**Tonight:** The Lugnuts play the fourth in a six-game series against the Dayton Dragons stretching through Sunday, July 4, with LAFCU Fireworks following tonight's game. Lansing is 4-5 against Dayton this year, losing two of the first three games in this series after splitting a six-game set at Day Air Ballpark in Dayton in mid May. Right-hander **Jack Cushing**, drafted by Oakland in the 22nd round in 2019 from Georgetown University, makes his Lugnuts debut against Dragons northpaw **Lyon Richardson**, who was drafted by the Cincinnati Reds in the second round in 2018 and is Baseball America's No. 13 prospect in the Reds' system.

**On Deck:** Each of the next two nights will also feature postgame LAFCU Fireworks!

**On the Air:** Today's game is on MiLB.TV and streaming online at <http://milb.streamguys1.com/lansing>, with **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** on the call.

**Last Night: Dragons 4, Lugnuts 3 (10 innings).** Dayton second baseman **Francisco Urbabaz** hit a game-tying two-run homer in the sixth inning and a tie-breaking RBI single in the tenth, lifting the Dragons to their first extra-inning win of the year (in three games) and handing the Nuts their first extra-inning defeat (in four games).

**What's New in 2021:** Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

### LUG•NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

**Meet the Boss: Scott Steinmann** is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017). More info about the skipper can be found on the next page of these notes.

**Recent Roster Moves:** On Tuesday, pitcher **Stevie Emanuels** was placed on the Injured List retroactive to June 26 and the Lugnuts received a pair of pitchers in **Sam Romero**, who came from Extended and joined the bullpen, and **Jack Cushing**, who joined from Low-A Stockton and starts tonight in his Lugnuts debut.

**Roster Index:** With his appearance tonight, **Jack Cushing** becomes the 843rd Lugnut all-time and the 39th this year, the 26th pitcher. With that, the Lugnuts surpass the total number of players used in the 1999 and 2008 seasons (38 apiece). The franchise record for most players used in a single year is 54, set in 2017. Currently, about 18.6% of all Lugnuts are reaching the Major Leagues (157 of 843). If that percentage continues to hold true, we can expect seven of the 39 players to see time this year will reach MLB.

**Pre-2021 Alumni Report:** Yesterday, 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, became the youngest player ever to lead Major League Baseball in All-Star voting, elected by the fans to start at first base for the American League All-Star team, his first All-Star nod. Fellow 2017 Lugnut **Bo Bichette** finished runner-up for A.L. starting shortstop. Vladdy Jr. currently leads the Majors in OBP (.440), OPS (1.108) and total bases (191); and ranks 2nd in home runs (26), RBIs (66) and in runs scored (64); 3rd in slugging percentage (.668) and batting average (.336); and 5th in walks (50) and hits (96). Bichette leads the Majors in runs scored (66).

**2021 Alumni Report:** Outfielder **Jake Suddleson** batted cleanup and went 0-for-4 last night with a strikeout for Double-A Midland and is now hitting .242 with an .803 OPS for the RockHounds. Suddleson is one of four 2021 Lugnuts to have received promotions this year, with relievers **Aiden McIntyre** and **Jack Weisenburger** joining him in Midland and outfielder **Austin Beck** with Triple-A Las Vegas.

**Man of Steal:** Infielder **Max Schuemann** (Portage Northern H.S. / Eastern Michigan University) is tied for first in Minor League Baseball with 31 stolen bases, nine more than the Major League leader, Kansas City's Whit Merrifield. Schuemann is tied for second in the Minors with 13 HBPs and is fourth in the High-A Central with 39 runs scored.

**Hail to Arms:** The Lugnuts' pitching staff ranks first again in the High-A Central with a 3.74 earned run average, thanks to the Cedar Rapids Kernels allowing 21 runs in the last two games to West Division-leading Quad Cities. Lansing has worked the third most innings in the league (447 2/3) and issued the second fewest walks (161) and recording the fourth most strikeouts (512).

**Heavy Workload:** Lugs lefty **Dalton Sawyer**, who missed the 2018-2019 seasons due to Tommy John and so did not pitch in a game between the 2017-2018 offseason this year, is making up for lost time. Last night's 1 2/3 perfect innings was Sawyer's league-leading 20th relief appearance of the season. He has struck out 36 batters compared to just eight walks in 24 1/3 innings overall.

## TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

- 2011:** The Lugnuts collected 16 hits (four-hit games from Jake Marisnick and Marcus Knecht), including seven doubles, one triple and one Michael Crouse homer, but lost 7-6 at Great Lakes.
- 2012:** Kevin Pillar hit a dramatic two-out three-run homer in the 9th to force extra innings, but South Bend beat the Lugnuts, 6-5, on a walk-off 10th-inning single by Raul Navarro off Brandon Berli.
- 2015:** The Toronto Blue Jays traded Lugnuts 2B Tim Lacastra (.310 in 70 games, leading the MWL with 30 SB and 21 HBPs) and former Lugnuts pitcher Chase De Jong to the Los Angeles Dodgers in exchange for three international signing slots, allowing the Jays to sign 16-year-old Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.

**Major League Lugnuts:** Three former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 157 all-time - pitcher **Ty Tice** '18, outfielder **Josh Palacios** '16-'17, and pitcher **Taylor Saucedo** '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: **Carlos Febles** and **Carlos Beltrán** for the Kansas City Royals. Saucedo most recently debuted, tossing a scoreless inning for the Blue Jays on June 17.

**Record-Setting, For Better:** On June 15, **Max Schuemann** broke **Samad Taylor**'s franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

**Record-Setting, For Worse:** On June 20, **Stevie Emanuels** broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

**So Many Starters:** The Lugnuts have used 13 different starting pitchers this season, namely **Brady Basso**, **Reid Birlingmair**, **Jeff Criswell**, **David Leal**, **Stevie Emanuels**, **Richard Guasch**, **Rafael Kelly**, **Bryce Nightengale**, **Colin Peluse**, **Leudeny Pineda**, **Seth Shuman**, **Shohei Tomioka** and **Brock Whittlesey**.

**Familiar Settings:** 10 of the 28 Lugnuts active players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members **Scott Steinmann**, **Don Schulze** and **Anthony Phillips** all have experience in the league.

**A Pleasant Peninsula Surrounds You:** **Max Schuemann** (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut to hail from Eastern Michigan University in Ypsilanti. Earlier this season, the Nuts featured two Michigan Wolverines in **Jeff Criswell** (injured) and **Jack Weisenburger** (promoted).

**Finally:** Pitchers **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **Shohei Tomioka**, catchers **Jared McDonald**, **Drew Millas** and **William Simoneit**, first baseman **Patrick McColl**, and outfielder **Michael Guldberg** have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts

**Front Office Connections:** Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColl** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

**Clubhouse of Higher Learning:** The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman **Patrick McColl** played for Harvard, reliever **Michael Danielak** was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher **William Simoneit** spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

**Power Five Baseball:** The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (**Michael Guldberg**, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (**Brady Basso**, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (**Dalton Sawyer**, Minnesota); and the SEC (**Cobie Vance**, Alabama); and the Pac-12 (**Stevie Emanuels**, Washington).

**International Appeal:** In addition to 17 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada, North Carolina, Ohio, Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

**Representing His Country:** 1B/3B **Jordan Diaz** played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

**Teammates Then, Teammates Now:** Several of the Nuts are more than a little familiar with one another. **Reid Birlingmair** and **Charlie Cerny** pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons; though **William Simoneit** played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing **Colin Peluse** by a year, Peluse hosted Simoneit on his visit and convinced him to attend Wake. Coincidentally, Peluse was hosted on his own Wake Forest college visit by 2019 Lugnuts infielder **Johnny Aiello**.

**Welcome to Lansing:** Jack Cushing, the Georgetown Hoyas' career record-holder and single-game record-holder for strikeouts, makes his first Lugnuts appearance tonight after being promoted from Low-A Stockton on Tuesday... he is the 14th different Lugnuts starting pitcher this season and the 39th player overall... Cushing takes Stevie Emanuels's spot in the rotation... his repertoire includes a four-seam fastball, two-seam fastball, change-up and slider.

