ELDS Game 1

YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Erie SeaWolves, 8-7, in 12 innings. **Jacob Heyward** won the game with a walk-off single in the bottom of the 12th. The Flying Squirrels came from behind four separate times in the game. Erie took a 1-0 lead in the first with a homer by Dane Myers. **Will Wilson** hit a two-run homer to give Richmond a 2-1 lead in the second, but Erie tied the game, 2-2, in the fifth. **Diego Rincones** moved the Flying Squirrels ahead with an two-run single in the fifth, but the SeaWolves tied the score again in the sixth and took a 5-4 lead in the seventh with a homer by Quincy Nieporte. Rincones squared the score, 5-5, with an RBI single in the seventh. Erie scored a run in the top of the 10th, but Heyward came off the bench to tie the score in the bottom of the inning. After the SeaWolves took a 7-6 lead in the 11th, Rincones brought in the tying run in the bottom of the 11th.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This week's set is the final series of the 2022 regular season and the SeaWolves' second visit to The Diamond this year. The Flying Squirrels dropped four-of-six at UPMC Park from April 19-24. In a six-game series in Richmond from June 7-12, the Flying Squirrels won five games, clinching a winning record against the SeaWolves in the first half.

TICKET PUNCHED: The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 24-41 in the second half. They are 18-33 in the last 51 games. The Flying Squirrels have won eight series, lost 10 and split five this year. Last week in Bowie, the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win of the second half. Richmond hitters lead the league with 1,467 strikeouts, the most in the history of the Eastern League, and rank fourth with 161 homers.

THE SEAWOLVES are tied for first place in the Southwest Division standings with three games remaining, even with the Baysox. If Erie and Bowie finish the second half tied, the SeaWolves hold the tiebreaker and would earn a spot in the Eastern League playoffs. Erie lost four-of-six in last week's series against Akron and split the previous week against the Baysox. On the year, Erie is tied for the second-highest team batting average (.247) and rank second in homers (173). Erie's roster includes eight of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Wilmer Flores (3), RHP Ty Madden (4), RHP Reese Olson (9), C Dillon Dingler (10), OF Parker Meadows (17), LHP Brant Hurter (22), SS Luis Garcia (24) and RHP Elvis Alvarado (27).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Kai-Wei Teng** makes his league-leading 28th start of the season and his fourth against the SeaWolves. Last time out, he worked 4.2 innings and allowed one run with seven strikeouts at Bowie on Saturday night. He faced Erie on April 21 at UPMC Park and allowed three runs (two earned) over 4.1 innings. He made two starts against the SeaWolves at The Diamond on June 7 and June 12, allowing three runs in each outing. Over his last eight starts since July 30, Teng has recorded 63 strikeouts in 38.1 innings. On the year, he is second in the Eastern League with 160 strikeouts. He needs eight strikeouts tonight to match Eastern League leader Reese Olson of the SeaWolves, who has 168 (Olson has the most strikeouts by an Eastern League pitcher since 2011, when Reading's Adam Hyatt had 171). Teng was originally signed by the Twins in 2017 out of Taiwan before being traded to the Giants in 2018 as part of a deal for right-handed pitcher Sam Dyson. **For more on Teng, see page two.**

TENG RECORD WATCH: For the season, **Kai-Wei Teng** has recorded 160 strikeouts, which is the second-most in a season in franchise history. He is five strikeouts behind the single-season record of 165, set by **Eric Surkamp** in 2011. Teng has walked 81 batters this year, which leads all MiLB pitchers and is the most in a season in team history. Today, he makes his 28th start of the season, which is tied for the most starts in franchise history, previously set by **Justin Fitzgerald** and **Craig Westcott** in 2012. Teng has hit 17 batters this year, a new team record. He is also Westcott in 2012 for the most losses in a season with 12.

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Ty Madden makes his seventh Double-A start. He last pitched last Friday against the Curve and worked four innings, allowing two unearned runs. After allowed four runs in his Double-A debut on August 13 at New Hampshire, Madden has gone 2-1 with a 1.03 ERA (3 ER/26.1 IP) in his last five starts since August 13. Madden was selected with the 32nd pick in the 2021 MLB Draft by the Tigers out of the University of Texas. He made his professional debut this year with the High-A West Michigan Whitecaps and went 6-4 with a 3.10 ERA in 19 starts before being promoted to Double-A Erie on August 3.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,121) and rank second in total attendance (385,603). Richmond is 14th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 161 home runs this season, which is fourth in the Eastern League. On August 7 in the 101st game of the season, **Riley Mahan** hit a grand slam to give the Flying Squirrels their 128th homer of the season, breaking the previous franchise record. Last year, the Flying Squirrels broke the team record for homers with 127 in just 113 games, passing the previous record of 109 from 2013.

