Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds welcome the Iowa Cubs to First Horizon Park for the first time since 2019. Nashville is coming off a series split at Durham while Iowa split their six-game set at Indianapolis. Right-hander Janson Junk starts for the Sounds. He'll face Iowa's Caleb Kilian.

Janson Junk: 27-year-old Janson Junk is scheduled to make his eighth appearance and seventh start with the Sounds. The right-hander is 2-3 with a 3.86 ERA (35.0 IP/15 ER) in Triple-A. He's made one start with Milwaukee, taking the loss on April 12 at Arizona. His last start came on May 16 at Durham. He gave up a career-high three home runs over 4.0 innings in his second consecutive loss (9 H, 5 R, 5 ER). Junk was acquired by Milwaukee along with RHP Elvis Peguero and LHP Adam Seminaris in exchange for OF Hunter Renfroe on March 15, 2023. He spent most of last season with Triple-A Salt Lake, going 1-7 with a 4.64 ERA in 16 outings. Junk was originally drafted by the Yankees in the 22nd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of Seattle University.

Caleb Kilian: 25-year-old Caleb Kilian makes his seventh start of the season for Iowa tonight. The right-hander is 2-0 with a 4.97 ERA (25.1 IP/14 ER) with the I-Cubs. He made one start for Chicago-NL on April 29 at Miami (L, 3.1 IP, 10 H, 7 R, 7 ER, 2 BB, 4 K). Kilian took a no decision in his last start on May 17 at Indianapolis. He struck out three while allowing three hits and two runs (1 ER) over 4.0 innings. The Texas Tech University product went 5-4 with a 4.22 ERA in 26 starts for Iowa last year. He also made his Major League debut on June 4, 2022 vs. St. Louis and would finish 0-2 with a 10.32 ERA with Chicago-NL. The Cubs acquired Kilian from San Francisco in the Kris Bryant trade on July 30, 2021. He was selected in the eighth round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft by San Francisco.

It's Been A While: The Sounds take on the Iowa Cubs for the first time since August 25, 2019, back when both teams were divisional opponents in the Pacific Coast League. The teams were scheduled to open the canceled 2020 season at First Horizon Park. Though the clubs' Major League affiliates are just 90 miles apart, this is the only time Nashville and Iowa will play each other in 2023.

Turn Up the Stereo: Andruw Monasterio pushed his on-base streak to 23 games with a hit by pitch on Sunday. It's the third-longest streak by a Sounds player this season, trailing Abraham Toro (31) and Jon Singleton (27). Over the span, he is hitting .298 (25-for-84) with 18 runs scored, three doubles, three homers and 14 RBI.

Pat the Bat is Back: After a slow start to the campaign, Patrick Dorrian is batting .311 (14-for-45) with 12 runs, three doubles, four homers, 10 RBI and a 1.036 OPS across 12 games.

Clutch A-Jax: Alex Jackson hit another go-ahead homer for the Sounds on Sunday, his third such go-ahead blast of the season. Only Keston Hiura (5) also has multiple go-ahead homers for the Sounds in 2023.

Pitcher Perfect: The Sounds pitching staff boasts the second-best ERA in the league at 3.95, trailing only Norfolk's mark of 3.75. Nashville hurlers also boast the best WHIP at 1.32 and the fewest walks with 176. The bullpen holds the lowest ERA among relievers at 3.45 (214.0 IP/82 ER).

The Sound of Music: Clayton (not Julie) Andrews added another scoreless inning to his campaign on Sunday. The left-hander is holding opponents to a .155 average (9-for-58) with 22 strikeouts and a 0.92 WHIP through 15 appearances with Nashville. Among relievers with at least 15 appearances, Andrews has the second-lowest BAA and fourth-lowest WHIP in the league.

Rehab Brewing: Brewers infielder Luke Voit joined the Sounds Saturday on rehab assignment. Over two games, he is 0-for-4 with four walks and a hit by pitch. He is the fourth Milwaukee player to join the Sounds on rehab this season (RHP Adrian Houser, OF Tyrone Taylor, RHP Gus Varland).

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects, which has been updated due to the recent graduations of INF Brice Turang and OF Joey Wiener. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 623-539 record during an eight-season span.
