

LAST GAME

The Boysox took down the Akron RubberDucks last night by a 6-2 final. Bowie's offense came to life in the fourth inning, as Heston Kierstad launched a solo home run, his fifth of the season and his third in as many games. The Baysox would add on via a John Rhodes RBI single, followed by a two-run double from Donta' Williams. Both Rhodes and Williams would collect an RBI in the eighth inning as well, when the Baysox loaded the bases before Rhodes was hit by a pitch and Williams walked in consecutive plate appearances. On the mound, Cade Povich started his second game of the season for Bowle, twilling five shutout innings with seven punchairs. The strikeout stuff would continue into the bullpen, as Bowie punched out a season-high 13 RubberDucks in the victory, restoring its record on the season back to .500 at 4-4.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Akron Rubberducks return fifteen players from a squad that missed the Eastern League playoffs via a tiebreaker in the first half, and finished just two games off the pace in the second half. In its inaugural series of 2023, Akron dropped two of three games at home against the Erie Sea wolves, falling in the rubber match 3-2 in 11 innings on Saturday night. Seven of the Guardians' top 30 prospects begin the 2023 campaign with Akron, including a debut Double-A stints for OF Petey Halpin (No. 17 CLE). Halpin hit .262 with six home runs, four triples, and 16 stolen bases for High-A Lake County last season and is off to a 3-for-12 start with a stolen base in 2023 as a tone-setter atop the Akron lineup. INF Angel Martinez (No. 10 CLE) hit .244 in 24 games for Akron last season and has continued to develop in the offseason, putting successful shifts together in both the Arizona Fall League and Guardians Spring Training. INF Jose Tena (No. 24 CLE) hit .264 in 127 games with 13 home runs for Akron in 2022 but did not feature in either of the two last games against Erie. The RubberDucks have four arms inside of the Guardians' top 30, including righthander Gavin Williams (No. 2 CLE) and southpaw Joey Cantillo (No. 19 CLE), the latter of whom was a 2022 Eastern League All-Star with a 1.93 ERA in 60.2 innings.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Southpaw Joey Cantillo is set to start today for the RubberDucks. Cantillo is currently the Guardians' No. 19 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline He is coming off an Eastern League All-Star selection last season, where he posted a 1.93 ERA across 60.2 innings and 13 starts. Cantillo only allowed 13 earned runs on the season, and struck out . Two of those earned runs came against Bowie in his lone start against the Baysox in 2022 - all the way back on April 20. Cantillo went 3.2 innings, allowed two hits and struck out eight, but walked a season-high five batters in the contest. His action in 2022 was limited when a shoulder issue ended his season in early August and he also had an oblique injury which caused him to miss over three months in 2021. In one start this season, Cantillo went three innings against the Erie Seawolves on April 8. He allowed one, unearned run on just two hits with two walks and four strikeouts. The Hawaii native was traded to the Guardians in August of 2020 from San Diego as part of the Mike Clevenger deal. Initially a 16th round pick in the 2017 draft, Cantillo features a fastball that has climed all the way to 95 mph since sitting in the mid-80s at the time of his selection by the Padres, along with a vulcan changeup that sits around 80 mph, in additon to a low-80s slider and mid-70s curveball

The Baysox have gotten a nice boost from the pitching staff so far in 2023. After having a bottom-half team ERA in the Eastern League last season at 4.42 and the fourth-highest average allowed at .245, the Bowie arms have turned it around to the tune of a 2.97 ERA – good for fourth in the Eastern League and sixth in all of Double-A. Opponents are also only hitting .162 (11-for-68) with runners in scoring position against Bowie this season

HESTON IS BESTON

Heston Kjerstad's solo home run in the fourth inning of last night's game was his fifth of the season - the most at the Double-A level. Kjerstad has now homered in three consecutive games and four times in this series. Kjerstad's seven extra-base hits are second-most at the Double-A level, while his 27 total bases lead the way.

GETTING STARTED ON THE RIGHT FOOT

With their four-run fourth inning last night, the Baysox have struck first in all eight games so far this season. Bowie is the only Double-A side to have scored first in every game in 2023






