YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the SeaWolves, 6-3, to trim their "magic number" to clinch a playoff spot and move them one win from clinching the second-half division title. Brady Whalen hit a two-run double in the top of the first to open a 2-0 lead. The SeaWolves took a 3-2 lead in the second with a three-run homer by Julio Rodriguez. In the top of the fourth, Ismael Munguia tied the game with an RBI double. Victor Bericoto broke the tie with a two-run double in the bottom of the eighth. In the ninth, Brandon Martorano extended the lead with a solo homer. Spencer Bivens took over on the mound in the fourth and threw the final six innings without allowing a run.

TUDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This series is the last set of the 2023 regular season. The two teams first met for a six-game series at The Diamond from April 18-23, with Richmond taking four-of-six. In their last trip to UPMC Park, the Flying Squirrels lost the first five games before winning the Sunday finale from May 9-14. The SeaWolves returned to Richmond and won five-of-six from May 30-June 4. Richmond can clinch a postseason spot and the second-half division title with a win tonight.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 45-27 in their last 72 games since June 18, the best record in the Eastern League in that span, and have gone 11-2 in their last 13 games. Heading into Sunday, Richmond had won a season-high seven consecutive games. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.95 ERA is third-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 495.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 658.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.78 ERA, which is the fourth-lowest in Double-A. Richmond hitters have homered 37 times over the last 20 games since August 22, which is the most in the minors during that time frame.

THE SEAWOLVES won the Southwest Division's first half and are locked into the postseason for the second straight year. The Erie offense leads the Eastern League in batting average (.247) and hits (1,098) while ranking second in runs (690), total bases (1,850), homers (169), RBIs (649), OBP (.337), SLG (.416) and OPS (.753). Erie's roster includes four of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including 2B Jace Jung (No. 4), RHP Ty Madden (No. 5), SS Danny Serretti (No. 16) and LHP Brant Hurter (No. 18). MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes five Erie players, including Jung (No. 4), Madden (No. 6), Hurter (No. 12), Serretti (No. 25) and RHP Tyler Mattison (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his 11th Double-A start and his first against the SeaWolves. He last pitched on Friday at The Diamond and allowed a career-high six runs over 3.2 innings and tied his career high with four walks issued. Among Giants full-season minor league pitchers this year, Bertrand ranks third in ERA (3.85), fourth in WHIP (1.24), tied for second in wins (10), eighth in BAA (250) and second in innings pitched (112.2). During his time with the High-A Eugene Emeralds from May 9-July 13, Bertrand led the Northwest League in WHIP (0.95) and BAA (196), held the second-best ERA (2.92), was second in wins (5) and ranked fourth in innings pitched (49.1). He began the season with Low-A San Jose and made five relief appearances. Bertrand pitched three seasons at Furman before spending his final two seasons at Notre Dame. Last year, he was an All-American with the Irish before being selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the MLB Draft. *For more on Bertrand*. see Dage two. on Bertrand, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Ty Madden makes his 26th start of the season and his fourth this year against Richmond. In his two September starts against Altoona and Somerset, Madden has allowed one earned run in 110 innings, a 0.82 ERA, and has 15 strikeouts. Over his first two starts against Richmond this year in April and May, Madden threw nine innings and did not allow an earned run, striking out 11. He last faced Richmond on June 2 and allowed a then-season-high five runs over five innings. This year, Madden ranks second in the Eastern League in ERA (3.55), fourth in strikeouts (140), seventh in BAA (240), eighth in innings pitched (114.0) and eighth in WHIP (1.32). Madden was selected by the Tigers with the 32nd pick in the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Texas, where he was the Big 12 Pitcher of the Year that season. He made his professional debut in 2022 with High-A West Michigan and went 6-4 with a 310 ERA over 19 starts. Madden was promoted to Double-A Erie last August and closed the year going 2-2 with a 2.78 ERA in seven starts. He made his final start of the 2022 season against Richmond on September 16 at UPMC Park and tied a Double-A high with four runs allowed over 4.2 innings. Madden started Game 2 of the Southwest Division Series at The Diamond on September 22 and allowed two runs, including back-to-back solo homers by Ricardo Genovés and Carter Aldrete, over two innings of work. Madden is rated as the No. 5 Tigers prospect by Baseball America and No. 6 by MLB.com.

PLAYOFF CHASE: With four games remaining in the regular season, the Flying Squirrels are in first place the Southwest Division Second-Half standings, three games ahead of the Erie SeaWolves, who have already clinched a spot in the postseason by winning the division's first half, and four games ahead of the Bowie Baysox. The winner of the second half in the Southwest Division will face Erie in the first round of the playoffs, unless the SeaWolves win the second half, which would lead to the second-place team (determined by winning percentage) in the second half advancing to the postseason. The Flying Squirrels are aiming to reach the playoffs for the fourth time in team history. They reached the postseason in 2011, 2014 and 2022.

