LAST TIME OUT: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats let their three-run lead slip away in a 4-3 defeat to the Reading Fightin' Phils on Thursday night. New Hampshire scored all three of its runs in the second inning. Damiano Palmegiani launched his 19th homer of the season. Alan Roden tacked on two more with a single up the middle, his 23rd and 24th RBI at Double-A, to make it 3-0 New Hampshire. Reading cut into the lead in the fourth on a two-run homer by Ethan Wilson and evened the score in the sixth on a solo homer by Baron Radcliff. In the seventh, the Fightin' Phils scored the go-ahead run with two outs on a Jhailyn Ortiz RBI single to right field off righthander Alejandro Melean. The 22-year-old Venezuelan took the loss after going three innings in relief, allowing six hits and two runs with three strikeouts. Starting right-hander CJ Van Eyk made his Double-A debut on the mound. The 24-year-old threw three innings, allowing three hits, two runs and two walks with one strikeout on 47 pitches in a no-decision.

HIRALDO IS HOT: 2B Miguel Hiraldo wrapped up an incredible month of August. The second baseman hit .333 (led team, T-3rd in league), with seven homers (led team) and 26 RBI (led team, T-3rd in league). The 22-year-old drove in half of his RBI for the season in the month of August. It was also the most RBI driven in by a Fisher Cat in a single month this season.

WE GO OUTTA HERE IN AUGUST: After Damiano Palmegiani's homer last night, New Hampshire matched its month-high with 38 home runs in August, which was third most in the league behind Reading and Somerset. The last time the Fisher Cats hit 38 homers in a single month was in May of this year. Miguel Hiraldo and Damiano Palmegiani led the team in home runs in August with seven each.

DAMIANO DAMAGE: IF Damiano Palmegiani launched his team-leading 19th homer of the season and his team-leading 71st RBI last night. The Blue Jays No. 19 prospect is third in the Eastern League in RBI, tied for fifth in homers, fifth in extra-base-hits, and second in doubles. The 23-year-old has a team-leading 29 multi-hit games on the season, which is the most since Samad Taylor recorded 30 multi-hit games in 2021. The franchise mark of 45 was set by Bo Bichette and Harold Ramirez in 2018.

ROCKIN' WITH RODEN & ROBERTSON: OFs Alan Roden and Will Robertson both enjoyed solid months of August at the plate. Roden hit .326 (2nd on team) with six homers and 16 RBI. The Blue Jays No. 7 prospect collected eight multi-hit games in the month, including his first four-hit and three-hit game at Double-A. Robertson hit .300 with five homers and 10 RBI. The 25year-old has already surpassed his Double-A numbers in AVG, HR and RBI from last year.

FRIDAY NIGHT CHEESE: RHP Chad "Cheese" Dallas makes his 16th start of the year and his third against Reading. The Blue Jays No. 14 prospect is coming off his best month where he posted a 3.58 ERA in five August starts, striking out 33 in 27.2 innings over just five walks. Dallas went five innings or more in four of five of those starts. In his last start against Reading, he struck out a Double-A high 10 in five innings on Aug. 9 at home.

NEWCOMERS TO NEW HAMPSHIRE: OF Devonte Brown, RHP CJ Van Eyk, and IF Abiezel Ramirez are the three newest Fisher Cats to be added onto the roster this week. Brown made his Double-A debut on Wednesday and picked up a double in his first at-bat. The 23-year-old signed as an undrafted free agent out of NC State in July 2022. Van Eyk made his Double-A debut last night, throwing three innings in his first outing above Class-A since Aug. 26, 2021. The former top 10 Blue Jays prospect did not pitch last year while recovering from Tommy John surgery. Ramirez, a former Rays farmhand, played only four games with Vancouver before earning promotion to Double-A.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (September 1, 2009) - Nick Gorneault (gore-NO) homered, doubled, and drove in three runs as the Fisher Cats won at Connecticut 5-2. Jonathan Diaz added a pair of doubles and Al Quintana also had two hits. In his first Double-A start, Andrew Liebel (LEE-bull) allowed two runs in eight innings, allowing the Defenders just five hits.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (73-61), off a series win over Washington, has a chance to make a move with the next nine games against three last-place teams starting tonight at Colorado. The Blue Jays will also play Kansas City and Oakland. Toronto trails Texas by 2.5 games for the final wildcard slot... Buffalo (64-63) has won four straight after a 4-1 win over Indianapolis last night. The Bisons broke the tie with three runs in the bottom of the sixth. Luis De Los Santos had a two-run triple in the frame. Paul Fry earned the win in relief of Andrew Bash, who allowed one run in 5.1 innings...Hillsboro swept a doubleheader at Vancouver (74-48). In the opener, the Hops scored twice in the fourth for a 2-0 win. The Canadians took a 3-0 lead in the nightcap when a double by Glenn Santiago cleared the bases. But Hillsboro scored four times in the third and won 5-4...Dunedin (59-63) split a doubleheader at Daytona Beach. After falling 2-1, the Jays scored twice in the eighth to win the nightcap 6-4. Jackson Hornung and Jaden Rudd had RBI singles in the extra frame.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats are on the road against the Reading Fightin' Phils until Sunday. Then, they will visit the Bowie BaySox for six games beginning Tuesday, September 5. The final home stand of the regular season begins Tuesday, September 12 against the defending Eastern League champions and this season's first-half champions, the Somerset Patriots.