CASEY AT THE BAT: Third baseman **Casey Schmitt** was promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 9. Dating back to his Double-A debut on August 10, Schmitt has the second-best batting average (.357) in the Eastern League, the eighth-best SLG (.545), sixth-best OPS (.940), second-most hits (40) and he is tied for the sixth-most doubles (10). Over his last 10 games since September 1, Schmitt is batting .386 (17-for-44) with two homers, four doubles and 10 RBIs. He has picked up multiple hits in six-of-his-last-10 games.

FITZ ON FIRE: **Tyler Fitzgerald** has 21 homers this season, which ranks as the second-most in a season in franchise history, one homer ahead of **David Villar's** previous franchise record of 20 set last year and trailing 25 by **Sean Roby** this year. He is the first player in franchise history to record 20-or-more homers and steals in a single season. After hitting .194 (55-for-284) with 15 homers in his first 83 games of the season through July 27, he is batting .294 (48-for-163) with six homers in his last 40 games since July 28.

BRAND NEW MAN: **Will Wilson** returned to action late last month after missing nearly three months with a broken hamate. After a rehab assignment in the Arizona Complex League, Wilson was assigned to Richmond on August 24. He hit .160 (4-for-25) in his first seven games back with Richmond. Over his last 13 games, Wilson is batting .250 (13-for-52) with three homers, a double, seven walks and eight RBIs. After going 0-for-9 in a three-game stretch, he had two hits in Sunday's finale in Bowie, including a go-ahead homer in the top of the ninth inning, added a solo homer on Tuesday night and hit a two-run homer on Thursday.

SHANE TRAIN: **Shane Matheny** has reached base six times in the three games of this week's series against the SeaWolves. On the season, he has posted a .377 on-base percentage, which is third-best in the Eastern League. He has worked 57 walks this year, which is tied for the sixth-most in a season in franchise history. His 90 career walks with the Flying Squirrels are the sixth-most in team history.

GO, DIEGO, GO!: Since returning from the injured list last week, **Diego Rincones** is batting .323 (10-for-31) with two homers, a double and nine RBIs. He hit a solo homer on Tuesday night and clubbed a game-tying, two-run homer on Wednesday. On Thursday, he drove in four runs in Richmond's 12-inning win over the Erie. Including his time on the injured list, Rincones is batting .347 (17-for-49) with three homers in his last 14 games since August 9.

SAY HEY: **Jacob Heyward** clubbed two homers in last week's series against the Baysox. He now has six homers in his last 21 games played, giving him 32 for his Richmond career, which is the second-most in franchise history, trailing on 37 by **Ricky Oropesa** (2013-16). He has also extended his career franchise walks record to 157. On Thursday night, he brought in a tying run in the 10th inning and added a walk-off single in the 12th, the second walk-off hit of his Richmond career.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Sean Roby** is tied for fourth in homers (25). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for 10th in homers (21) and tied for second in runs scored (74). **Shane Matheny** is third in OBP (.377) and tied for sixth in walks (57). **Kai-Wei Teng** is second in strikeouts (160), first in games started (27), third in innings pitched (129.1) and seventh in BAA (.246).

RING CHASING: The Giants have four affiliates playing in the MiLB playoffs this year, including Richmond. High-A Eugene has a 2-0 lead in the Northwest League Championship Series over Vancouver. Low-A San Jose was eliminated by Fresno in the California League playoffs on Thursday. The ACL Giants Black won the Arizona Complex League title with a walk-off single by P.J. Hilson on August 28. Eugene and San Jose both won their league titles in 2021 and Sacramento won the Triple-A National Championship in 2019.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Casey Schmitt** (6), **Vaun Brown** (14 - on IL), **Ryan Murphy** (15 - on IL), **Will Wilson** (22) and **Ricardo Genoves** (30). Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. Schmitt is listed as the "Best Defensive Infielder" and "Best Infield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Schmitt (6), Brown (10), Murphy (15), **Tristan Peters** (21), Will Wilson (26) and **Landen Roupp** (27). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 18 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 22 overall prospect.
