NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

- 2026 has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.
- Of 15 series played this season, Omaha has won 5, lost 7 and split 3 ... the Storm Chasers have a 2-6 record over their last 8 games coming off a series loss to Indianapolis last week and dropping the first 3 games against Louisville.
 - Omaha went 13-12 in April ... with a 13-14 record in May and 10-15 in June, the Chasers had back-to-back losing months for the first time since June/July 2025.

COMEBACK KIDS

- The Chasers have 24 comeback wins and have blown a lead in 28 losses this year.
- 24 comeback wins are tied for 6th-most in the International League, tied 9th in Triple-A ... 28 blown leads are 2nd-most in the league, 4th in Triple-A.
 - The Storm Chasers have led at some point in 16 of their last 26 losses, including 4 games where the team led for at least half the game and 2 losses where Omaha had a 6+ run lead at some point in the game.
 - In the last 55 games (since May 9), Omaha is 24-31 ... the Chasers have trailed at some point in 17 of 24 wins and led at some point in 18 of 31 losses, meaning 35 of Omaha's last 55 games (64%) have been a comeback win for one of the teams ... in this stretch, 36 of 55 games (65%) have been decided by 3 runs or less.

SUMMER HEAT

- A pair of Storm Chasers bats have especially been performing well in recent weeks.
- Over his last 14 games (since June 21), **Brett Squires** is slashing .351/.400/.544 (20-for-57) with 12 RBI ... Tuesday, he snapped an on-base streak of 17 straight games, tied for the longest on-base streak among Storm Chasers hitters this year ... Squires hit safely in a career-best 14 straight games (June 16 to July 2).
 - Since his first game with Omaha on June 4, **Matthew Lugo** has hit .297 (33-for-111) with 8 home runs and 23 RBI in 29 games ... since his arrival, he is tied 4th in the International League in runs scored (25), tied 5th in home runs and extra-base hits (17) and 8th in total bases (66).

HONEST AB

- Abraham Toro** started the season slow, but has been one of the International League's best hitters since mid-May
- Since May 12, Toro has a .323 average (53-for-164) ... he ranks 2nd in the IL in OPS (1.014), 3rd in SLG (.622) and 7th in AVG ... his 41 RBI over 44 games since May 12 rank tied as the 5th-most in the league.
 - From March 27 to May 10, Toro hit .189 (21-for-111) with a .650 OPS and hits in 16 of 33 games ... since May 12, Toro has hits in 33 of 44 games, with 4+ hits in 3 games.
 - Over his last 11 games (since June 27), Toro is hitting .349 (15-for-43) with 9 extra-base hits and 11 RBI, with an 1.152 OPS.

CROSS ME UP

- Gavin Cross** had one of the league's slowest start to the season, but has heated up with the weather as the season has gone on.
- Over his first 36 games (March 27 to May 15), Cross hit just .128 (15-for-117) ... but in his last 44 games (since May 16), he's hitting .299 (47-for-157), with 15 XBH and 20 RBI, with 14 multi-hit games, including 4 of his last 5 games.

LOUISVILLE SLUGGING

- While the Bats hold the edge in the season series so far this year, a few Omaha hitters have been a thorn in the side of Louisville both this year and in previous seasons.
- Luca Tresh** is hitting .375 (15-for-40) with a 1.005 OPS and 10 RBI in 10 games against Louisville this year ... his 1.005 OPS ranks 7th among 41 hitters with at least 30 plate appearances against the Bats.
 - Louisville has also struggled pitching to **John Rave** ... over 26 career games at Louisville Slugger Field, Rave has 5 home runs, his most of any visiting Triple-A park ... since 2024, his 13 homers, 30 RBI and 92 total bases against the Bats are the most of any opposing player vs. Louisville.
 - Drew Waters** is a career .353 hitter (24-for-68) at Louisville Slugger Field (since 2021), with 11 extra-base hits and 14 RBI for a 1.085 OPS across 17 games, his best road AVG, OBP (.438), SLG (.647) and OPS of any Triple-A venue he's played in.

ROAD WARRIORS

- A pair of bullpen arms have stepped it up when pitching away from Werner Park.
- Génesis Cabrera** has allowed just 2 earned runs in 8.1 road innings (2.16 ERA) for the Storm Chasers, compared to a 9.28 ERA (11 ER in 10.2 IP) at home.
 - Dan Altavilla** has a 3.78 ERA (7 ER in 16.2 IP) in 16 road appearances this year and an 8.72 ERA (21 ER in 21.2 IP) in 17 home games, between Omaha and St. Paul.

TODAY'S APPEARANCE

- Henry Williams is making his **9th start** this year with the Storm Chasers, his **11th Triple-A appearance** and his **18th overall appearance** this season.
- Playing his **4th professional season** this year, all in the Royals organization.
- This is Williams' 1st career appearance against the Bats and just his 2nd against a Reds affiliate ... he previously pitched 4.0 shutout innings against Dayton (A+) on May 25, 2024.