POWER SURGE: The Flying Squirrels have homered 37 times in their last 19 games dating back to August 22, which is the most in the minors during that span. On August 31 in Hartford, the Richmond hitters combined for eight home runs, which set a new single-game franchise record. It was also tied for the most homers by a team in a single game in the minors this year, even with an eight-homer performance by Sugar Land at Albuquerque on May 7. It was also the most homers in an Eastern League game since the Harrisburg Senators homered eight times at Erie on June 18, 2006. In last week's series against the RubberDucks at The Diamond, they homered nine times. Richmond has four homers in the first two games of this week's series.

COMING UP CLUTCH: Of the Flying Squirrels' last 17 wins, they have scored the winning run in the seventh inning or later in 11 of them. On August 17, Victor Bericoto hit a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning the beat Harrisburg after Richmond entered the inning trailing, 6-2, tying the largest ninth-inning comeback in franchise history. On August 19 against the Senators, Sean Roby won the game with a walk-off scriftce fly in the bottom of the ninth inning the beat Harrisburg after Richmond entered the inning trailing, 6-2, tying the largest ninth-inning comeback in franchise history. On August 23 at Portland, Jimmy Glowenke hit a go-ahead single in the top of the ninth inning at Portland to give Richmond a 9-8 win. On August 27 in the second game of a doubleheader at Hadlock Field, the Flying Squirrels rallied after trailing, 8-6, down to their final out in the seventh before Brady Whalen and Bericoto hit back-to-back homers to tie the game and Logan Wyatt hit a two-run, pinch-hit homer for a 10-8 win. On August 30 at Hartford, Wyatt broke a 4-4 tie with a solo homer in the top of the seventh for a 5-4 win. On September 2, Will Wilson hit a go-ahead single in the eighth, starting a burst of seven runs over the next two innings in a 10-3 win. In the series finale at Hartford on September 3, Richmond scored five runs in the seventh to take a 9-6 lead and won by that score. On September 6 against Akron, the Flying Squirrels picked up a walk-off win in the 10th on an error. On September 7, Wyatt hit a go-ahead single in the bottom of the eighth in a 6-5 win over the RubberDucks. On Saturday night, Andy Thomas broke a tie with an RBI single in the eighth for a 5-4 win. On Wednesday, Bericoto hit a two-run, go-ahead double in the eighth in a 6-3 win.

WHALEN'S WARMING UP: In his last 14 games since August 27, Brady Whalen is batting .382 (21-for-55) with three homers, four doubles and 10 RBIs, raising his season batting average from .203 to .275. He has hit safely in each of his last 10 games dating back to September 1, during which he is batting .375 (15-for-40). It is currently the longest active hitting streak in the Eastern League.

MARTY PARTY: Brandon Martorano is batting .400 (6-for-15) with two homers, three RBIs and four walks in his last five games dating back to September 3. He has also homered three times in his last eight games since August 27. On Wednesday, he went 2-for-3 with a walk and a solo homer. Martorano is now tied for 11th in Richmond franchise history with 22 career homers.

LONGBALL LOGAN: Logan Wyatt saw his nine-game hit streak end on Wednesday. but over his last 15 games since August 20, he is hitting .340 (I8-for-53) with five homers, four doubles, six walks and 14 RBIs. On August 27 in the second game of a doubleheader, he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer with two outs in the seventh to lift Richmond to a 10-8 win over the Sea Dogs. On August 30 at Hartford, he launched a go-ahead, solo homer in the top of the seventh for a 5-4 win. His 17 homers between Eugene and Richmond this season are tied for the fourth-most in the Giants organization. Wyatt also hit a go-ahead single last Thursday in the eighth inning to beat Akron.

GLOW SHOW: Jimmy Glowenke is batting .345 (20-for-58) with three homers, three doubles, 10 walks and eight RBIs in his last 20 games since August 23. He started this most recent hot stretch on August 23 at Portland, when he hit a two-run homer and picked up two RBI singles, matching his season high with four RBIs for the game. On the year, Glowenke is batting .333 (39-for-117) in road games, including all seven of his Double-A homers, compared to .171 (20-for-117) at The Diamond. Since July 1, Glowenke is batting .295 (48-for-163) with seven homers and 28 RBIs in 51 games. Last Monday, Glowenke was named the Eastern League Player of the Week for his performance at Hartford from August 29-Sept. 3.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Since joining the Richmond roster on June 13, Shane Matheny leads the team in homers (11), RBIs (42), SLG (.449), OPS (.816), hits (62), doubles (16), triples (2), walks (50), extra-base hits (29), total bases (115), runs scored (43) and ranks second in OBP (.367). His 88 walks this year between Richmond and Sacramento are the most by a Giants minor leaguer since **Brandon Belt** had 93 in 2010. Matheny is now second in Richmond franchise history with 141 career walks and tied for fourth with 27 career home runs.

PRDSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 5 - on IL), OF Vaun Brown (No. 7 - on IL), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 12), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 16), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 17 - on IL) and RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 28). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and Jose Cruz as having the best changeup. MLB com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23).
