Jersey Shore BlueClaws (11-10/49-38) vs Brooklyn Cyclones (7-14/40-47)

Maimonides Park – Brooklyn, New York (opened 2001)

LHP Braeden Fausnaught (7-2, 3.81) vs RHP Jonah Tong (3-2, 2.85)

Series: Game 1 of 3 (Jersey Shore leads season series 10-8 of 27)

Last Time Out...George Klassen gave up one run in five innings and the BlueClaws scored twice in the fourth and three times in the fifth en route to a 5-3 win over Hudson Valley on Sunday at ShoreTown Ballpark...Simon Muzziotti, on a rehab assignment, had an RBI triple while Andrew Walling (since promoted) earned his sixth save of the year.

State of the BlueClaws...The BlueClaws won six of their last seven and eight of their last 10 games heading into the break...They are 8-2 since July 3rd, after they dropped the first two games at Wilmington on July 1st and 2nd...A win today gets them to 12 games over .500 on the season, which would match their high water mark (40-28).

Down on the Boardwalk...The BlueClaws are in Brooklyn for three games this weekend, their second visit to Coney Island this year – they went 4-2 from June 18th – 23rd, going 2-1 in the last three games of the first half and 2-1 in the first three games of the second half...They are 10-8 against the Cyclones this season.

The Newest BlueClaws (Hitting Edition)...The BlueClaws have added two new hitters to the roster, OF Jordan Viars and OF Pierce Bennett... Viars, a 3rd round pick in 2021 from Frisco, Texas, joins the BlueClaws after hitting .252 with 12 home runs and 39 RBIs with Clearwater. He had three home runs and nine RBIs in a May 30th game against Lakeland. At the time of his promotion, he was tied for third in the FSL with 12 home runs, first in slugging percentage (.491), and second in OPS (.846)... Bennett comes to the BlueClaws after hitting .249 with one home run and 23 RBIs so far this year with the Threshers, adding eight stolen bases. He was a 20th round pick last year from Wake Forest.

The Newest BlueClaws (Pitching Edition)...RHPs Luke Russo and Braydon Tucker (Sunday's scheduled starter) have joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater... Russo was drafted in the 16th round last year from Eastern Michigan. With the Threshers this year, he is 4-3, with a 5.13 ERA. He threw a career long seven innings with a career high nine strikeouts on June 26th against Bradenton... Tucker was named Florida State League Player of the Week after throwing six scoreless innings with six strikeouts on July 13th at Palm Beach. He is 5-2 with a 2.94 ERA on the season with 62 strikeouts in 64.1 innings. Tucker signed as a Non-Drafted Free Agent last year out of Lipscomb.

Onward and Upward...Four BlueClaws were promoted to Double-A Reading over the all-star break: OF Leandro Pineda (.260, 8 HRs, team-best 4 RBIs), IF Erick Brito (.263, 2 HRs, 14 SBs), RHP Eiberson Castellano (4-2, 4.12 ERA), and LHP Andrew Walling (7-0, 1.73 ERA, 6 saves)...OF Justin Crawford (.301, 6 HRs, 35 RBIs, 27 SBs) was promoted on Friday, July 12th but didn't play last weekend to attend the Futures Game.

JD...Jordan Dissin had three hits in the win on Saturday, his second three-hit game of the year...He had an RBI double on Friday, driving in his 30th run of the season...He leads the BlueClaws with nine home runs, six of which have come since May 31st...His most recent home run was on June 25th in Lakewood against Greensboro...Dissin was a 12th round pick in 2022 from Saddleback College (CA) after spending one year at Richmond...He went to Malvern Prep outside of Philadelphia.

Willie B...William Bergolla had two hits in the win on Saturday and another hit on Sunday...The 19 year old was in the Injured List and didn't play from June 22nd – July 8th...Bergolla hit .172 in April but since then, is 48-142 (.338)...He was the 3rd youngest player on a South Atlantic League Opening Day roster.