**Last Outing:** Entered in relief at Inland Empire, June 24, after Jorge Juan allowed three runs in two innings and aced the 66ers... tossed six innings of six-hit ball, giving up just one unearned run, no walks, and striking out four... only run allowed came in his final inning, the bottom of the 8th; with two outs, none on and Stockton leading 4-3, top prospect SS Robert Puason committed a fielding error to allow Jeremiah Jackson to reach; Braxton Martinez followed with a single and Caleb Scires delivered an RBI double to score Jackson to tie the game, though Martinez was thrown out at home on the play to end the inning and Cushing's outing... Stockton won in ten innings, 5-4.

**2021 in the Low-A West:**

- Began the season as the No. 3 starter in Stockton's rotation and blasted out of the gates with four hitless innings, walking three and striking out two, against the Modesto Nuts, May 6.
- Finished May with a 0.92 ERA in four starts: 2 ER in 19 2/3 IP, 7 BB, 23 K and a .147 opponent average.
- Struck out 10 batters in six innings at Rancho Cucamonga, May 27, allowing two hits, one walk and one run via solo HR.
- In June, posted a 4.71 ERA in four starts, with 11 ER in 21 IP, 3 BB, 20 K, .321 avg., though of the four starts, two were poor (4 HR in 5 IP vs. San Jose, June 10; 7 R/4 ER in 4 1/3 IP at Fresno, June 17) and two were outstanding (5.2 IP, 2 R, 8 K vs. Lake Elsinore, June 3; and 6 IP, 1 UER, 0 BB, 4 K at Inland Empire, June 24).
- Shut down right-handers: .221/.292/.379... left-handers hit .281/.288/.421... of 10 walks issued, however, nine were to right-handed batters.
- Opposing base-stealers were 5-for-7 in success rate.



**Going Pro:** Drafted in the 22nd round, 2019, signing with the A's for \$1,000... signing scout: Trip Faulk, who also signed the Lugnuts' Bryce Nightengale and Elvis Peralta, Jr.

**2019 Pro Debut:** Opened in AZL with two appearances for A's Gold before making 11 appearances, 6 starts, with Short-Season Vermont... in best appearance, 8/1/19, pitching five shutout two-hit innings at State College, striking out two... opposition went 4-for-5 in stealing bases against him.

**Traveling Childhood:** Born in Enid, Oklahoma - the ninth-largest city in the state - Cushing moved to Colorado for "several years" before his family relocated to Flower Mound, 28 miles northwest of Dallas, when he was seven... he grew up rooting for the Texas Rangers... Flower Mound is named for, yes, a flowering mound - a 50-foot tall hill nicknamed "The Mound," maintained by The Mound Foundation, which features dozens of flowers naturally blooming each spring... Flower Mound is located 28 miles northwest of Dallas, on Grapevine Lake... 2019 Lugnuts starter Sean Wymer also hailed from Flower Mound... in his spare time, he enjoys hunting, fishing and hiking.

**Glory Days:** Attended Marcus High School... named team captain as a senior, going 6-2 with a 0.73 ERA to earn the honor of District 6-6A Pitcher of the Year... was named to the Texas Sports Writer's Association Class 6-A All-State Team and Dallas Morning News All-Area Team... set Marcus H.S. career records in shutouts, ranking second all-time in wins and innings and third in complete games... tossed a no-hitter... played two years on the Marcus H.S. varsity football team.

**Hoya Saxa:** Attended Georgetown University, where he set the program's career strikeout record (236) with 11 K's in his final college appearance, 5/17/19 vs. Butler at Shirley Povich Field... set Georgetown's single-game strikeout record with 16 K's vs. Mount St. Mary's, 3/5/19... notched 87 strikeouts total in 79 1/3 innings as a senior in 15 games, 12 starts, leading the Hoyas with a 3.06 ERA... Named All-Big East Second Team, Big East Honor Roll, and Big East All-Academic Team... baseball greats from Georgetown include legendary scout Clyde Sukeforth, Doc White, speedster Art Devlin, and Del Bissonette... the only Hoyas to reach the Majors in the last 50 years: Sean Maloney (1997-98) and Tim Adelman (2016-17).
