the Durham Bulls (Tampa Bay Rays) at Coolray Field. It is non-save ninth last night (1.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 2 SO), the 12th of 18 games between the two clubs this season, and the sixth of 12 games to be played in Georgia. Today is Sunday Funday (presented by Georgia United Credit Union), as well as Chopper's 14th Birthday Celebration. The Commissioner's Trophy won by the Atlanta Braves following the 2021 World Series also makes an appearance. With a win, Gwinnett would snap a nine-game losing streak in series finales (last won 6-5 on 5/8 vs. CLT).

vs. Durham all-time at Coolray Field, including 3-2 (.600) through five meetings so far in 2022. The Stripers are 7-4-1 in season home series vs. the Bulls dating back to 2009, one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer including 2-0-1 over the last three seasons (2018-21).

JULY TRENDS: Through 14 games this month, the Stripers are 8-6 with a +4 run differential (outscoring 42-38). Eleven games have been decided by three runs or less.

- Dominant Arms: Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in July in ERA (2.70), WHIP (1.01), BAA (.204), fewest runs allowed (38), and fewest walks allowed (33).
- Struggling Bats: Gwinnett hitters rank last in Triple-A in July in runs (42), homers (5), slugging (.333), and OPS (.651). The team's .242 average ranks 22nd.

A JOLT FROM JENISTA: Greyson Jenista snapped a fivegame hitless drought (0-for-17) with a 401-foot solo home run to right field off RHP Jayden Murray last night. Jenista fell a triple shy of the cycle (3-for-4, 1 2B, 1 HR, 2 R, 1 RBI) in his third three-hit game of the season. In eight games against Durham, he's batting .360 (9-for-25, 4 2B, 1 HR, 4 8/11/21-G1, won 4-3 in 7th on Cristian Pache single). R, 5 RBI, 1.047 OPS) with two multi-hit efforts.

OFFENSIVE ODDS & ENDS: Hernan Perez has tallied three straight multi-hit games since 7/14 (.583, 7-for-12, 1 2B, 3 R. 1 RBI, 1.250 OPS), one game short of matching the longest streak on the club this year (Chadwick Tromp, 4G, 4/29-5/4). Alex Dickerson is batting .324 (12-for-37, 2 2B, 1 3B, 3 R, 4 RBI, .798 OPS) in 11 games in July. Ryan Goins is batting .367 (22-for-60, 6 2B, 6 R, 9 RBI, .891 OPS) in 18 games since 6/14.

KINGS OF THE "K": Stripers pitchers lead the International League in strikeouts with 886 in 89 games (9.96 SO/game). That's 19 behind Round Rock of the Pacific Coast League (905 SO in 89G) for the most in Triple-A. Gwinnett has not led Triple-A in strikeouts since 2011 (club record 1.223 SO in 143G). Kyle Muller (1st, 117), Tucker Davidson (T-3rd, 89), Huascar Ynoa (7th, 77), and Bryce Elder (T-15th, 71) all rank among IL leaders in strikeouts.

reached base safely in 50 of 61 games (81.9%) with a plate appearance for the Stripers this season, batting .261 (46for-176, 6 2B, 1 HR, 28 R, 18 RBI). He leads the team in stolen bases (19, T-7th in IL) and walks (43, 12th in IL).

TUI AT THE FUTURES GAME: Last night, Stripers manager Matt Tuiasosopo served as the third base coach for the National League in the 2022 SiriusXM MLB All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles. He is the first Gwinnett coach ever to participate in a Futures Game. The NL, led by former MLB manager Mike Sciocia, lost 6-4 to the American League (OAK's Shea Langeliers was MVP).

TODAY: The Stripers play the finale of a six-game series vs. **CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN:** Michael Tonkin tossed a scoreless extending his scoreless streak to 14.2 innings over his last 13 appearances since 6/5. It's the seventh-longest scoreless streak in the IL this season, a span in which Tonkin is posting a 0.61 WHIP (6 H, 3 BB), .120 BAA, 14.73 SO/9.0 IP ratio (24 SO), and four saves. Overall this year, he's 3-0 with a 1.84 ERA, 1.02 WHIP, .176 BAA, and teamhigh seven saves (7-for-8, T-6th in IL) in 28 outings.

DEMERITTE ALWAYS ON: Travis Demeritte has reached VS. DURHAM: Gwinnett is 66-61 (.520) in 127 games base safely in 174 of 206 career games (84.5%) with Gwinnett since 2019, batting .275 (196-for-712, 52 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 131 R, 140 RBI, 17 SB, .910 OPS). WALK IT OFF: Chadwick Tromp delivered Gwinnett's fifth walk-off win of the year on Friday with an RBI single scoring pinch runner Braden Shewmake for a 2-1 victory in the bottom of the ninth. It was Tromp's first walk-off RBI as a Striper and his third last-at-bat GWRBI of 2022 (also on 5/5 vs. CLT and 5/26-G2 at NOR). The win was Gwinnett's 11th walk-off triumph over Durham all-time (first since

THE ELDER STROLLS: Bryce Elder turned in his second scoreless start of the year on Friday, working 7.0 innings (6 H, 0 BB, 5 SO) in a no-decision. Over three starts in July, he's 2-0 with a 1.74 ERA (4 ER in 20.2 IP), 1.02 WHIP, .219 BAA, and two quality starts. For the season, Elder ranks among the IL top 10 in WHIP (7th, 1.19) and BAA (8th, .237), going 5-4 with a 4.78 ERA in 13 starts.

MULLDOZING: Kyle Muller notched his team-leading ninth quality start of the season on Thursday, working 6.0 innings (7 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 0 BB, 7 SO) in a no-decision (GWN lost 5-3). Over his last eight starts since 6/2, Muller is 3-2 with a 2.25 ERA (13 ER in 52.0 IP), 0.88 WHIP, .202 BAA, 10.56 SO/9.0 IP (61 SO), and seven quality starts.

• IL Leaderboard: Muller leads the league in strikeouts (117, 7th in MiLB) and ranks among the top 10 in WHIP (2nd, 1.08), innings (2nd, 94.1), CG (T-2nd, 1), ERA (3rd, 2.96), BAA (4th, .223), and starts (T-5th, 16).

DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING: Delino DeShields Jr. has FERGUSON DEBUTS: On Thursday, 28-year-old RHP Tyler Ferguson made his Triple-A debut, pitching a scoreless seventh inning (1.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 2 SO). He is riding a nine-game scoreless streak (9.2 IP, 0 H, 1 HB, 2 BB, 16 SO) dating back to 6/16 with Double-A Mississippi. Ferguson is the eighth player to make his Triple-A debut for Gwinnett this season (see "Players Used" chart on Pg. 2).

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... On 7/16, served third base coach for the NL Team for the 2022 SiriusXM MLB All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium ... Began his career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year.