Touch 'em All, Troy...Troy Schreffler hit a three run home run on Saturday night, his fourth home run of the season and first since May 26th...He is now 7-23 in July and has two hit games in his last two starts...He was a 15th round pick in 2022 from the University of Maryland.

Hittin' Hendry...Hendry Mendez enters today on a 10-game hitting streak (16-37 since July 1st) and hit his first BlueClaws home run on July 6th...He had a four-hit game on July 4th, his first four-hit game of the year (and first since a rehab game on 6/27/23 with the AZL Brewers), while driving in four of the BlueClaws 15 runs...He has four multi-hit games since July 1st (he had one between May 30th and July 2nd)...The 20 year old came to the Phillies with Reading IF Robert Moore for Brewers IF Oliver Dunn in November.

The Hittin' Hawkeye...Keaton Anthony, who signed out of the University of Iowa last year, had the game-winning RBI single in the bottom of the eighth inning on Thursday night...His nine-game hitting streak (14-31) was snapped on Friday but he is 17-46 (four doubles, 10 RBIs) with the BlueClaws, with five multi-hit games including a three-hit game on June 28th, since arriving on June 25th from Clearwater...He drove in four runs in the win on July 10th against Hudson Valley...He was hitting .322 in 44 games with Clearwater, adding four home runs and 21 RBIs, and drew 28 walks in 186 plate appearances while striking out only 28 times...At the time of his promotion, led the Florida State League in OBP (.446) and OPS (.916) while third in SLG (.470) and fourth in BA (.322)...He signed as an NDFC from the University of Iowa in 2023 after three years with the Hawkeyes.

Super Mari...Emaarion Boyd has been at the forefront of both BlueClaws walk-off wins this year...On Tuesday, his two-run walk-off single won the game in the ninth...On Opening Night (April 5th) he tied the game with a triple in the ninth and scored the winner on a wild pitch...Boyd is now 10-31 so far in July and 28-94 (.298) since June 6th...He hit his second home run of the season on July 6th against Wilmington, a three run shot in the first inning...His other homer was a grand slam on June 9th at Greensboro.

Going, Going, Gone...The four BlueClaws home runs hit on July 6th (Boyd, Crawford, Mendez, Pineda), were one off the BlueClaws record for most home runs in a game at ShoreTown Ballpark...They hit five home runs against Brooklyn on June 6, 2021 (one each by Logan O'Hoppe, Jhailyn Ortiz, Jose Tortolero, Nate Fassnacht, and Hunter Hearn)...The BlueClaws now have 29 home runs at ShoreTown Ballpark this season.

Paxton on the Mark...RHP Paxton Thompson joined the BlueClaws on July 2nd and has thrown 4.1 scoreless innings with Jersey Shore so far, a scoreless inning on Saturday...He threw two scoreless innings on July 3rd in his BlueClaws debut...He joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater where he 1-2 with a 3.62 ERA in 19 appearances...He struck out 30 and walked nine in 27.1 innings with the Threshers...Thompson signed with the Phillies last year from UNC-Charlotte where he helped them reach the NCAA Tournament last year and he threw three scoreless innings in the Regionals to eliminate #3 Clemson.

Going Going Gone...The BlueClaws (30 HRs in Lakewood and 30 on the road) got a home run from Troy Schreffler on July 13th...They hit four home runs on July 6th against Wilmington – one each from Emaarion Boyd, Justin Crawford, Hendry Mendez, and Leandro Pineda... Aidan Miller hit a leadoff home run in the game on July 4th...Jordan Dissin leads the team with nine and Leandro Pineda has eight...Felix Reyes has five, four since June 16th...William Bergolla hit his first professional home run on June 8th at Greensboro.

