FIVE-RUN NINTH INNING SPURS SHRIMP

Tristan Gray homered for the fourth straight game in a row, José Devers added a three-run shot and Jacksonville scored five runs in the ninth to beat Durham 9-6. The Bulls scored in their first at-bats before Gray tied it with his solo shot in the fourth. The Jumbo Shrimp grabbed the lead thanks to Devers' blow in the fifth inning. Former Jumbo Shrimp Jake Mangum hit a two-run homer in the sixth and tied the game at four with an RBI single in the eighth. However, Jacksonville plated five runs in the ninth inning on only one hit, earning five walks. Durham scored twice in the bottom of the ninth, but the Jumbo Shrimp won 9-6.

SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through seven games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 28 runs, in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 12-for-69 (.179/.310/.290/.600, ranking 29th, 28th, 28th and 28th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position, stranding a total of 54 runners. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

GRAY'S ANATOMY

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Tristan Gray**, who played 331 games with the Durham Bulls from 2021-23, has been on a tear since returning to the Bull City. The Missouri City, Texas native has homered in all four games against the Bulls while reaching base multiple times in two contests to bat a combined 7-for-17 with a double, four home runs, six RBIs, walk and five runs scored. During his career with the Bulls, Gray batted. 233/.300/.474/.774 with 59 doubles, five triples, 71 home runs, 220 RBIs and 179 runs scored.

THE CHICKS DIG IT

It took into the club's second series of the year to hit their first home run, but Jacksonville has launched seven bombs through four games in Durham. In 2023, the Jumbo Shrimp finished in the bottom of the IL in home runs (T-15, 160). Historically, Jacksonville has clobbered more home runs on the road since rejoining Triple-A prior to the 2021 campaign (82 vs 78 in '23, 109 vs 74 in '22 and 81 vs 55 in '21).

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Outside of a 10-0 loss to Gwinnett on Sunday, all six of Jacksonville's contests in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have gone 4-2 in those affairs thus far. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

RAGING BULL

Dating back to last season, 13 of the last 16 games between Jacksonville and Durham have been decided by three runs or fewer. The clubs have nearly split these matchups decided by razor-thin margins, with the Jumbo Shrimp winning seven of those 13 closely-decided contests. From when the Jumbo Shrimp and Bulls first began playing each other in 2021 until this current 15-game stretch began on May 31, 2023, 33 of the 66 matchups between the clubs were decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville went 15-18 (.455) against Durham in those affairs.

TROY MEETS WORLD

Jumbo Shrimp first baseman **Troy Johnston** is coming off an extraordinary season that saw him earn Marlins Minor League Player of the Year. Johnston finished the season leading all of Minor League Baseball in RBIs (116) while ranking fourth in extra-base hits (67), ninth in hits (157), tied for 10th in runs (102), 13th in OPS (.948), tied for 15th in doubles (36) and 17th in slugging percentage (.549). Over 134 games between Jacksonville and Double-Pensacola, Johnston slashed .307/.399/.549/.948 with 26 home runs and 24 stolen bases, becoming the first Marlins minor leaguer since 2008 to post a season with at least 20 homers and 20 steals.

SHRIMP BITES

Of the 15 innings Jacksonville in which has scored in this season, eight have been multi-run frames... After coming out of the bullpen on Sunday against Gwinnett, **Roddery Muñoz** makes his first start of the season on Saturday in Durham. Last season in Triple-A, he went 1-3 with a 7.20 ERA in 10 starts. As a reliever, he was 2-2 with a 4.35 ERA in 18 appearances.

ABOUT RODDERY

-Originally signed by the Atlanta Braves on June 11, 2018 as a non-drafted free

-On July 17, 2023, the Washington Nationals claimed Muñoz off waivers from Atlanta. The Pittsburgh Pirates then claimed Muñoz on waivers on December 1, 2023, and after designating him for assignment, they traded him to Miami on December 20, 2023 for cash considerations.

2024 SEASON

-Made one relief appearance on March 31 versus Gwinnett.

2023 SEASON

-Between the Rookie-level FCL Braves, Double-A Mississippi, Triple-A Gwinnett and Triple-A Indianapolis in 2023, posted a 4-6 record and 5.42 ERA in 34 games, including 14 starts (78.0 IP, 70 H, 53 BB, 81 K).

-Last season in Triple-A, he went 1-3 with a 7.20 ERA in 10 starts (35.0 IP, 35 H, 26 BB, 36 K, .259 BAA). As a reliever, he was 2-2 with a 4.35 ERA in 18 appearances (31.0 IP, 28 H, 20 BB, 32 K, .239 BAA).

-Muñoz posted extreme platoon splits in Triple-A. He held right-handed hitters to a .217/.329/.357/.686 line in 170 plate appearances. Left-handed batters slashed .291/.418/.545/.963 against him in 134 plate appearances.

-With the bases empty, opponents hit just .213/.346/.354/.700 against Muñoz, but with runners on base, they batted .286/.391/.524/.915 against him.

-Tallied 41 K's with Rochester before posting three K's with Double-A Mississippi and 10 K's with FCL Braves.

2022 SEASON

-Split the 2022 season with High-A Rome and Mississippi, collecting an 8-4 record and 4.66 ERA in 22 games, all starts (100.1 IP, 97 H, 42 BB, 119 K).

-While pitching for Rome, left-handed batters posted a .795 OPS against him in 163 plate appearances, compared to a .641 mark for right-handed batters in 228 plate appearances.

-With the bases empty while pitching for Rome, Muñoz held opponents to a .224/.279/.361/.641 batting line. However, that swelled to .275/.370/.428/.798 line with runners on base.

2021 SEASON

-Went 1-2 with a 6.67 ERA in 2021 with Low-A Augusta (8 G, 6 GS, 29.2 IP, 33 H, 11 BB, 33 K).
