Today: The Lugnuts open a six-game series at Fort Wayne against the TinCaps, the first meetings of 12 between the two squads this year. The TinCaps are coming off back-to-back road series wins at Lake County and Dayton, while the Nuts enter play tonight after winning four of seven last week against the Captains.

Starting Matchup: The Lugnuts send right-hander Christian Fernandez, acquired via trade from Tampa Bay last season for Christian Bethancourt, against the reigning Midwest League Pitcher of the Week, right-hander Jairo Iriarte, who delivered the first six innings of a no-hitter in his last start.

Sunday: Lugnuts 3, Captains 2. Lansing walked off Lake County for the second consecutive game, thanks to Alex Campos's two-out RBI single in the bottom of the ninth off Tyler Thornton, helping the Nuts win the rubber match in an unusual seven-game series (with one game added to make up for an April postponement in Eastlake, Ohio).

On the Air: Today's game is available on Bally Live and MiLB TV with John Nolan, and via StreamGuys with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play Fort Wayne through Sunday, enjoy a day off, and then return to Jackson Field to host the Cedar Rapids Kernels in a series ending May and beginning June.

Lug•Notes

On the Edge of Our Seat: With Sunday's dramatics, the Nuts have now walked off six times in 25 home games this year - twice against Lake County, twice against Dayton and twice against Quad Cities (and weirdly four times by the final score of 6-5). Looking back on recent Lugnuts seasons, walkoffs by year: 6 in 2023, 5 in 2022, 4 in 2021, 2 in 2019, 6 in 2018, 5 in 2017, 5 in 2016, 1 in 2015, 5 in 2013, 4 in 2012, 8 in 2011, and 8 in 2010.

Streaking: 1B/OF Danny Bautista, Jr., went 1-for-4 with an RBI single on Sunday to extend his hitting streak to eight games, giving him with the longest hitting streak for a Lugnut this season, breaking a four-way tie with Lazaro Armenteros, Daniel Susac and Jack Winkler. Bautista, Jr., batted 9-for-25, .360, against Lake County

Seventh Heaven: Seven times this season a Midwest League starting pitcher has tossed seven innings. (No one has yet pitched longer than seven innings). Of those seven occasions, two were supplied by Lansing right-handers: **Blake Beers** on May 13 at West Michigan and **Jake Garland** on May 18 vs. Lake County. Garland's 10 strikeouts in his Lugnuts debut on Thursday were one behind the highest single-game strikeout total recorded by an MWL pitcher this year (Quad Cities' Noah Cameron, who has twice whiffed 11 in a game).

Other Notables From the Lake County Series:

- * In his last start, catcher **Daniel Susac** went 4-for-4 on Saturday, tying **Caeden Trenkle**'s four-hit performance from earlier this year for the most hits by a Lugnut in a game this season. The outing also set a professional high for Susac for hits in one game; the former Arizona Wildcat had six four-hit games in college. Second baseman Sahid Valenzuela became the first Lugnut to reach base five times in a game on Saturday, going 3-for-3 with two walks and three runs scored After opening the season 2-for-15, Valenzuela has 18 hits in his last 48 at-bats, a .375 batting average
- * Infielder Jack Winkler finished the series blazing hot, reaching base three times apiece in each of the final three games. In the process, Winkler vaulted his batting average from .212 to .250 and his OPS from .597 to .673.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old Max Muncy was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old Daniel Susac was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padrés, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and Alexander Campos (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2014: An ugly one at Parkview Field: The TinCaps built a 6-1 lead with three runs in each of the first two innings, gave up four runs in the third (including an L.B. Dantzler three-run homer) to narrow the score to 6-5, and then broke the game open with a six-run bottom of the third that saw starter Matt Dermody and manager John Tamargo, Jr., get ejected after Dermody drilled Dustin Peterson purposefully, followed by a member of the TinCaps in the home dugout shouting at Dermody as he walked past on his way back to the clubhouse (the path to the clubhouse leads directly past the dugout at Parkview). Tamargo got involved, shouting back, and the two sides needed to be separated. The TinCaps went on to romp, 17-6, scoring in seven of their eight at-bats (blanked in only the sixth).

2018: In 1:56, the South Bend Cubs beat the Lugnuts, 1-0, on a Miguel Amaya leadoff home run in the bottom of the eighth at Four Winds Field. Nuts starter Zach Logue pitched eight innings, striking out four. The Cubs' Brendon Little allowed three hits in seven innings, striking out five.

Life as a Lugnut in 2022: Assigned to Lansing on July 10, 2022, after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays with Triple-A outfielder Cal Stevenson on July 9 for Christian Bethancourt... debuted for the Nuts on July 13 at Fort Wayne, looking great with a 1-2-3 first inning before allowing three runs on three singles and two walks in the second inning and then a fourth run in the third inning on two singles sandwiched around a wild pitch... after delay due to All-Star Break, made second start on July 27th, allowing seven runs at Great Lakes in two innings (four runs in 1st, three in 2nd... gave up leadoff home run in each frame (Eddys Leonard, Edwin Mateo)... impressed with five hitless innings at Dayton, August 10th.

The Early Word: When announcing the trade with the Rays, Athletics general manager Dan Feinstein summed up Fernandez to the media, "A four-pitch mix. Fastball averages 93. Three really good off-speed pitches. The change-up is probably the best one. Has the ability to get swings andmisses, plus a slider and curve ball." Feinstein also informed the media that Fernandez missed the 2021 season with an unspecified arm injury.

Home Cooking: Home of Cabimas is located in northwestern Venezuela on the shore of Maracaibo Lake in the state of Zulia... notables from Cabimas include MLB ace Pablo López and longtime Major Leaguer Vic Davalillo (1963-1980).

Path Through the Pros: Debuted in 2016 in Dominican Summer League working entirely out of the bullpen... converted to starting pitcher in 2017 DSL with greater success... split 2018 between DSL and Gulf Coast League... spent 2019 in Appalachian League... missed 2020 (canceled MiLB season) and 2021 (injury).

2022 Dominance in the Rays' System: Opened this season as a middle reliever in the Charleston RiverDogs bullpen, striking out five in 2 1/3 innings vs. Myrtle Beach on April 10 in season debut; it had been 958 days since his last MiLB appearance on August 27, 2019... pitched out of the bullpen through late May, peaking in final appearance with eight strikeouts in four innings vs. August, May 20... moved into the starting rotation May 26 vs. Delmarva and responded with four scoreless innings, six strikeouts... made five starts in June: 3.27 ERA, 22 IP, 10 BB, 30 K, .195 avg. ... in two starts in July: 2.79 ERA, 9 2/3 IP, 3 BB, 10 K, .263 avg. ... excelled at home (33 2/3 IP, 2.14 ERA, .197 avg., 1 HR) compared to road (24 1/3 IP, 3.70 ERA, .207 avg., 5 HR)... because of change-up, very tough on lefties (.179, 0 HR) vs. righties (.223, 5 HR)... limited opposition to .179 avg. with runners in scoring position.