HENRY'S HUNCH

- FINDING HIS FOOTING:** Williams made his Triple-A debut with the Storm Chasers last season, but made just 2 spot starts in the 1st half of the season ... he opened 2026 in Double-A, but since being promoted to Omaha on May 12, he has pitched in 10 games ... after posting an 8.59 ERA (14 ER in 14.2 IP) with 14 strikeouts (8.59 K/9) over his first 4 outings, Williams worked a 5.59 ERA (12 ER in 19.1 IP) with 21 strikeouts (9.78 K/9) over his next 4 appearances.
- STRENGTH AND STAMINA:** Williams got off to a hot start in 2026, allowing 2 earned runs or less while going 5.0+ innings in 4 of his last 6 starts at Double-A ... following his stretch with Omaha in 2025, Williams went back to NW Arkansas (AA) and pitched 5.0+ innings in 13 of his last 18 starts at Double-A.
- HOME RUN HURTING:** Much of the damage off Williams in Triple-A this year has come on the long ball, but he has limited home runs recently ... he allowed 9 home runs (all solo homers) in his first 5 starts and 20.2 innings, accounting for 50% (9 of 18) of the runs he allowed, but he has allowed just 1 home run in his last 5 starts, accounting for just 6% (1 of 18) of the runs he has allowed.

LAST OUTING: SUNDAY, JULY 5 VS. INDIANAPOLIS

- Made his 2nd quality start for Omaha and his 3rd overall, tying a season-high 6.0 innings pitched ... allowed an RBI single in the 1st inning, but worked back-to-back perfect frames in the 2nd and 3rd inning ... surrendered a pair of RBI singles in the 4th inning, but induced a triple play to end the frame ... worked around a two-out walk in the 5th inning and fired a 1-2-3 top of the 6th inning ... did not return for the 7th inning, with Oscar Rayo taking over for him.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Made 7 starts for Northwest Arkansas before his promotion to Omaha ... worked a 4.72 ERA (18 ER in 34.1 IP) with a 1.37 WHIP ... 3 of his 7 starts went 5.0+ innings with 1 or less runs allowed.

CAREER NOTES

2025

- Spent most of the season with Northwest Arkansas (AA), but also made 2 starts for Omaha ... among Royals Minor League pitchers, ranked 5th in innings pitched (115.1) and tied 6th in strikeouts (106).
- Opened the year with the Naturals and threw 5 quality starts over his first 8 appearances ... made his Triple-A debut with the Storm Chasers on May 28 vs. St. Paul (MIN) ... in 2 starts for Omaha and allowed 9 ER in 8.0 IP (10.13 ERA) before returning to Northwest Arkansas on June 6 to finish his season.

- In Northwest Arkansas, totaled 21 appearances (19 starts) and worked a 4.24 ERA (51 ER in 108.1 IP) with 100 strikeouts and a 1.37 WHIP throughout the season ... named the Texas League Pitcher of the Week for his start on July 2 @ Springfield (STL), tossing 5.0 scoreless innings with 1 hit and 7 strikeouts

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER

- Spent the entire 2024 season with Quad Cities (A+) ... appeared in 22 games (21 starts) with a 3.68 ERA (42 ER in 102.2 IP) and 92 strikeouts at High-A ... 7 of his 21 starts were scoreless, including his last 3 of the season, for a career-high 21.0-inning scoreless streak that stretched into April 2025.
- Split 2023 between the Royals and Padres organizations ... opened the year with the Lake Elsinore Storm (A) in San Diego's system but the Padres traded him to Kansas City at the trade deadline ... after the trade, made 5 starts for Columbia (A) and posted a 3.38 ERA (9 ER in 24.0 IP) with 23 strikeouts for the Fireflies...
- Made his professional debut at the start of the 2023 season with Lake Elsinore after San Diego drafted him in the 3rd round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Duke University ... made 12 starts for the Storm before his trade to the Royals, working a 5.74 ERA (27 ER in 42.1 IP) with 40 strikeouts for Lake Elsinore ... missed the 2022 season as he recovered from Tommy John surgery.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Attended Duke University (2019-2021), where he appeared in 9 games (7 starts) over 3 seasons with the Blue Devils (ACC), going 3-3 with a 3.82 ERA (16 ER in 37.2 IP) and 45 strikeouts ... only pitched one full season in Durham (2021) due to the COVID-19 pandemic shortening his freshman campaign (2020) and Tommy John surgery in December 2021, keeping him out of action his junior year (2022).
- Lettered in both baseball and basketball all 4 years at Darien High School (CT) ... was a team captain for the basketball team his senior season.
- Father David played collegiate baseball at Davidson College from 1987 to 1991.
