**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fifth in a six-game series at the Lake County Captains, the High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, continuing a nine-game road trip that began with winning two of three at Fort Wayne. The Nuts are 10-6 this season against Lake County, 6-4 at Classic Auto Group Park, losing the first two games of this series before winning the last two nights.

Yesterday: Lugnuts 6, Captains 5. Jonny Butler crushed a pair of two-run homers, Cameron Masterman went 4-for-6 with four RBIs and keyed a seven-run sixth inning with a solo homer and a two-run single, and the Lugnuts romped to a satisfying rout over the Lake County bullpen.

On the Air: Today's game is on MiLB TV and Bally Live, with a Lugnuts audio stream via StreamGuys, Adam Jaksa and Jesse Goldberg-Strassler on the call.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and Captains wrap things up tomorrow, leading into the four-day Major League Baseball All-Star Break. Then the Nuts return home to welcome in the Great Lakes Loons for a three-game series from July 19-21.

#### Lug•Notes

The Future is Here: Lugnuts right-hander Luis Morales, the youngest player on the team, represents the Oakland Athletics in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game today at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas. Morales, the A's top pitching prospect and No. 2 overall prospect, is the fifth active Nut in team history to participate in the Futures Game, joining Denzel Clarke (2022), Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (2017) and Ángel Perdomo (2016).

**All-Star Alumni:** Speaking of Vladdy Jr., the 2017 Nuts alum and 2022 Lansing standout **Mason Miller** were each named American League All-Stars; for Vladdy, this is his fourth consecutive All-Star nod while rookie Miller makes his first All-Star appearance, continuing a stellar first full season that has him in Rookie of the Year conversations.

6th Inning Slams: With Cameron Masterman's game-tying two-run homer last night, the Lugnuts have now homered in the sixth inning in six straight games dating back to July 5; over that span the Nuts have scored 18 total runs in the sixth inning.

**Got Your Number: Magnus Ellerts** leads the MWL with ten saves and has only allowed runs in five of 28 appearances this year – but three of those appearances are against the Lugnuts, giving him two of his three losses, including last night via **Brayan Buelvas**' go-ahead two-run double in the ninth. **Trenton Denholm** leads the MWL with eight victories, but he's 0-1 in four starts against the Lugnuts, allowing six of his 12 total home runs served up.

**Prospecting:** Lansing has four MLB Pipeline Top 30 Oakland Athletics prospects on its roster: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2, and the A's No. 1 pitching prospect), corner infielder **Will Simpson** (No. 24), tomorrow's starting pitcher, **Will Johnston** (No. 27), and outfielder **Brayan Buelvas** (No. 29).

What a Crowd! The Nuts' 9,917 attendance on July 3 was the largest crowd in the Midwest League this season, leading all High-A single game attendances this season. It topped all but one Class A team (Fresno), all but one Class AA team (Frisco), and was larger than 14 Class AAA teams.

## **TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY**

**2015:** Ryan McBroom continued a hitting binge with hits in his first three at-bats, giving him nine straight at-bats with a hit, before it ended one AB shy of the MWL record due to a sacrifice fly. The Lugnuts were swept at Fifth Third Field, 4-3, by Dayton.

**2018:** The Nuts erased a 7-2 ninth-inning deficit at Burlington with five runs – but then a power surge caused by a gathering storm shut off a first-base side light tower, causing a delay in the middle of the ninth. The Bees called for assistance but were told that the problem could not be fixed. Thus, they did not cover the field when the storm arrived with brief but heavy rain. 30 minutes later, the lights were fixed (by turning them off and then back on again) and the storm had passed, but the umpires ruled that the game was over. The rally was wiped away, giving the Bees a 7-2 eight-inning victory.

**No-Hit History:** On June 13, tossed five hitless innings, walking two and striking out six, before handing the baton to Grant Judkins (2 2/3) and then Colton Johnson (1 1/3) as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 no-hitter of the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the 4th no-hitter in franchise history and the first home no-hitter since April 2003.

**Hometown Hero:** Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands thus all root for Boston-area teams.

**Jupiter?** How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

**The U:** Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall, in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Path to Lansing: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings... opened 2023 pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of California League Pitcher of the Week with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... dominated in Lugnuts debut May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win.

- April 12 INF/OF Max Schuemann becomes the 185th Lugnut to reach the Majors, pinch-running for the A's and scoring the game-winning run in the 10th inning on a Lawrence Butler RBI single against the Nationals.
- April 20 Max Schuemann's first hit in the Major Leagues is a solo home run at Cleveland, albeit in a 6-3 A's loss.
- May 3 INF **Brett Harris** becomes the 186th Lugnut to reach the Majors, going 0-for-3 for the A's in a 3-1 victory over the Marlins.
- May 4 Brett Harris' first two MLB hits are homers in a 10-3 victory over Miami.
- May 31 P **Brady Basso** becomes the 187th Lugnut to reach the Majors, tossing a scoreless inning in relief for the Oakland A's against the Atlanta Braves.
- June 13 **Jake Garland, Grant Judkins** and **Colton Johnson** combine to no-hit the Cedar Rapids Kernels, 8-0, at Jackson Field. It is the fourth no-hitter (and the third nine-inning no-hitter) in franchise history.
- June 27 The Lugnuts beat the West Michigan Whitecaps, 3-0, in one hour and 44 minutes, the quickest nine-inning game in franchise history.
