LHP Reggie Crawford (No. 8), OF Grant McCray (No. 13), OF Vaun Brown (No. 15), OF Victor Bericoto (No. 20), C Adrian Sugastey (No. 24)

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Hayden Birdsong gets the start for Richmond tonight. The 22-year-old is in his second season with the Flying Squirrels and will make his fourth start of the year. The right-hander is coming off his shortest start of the season last week in Harrisburg, only going 3.1 innings with a season-high four walks but he did strike out five batters and did not allow a run on 75 pitches. The Giants No. 6 prospect climbed three levels last season, starting in Single-A San Jose and reaching Double-A Richmond, punching out 149 hitters over 100.2 innings.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** is off to a solid start in his second stint with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect extended his on-base streak to 15 consecutive games on Thursday night and is one game away from matching his career-long on-base streak set back in 2022 with Single-A Delmarva. Beavers currently owns the longest active on-base streak in the Eastern League and has already surpassed his season-long on-base streak from last season at 12 games, while with High-A Aberdeen.

COUNTRY RHODES

OF/1B **John Rhodes** has done it all so far in this series for the Baysox. The Orioles No. 23 prospect is 5-for-12 in the series with two homers, two doubles and five RBI. He drove in four of the first five runs for the Baysox in the first two games of the series and hit homers in back-to-back games. This is the second time in Rhodes' pro career that he has homered in back-to-back games (8/16/23 & 8/17/23 with BOW). In his last five contests, Rhodes is batting .421 with an OPS of 1.395.

STRIKEOUT SAVANTS

Last night, Bowie's pitching staff of **Ryan Long**, **Dan Hammer**, **Nick Richmond**, **Kade Strowd**, and **Keagan Gillies** combined for a season-high 17 strikeouts on the night, surpassing the mark set of 16 strikeouts back on Opening Night vs Reading. Baysox arms lead the Eastern League in Ks with 190 (10.6/gm) so far on the season with 108 of them coming from the bullpen.

BRIGHT ON THE BUMP

RHP **Trace Bright** gets the starting nod for the Baysox today. This will be Bright's seventh career Double-A start and his fourth this year. The Orioles No. 16 prospect allowed a career-high nine hits in his most recent start against Altoona but thanks to four double plays turned behind him, he gave up only one run through five strong innings. The O's fifth-rounder in 2022 punched out 127 batters in 82.2 innings with High-A Aberdeen last year, which finished him fourth in the South Atlantic League, helping him earn promotion to Bowie in August.

BENCOSME BARRELS

IF **Frederick Bencosme** has barreled up the ball since arriving the Double-A level to begin the season. The Orioles No. 27 prospect is sixth in the Eastern League in batting average (.328), is third in hits (21) and is second in total bases (35). The middle infielder has hits in 12 of his first 16 Double-A contests, including seven multi-hit contests. Bencosme has also already hit three homers on the season after hitting only two all of last year in High-A Aberdeen. Only 21 years old, Bencosme was signed by the Orioles as an international free agent out of Moca in the Dominican Republic in August of 2020.

2024: Named to Bowie Opening Day roster. Struck out 14 batters over 8.2 innings in first two starts of year. Gave up career-high nine hits on 4/20 vs ALT but gave up only 1 ER thanks to defense turning four double plays.

2023: Began first full season in minors in High-A Aberdeen. Made 22 appearances (18 starts) and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 innings. Led IronBirds in strikeouts. Finished four in South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 10 batters in just 3.1 innings in 2023 season debut against Wilmington. Posted a 5.04 ERA in the first half but pitched better in second half of season, posting a 3.55 ERA with 62 strikeouts over 38 innings. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Made Double-A debut on August 26. Struck out five over four scoreless innings against Erie on the road. Went at least four innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.

2022: Debuted professionally with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27. Struck out three over three shutout innings in Delmarva debut against Lynchburg. Finished first professional season with a 1.86 ERA in 9.2 innings.

College: Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were fourth most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

Personal: Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with third round pick Nolan McLean. Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League.
