BULLS BROOM JUMBO SWIMP IN TWIN BILL

The Durham Bulls swept the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp 3-0 and 5-2 in Wednesday's doubleheader. In the opener, all three Bulls runs came in the second courtesy of a two-run home run from **Ruben Cardenas** and an RBI single from **Jonathan Aranda**. The finale was scoreless into the eighth inning. Both teams scored in the frame, but in the ninth, Durham busted out for four runs to blow the game open when Aranda laced another RBI single and **Tristan Gray** smacked a three-run home run. Jacksonville mustered only three hits between the two games.

MAY SHOWERS BRING JUNE FLOWERS, RIGHT?

Jacksonville finished the month of May by losing 15 of 21 games. The club's 10-17 (.370) month was their worst record in any month since going 11-20 (.354) in July 2018. The Jumbo Shrimp began the month in eighth place, residing just 5.5 games out of first. They closed the month having lost 8.5 games in the standings, as the club now sits in a tie for 16th, 14.0 games behind first-place Norfolk.

BROKEN BATS

Jacksonville erupted for six homers - their most in a home game since hitting seven against Carolina on June 4, 2010 - and 20 runs on Saturday, their most in a home game since at least 2005. On Sunday, the Jumbo Shrimp closed their set with Charlotte with a 5-2 victory. Since then, though, Jacksonville has struggled mightily on offense. The only two runs the Jumbo Shrimp have scored in their last 22 innings were unearned runs in which the extra-inning zombie runner scored via error and ground out, respectively. During this 22-inning stretch, Jacksonville has just four hits. They are 8-for-82 (.098) as a team in their series with Durham.

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 20 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 23-for-69 (.333/.418/.667/1.085) at the plate with five doubles, six home runs, 12 RBIs, nine walks and 14 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1% of his plate appearances during the 2022 campaign, Allen has whiffed just 18.0% of the time this season. His .202 BABIP is the third-lowest of the 193 IL players with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023.

THE BRIAN KING

Heading into play on Thursday, Jacksonville outfielder **Brian Miller** has reached base in 17 of his last 19 games. During this stretch, the Durham, N.C., native is 23-for-66 (.348/.436/.485/.921) with five doubles, two triples, six RBIs and seven runs scored. After posting an 8.2 percent walk rate in 2022, Miller is walking in 11.1 percent of his plate appearances this season. He has chopped his ground ball rate from 46.3 percent to 36.5 percent.

CHICKS ARE DIGGING IT

In the 11 games from May 14-26, the Jumbo Shrimp launched just nine home runs, tied for the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. However, over the last five contests, Jacksonville has blasted 11 long balls, including a season-high six on Saturday, their most at notoriously pitcher-friendly 121 Financial Ballpark since hitting seven against the Carolina Mudcats on June 4, 2010. Those 11 home runs are tied for the second-most in Triple-A over the last five games. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp's 60 homers rank in a tie for 16th in Triple-A.

THE MAYOR OF STARKVILLE

An offseason trade acquisition from the New York Mets, Jacksonville outfielder **Jake Mangum** has had an outstanding start to the 2023 season. The former Mississippi State Bulldog is 50-for-163 (.307/.341/.472/.813) with 11 doubles, five triples, two home runs, 22 RBIs, six walks and 17 runs scored to start the campaign. Among the 127 qualified players in the IL, Mangum ranks third in line drive rate (32.3 percent) while producing the 13th-highest opposite-field rate (40.3 percent). Those figures were at 28.2 and 32.2 percent, respectively, while playing for Triple-A Syracuse in 2022.

NOT THIS WAY

Jacksonville starting pitching seemed to find their footing in the middle part of April into May. From April 13-May 5, Jacksonville starters yielded 42 runs, 35 earned on 90 hits (8.2 H/9) in 98.2 innings for a strong 3.19 ERA. However, over their last 24 games, they've combined to surrender 90 runs, 87 earned, on 121 hits (12.4 H/9) in 87.2 innings for a 8.93 ERA. During this stretch, Jacksonville starters have walked 57 (5.9 BB/9) against only 64 strikeouts (6.6 K/9).

ABOUT JEFF

-A graduate of Illinois State University, Lindgren was mainly a reliever in college, starting in just 17 of his 83 appearances. He went 8-14 with a 6.02 ERA over his four seasons. However, entering 2022, he has already totaled 19 minor league starts in 36 career games, collecting an 8-10 record and 3.28 ERA.

-Jeff comes from an athletic family; His father, John, played football at Henderson State University in Arkadelphia, Arkansas.

-An alumnus of Illinois State University, Jeff followed in his sister Allyson's footsteps in attending school in Bloomington-Normal, Illinois. Allyson is a fellow graduate of Illinois State.

-Lindgren played for the Pensacola Blue Wahoos between stint with Jacksonville. In 2022 combine, Lindgren posted a 7-4 record with 116 strikeouts in 136.2 IP.

2021 SEASON

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .234 (59-for-252) with a .740 OPS. However, with runners in scoring position, Lindgren buckled down for a .211 (16-for-76) opponents' average and .598 OPS.

-Lindgren got off to slower starts in 2021; in the first and second innings, opponents batted .290 (43-for-148). However, in the third and fourth innings, often his second time through the order, Lindgren held opposing hitters to a .183 (25-for-136).

-When Lindgren got hitters in a 1-2 hole, they were just 7-for-71 (.099) against him with 33 strikeouts.

Interestingly, when Lindgren was pitching from behind on the scoreboard, he performed better, holding opponents to a .176 (24-for-136) average. When his team led, opposing hitters collected a .241 (27-for-112) average.

2019 SEASON

-With High-A Jupiter, lefties hit .297 with a .680 OPS against Lindgren. However, he held right-handed hitters to a .176 average with a .432 OPS.

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .275 (11-for-40) against Lindgren with a .626 OPS. With runners in scoring position, Lindgren limited opposing batters to .194 (6-for-31) with a .508 OPS. Total, with runners on, Lindgren posted a .188 (9-for-48) batting average against with an OPS of .471.

-At Centennial High School (Champaign, Ill.), Lindgren competed in both baseball and basketball. He served as the baseball team captain, helped win two regional championships and one sectional championship.