Hitting Triple Digits...A South Atlantic League starting pitcher has thrown 100 pitches seven times in a game this season – all seven are BlueClaws...Sam Aldegheri has done it three times (including 103 on June 13th). Jean Cabrera has done it three times (including a league-high 110 on Wednesday at Brooklyn), and Braeden Fausnaught has done it once...Cabrera's 110 pitches are the most by a BlueClaw since Nick Fanti threw 113 in two no-hitters in 2017 (7/17 vs CHA, 26 outs in a 5/6/17 no-hitter at COL), not including Matt Russell, who threw 125 pitches in eight innings against ABD in 2022 but pitched three innings in April and the remaining five in June after the game was suspended.

Save Index...Daniel Harper (now with Reading) leads the BlueClaws with seven saves and earned his seventh on June 19th at Brooklyn...Andrew Walling (now with Reading) earned his sixth save of the year in the win on July 14th... Gunner Mayer has three while Charles King has two.

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws have two walk-off wins this year – July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and pril 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch)...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva.

The Comeback Claws...Jersey Shore erased a 5-0 deficit on June 8th at Greensboro and a 4-0 deficit on June 15th to come back and beat Wilmington...On June 15th, Troy Schreffler doubled home two runs to tie the game and Justin Crawford gave the BlueClaws the lead with a line drive RBI single to centerfield...Their largest comeback win last year was six (5/24/23 at Aberdeen in a game they trailed 8-2 and won 12-10).

Just Grand...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they have three grand slams since May 30th – one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...Boyd's home run was the second of his career while Dissin's was his sixth home run of the season.

Trying For Back to Back...The BlueClaws have only made the playoffs in back to back years once – in 2009 and 2010, both SAL Championship seasons...They have a chance to do so again this year after reaching the SAL Northern Division Championship Series last year.

Youth Is Served...Per Baseball America, the BlueClaws have five of the 25 youngest players in the South Atlantic League (based on Opening Day rosters of 360 players): William Bergolla (3rd youngest), Bryan Rincon (9th), Justin Crawford (11th), Hendry Mendez (17th), and Emmaarion Boyd (21st).

In the First Round...Aidan Miller is the 16th former first-round pick to play for the BlueClaws and the fifth to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A team...(his teammate Justin Crawford in 2024, Andrew Painter and Mick Abel in 2022 and Bryson Stott in 2021)... Since 2000, the only two Phillies first round picks not to play for the BlueClaws are Joe Savery (2007) and Aaron Nola (2014) plus 2023 first-round pick Aidan Miller, who is currently with Clearwater.

Go Phils...The BlueClaws have several players that grew up Phillies fans: C Jordan Dissin (went to Malvern Prep in Philadelphia, 27 miles from Citizens Bank Park), OF Troy Schreffler (from Harrisburg), and LHP Braeden Fausnaught (from Danville and went to West Chester University).

From The Shore to the Show...123 players have now gone *From the Shore, to the Show* including one this year (Ben Brown, Cubs)...Three debuted in 2023 – James McArthur with the Royals, Johan Rojas with the Phillies, and Orion Kerkering with the Phillies...Kerkering, who was with the BlueClaws from May 9th through July 6th, is the only player to play for the BlueClaws and Phillies in the same year.

On the Staff...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2024 after leading the BlueClaws to the playoffs and a league-best 73-58 mark in 2023...Pitching coach Brad Bergesen is in Lakewood for a third time (2018 and 2022) and is joined as a pitching coach by first-year Phillies coach Matt Ellmyer...Hitting coach Adam Lind hit 200 big league home runs and is in his first year as a coach...Position coach Orlando Munoz is in his first year with the BlueClaws after managing the DSL Phillies since 2017...Development coach Beth Greenwood is the first BlueClaws female position coach and a member of Team USA Women's National Baseball Team.

Career Notes: Spent the season with Clearwater, going 2-4, 4.57 in 24 games and seven starts and had a 64-39 K-BB ratio in 63 innings pitched...Played winter ball for the Adelaide Giants of the Australian Baseball League...Threw a season-long six innings (1 uER with eight strikeouts) on 8/24 at Lakeland...Played for the Trenton Thunder in the MLB Draft League before signing with the Phillies...Went to West Chester (PA), the same school to produce 2023 BlueClaws IF Nick Ward.
