INTRODUCING THE SOMERSET SEMIQUINCENTENNAALS! This weekend, the Somerset Patriots debut their newest alternate identity, playing as the Somerset Semiquincentennials for the first time in franchise history, in celebration of America's 250th Anniversary. The Somerset Patriots received their name originally in 1998 based off of the rich Revolutionary War background of Somerset County and Central New Jersey.

BRIDGEWATER BOMBERS: The Somerset Patriots enter today leading all Double-A teams with 121 HR, which ranks 4th in MiLB. On Friday, Somerset smashed multiple HR for the third time in the last five games. The Patriots have recorded multiple HR in 35 of 80 (43.8%) games this season matching their multiple HR in 35 of 138 (25.4%) games in 2025. Somerset enters today having homered in four of its last five games, 13 of its last 17, 22 of its last 27, 39 of its last 46 and 63 of 80 games this season.

THE SCOOP ON COOP: Somerset Patriots manager James Cooper will represent the Patriots and the Yankees as the third base coach for the AL at the MLB All-Star Futures Game in Philadelphia on July 12th. Currently in his fifth season with the Yankees and his fourth as a manager, Cooper was the 2023 FCL Manager of the Year in his first year managing. He also managed the Arizona Fall League's Mesa Solar Sox in 2023.

QUALITY CADE: On Tuesday, Cade Smith earned his fifth win of the season, tossing 6.0 IP with 4 H, 1 R, 2 BB and 4 K in the series opener vs. Hartford. It marked his second consecutive quality start for the first time in his Double-A career and his fourth quality start this season. Smith's four quality starts lead all active Patriots and are tied for fourth in the Eastern League. Across his last five appearances, Smith has posted a 2.10 ERA, 1.13 WHIP and .213 BAA with 26 K to 11 BB in 30.0 IP. That includes working 6.0+ IP in four consecutive outings.

MAMBA MENTALITY: On Friday, Coby Morales smashed his 15th HR in his 75th game of the season, becoming the fastest Eastern League batter to 60 RBI since Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (NH - 2018 - 61 G). His 60 RBI lead the AL and rank 6th in Double-A. Across his last 10 games, he's 13-for-33 (.394 AVG) with a .487 OBP, 3 HR, 8 RBI and 9 XBH. He's raised his season-long OPS from .834 to .883 in that span. With hits in five of his last six games, Morales' 77 hits are the 3rd-most among Patriots all-time through Somerset's first 80 games to start a season.

ACTION JACKSON: With hits in six of his last seven games, Jackson Castillo is 9-for-27 (.333 AVG), with a HR, 3 RBI, 4 XBH and two multi-hit games in that span. In his 57th game of the year Tuesday, Castillo hit his 7th HR of the year, already matching the total number of HR he hit last year in exactly half the amount of games (114 games).

THE GOAT GASHER: With hits in all five games against the Yard Goats this week, DJ Gladney's active five-game hit streak is the longest on the team. Gladney is 7-for-19 with HR, 3 XBH, 4 RBI and two multi-hit games against HFD this week.

I'M LOVIN' IT: On Saturday, Connor McGinnis registered a career-high three hits and his seventh multi-hit game with the Patriots this season. Across his last 10 games, McGinnis is batting .344/.382/.469 with 3 RBI, 4 XBH and three multi-hit games.

MOYLAN IS BOILIN': With his 4th career multi-home run game on Tuesday, Josh Moylan extended his single-season career-high in HR to 16 by pounding 2 HR off HFD SP Jackson Cox. Since May 22 dating back to his stint with Hudson Valley, Moylan has collected 13 HR in his last 32 GP. Moylan's 13 HR in that span lead all Yankees minor leaguers and are T-7th in MiLB.

GIVE HIM THE VERDE LIGHT: On Friday, Kevin Verde powered his first career Double-A homer down the left field line in the fifth inning. At 20 years, 203 days old Verde became the third-youngest Patriot to homer in a game (Jasson Dominguez, George Lombard Jr.) and the 16th unique Patriot to homer this season.

HOME SWEET HOME: Currently in the midst of a season-long 12-game homestand, the Patriots are 24-14 at TD Bank Ballpark this season, compared to 18-24 away from home. Somerset's 10 games over .500 at home rank 2nd in the Eastern League (Richmond - 20).

CARDIAC PATS: Friday's win over HFD marked the 14th time Somerset has played a game decided by two or fewer runs in its last 20 contests. The Patriots have also played in eight one-run games over their last 19 games. Somerset's 29 one-run games this season are T-2nd in the Eastern League.

SOMERSET SHOIVING: The Patriots pitching staff enters today with a Double-A best 837 K, which ranks 8th among 120 MiLB teams. With a nine-inning franchise-record 19 K on Wednesday, Somerset's 48 K in its last four games are tied for the Double-A lead and are T-4th in MiLB.

2026 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

JAMES COOPER: Manager (1st year)

James Cooper enters his first season as manager of the Somerset Patriots, his fifth overall year in the Yankees organization and his fourth consecutive as a minor league manager. He spent the 2025 season as the manager of the High-A Hudson Valley Renegades, after serving as manager of the Single-A Tampa Tarpons in 2024 and beginning his minor league managerial career with the FCL Yankees in 2023. Under Cooper's leadership in 2025, Hudson Valley finished with a franchise-record 79 wins (79-50), being eliminated from playoff contention on the final day of the regular season. During the season, the Renegades finished second in AVG (.235), H (970), OBP (.336), SLG (.363), OPS (.699), third in R (598) and HR (547). In 2024 at the helm for Tampa, the Tarpons led the FSL in SB, while ranking second in AVG, H and 2B, and fourth in OPS. During Cooper's first assignment with the Yankees organization in 2022, he served as defensive coach for the FCL Yankees, where he helped the team with the 2022 FCL Championship. The following season, Cooper made his managerial debut with the FCL Yankees and was named the Florida Complex League Manager of the Year in 2023, when his team led the FCL in runs, hits, triples, RBIs, AVG, OBP, SLG and OPS.

MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (2nd year)

Mike Fransoso enters his second season as a coach in Somerset and within the Yankees organization. Under Fransoso's leadership during the 2025 season, the Patriots' offense ranked among the Eastern League leaders with 129 HR (2nd), a .691 OPS (4th) and 600 R (5th). Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots (2018-2019) during the team's run as an independent team and also the Pittsburgh Pirates organization (2013-2015). He previously coached in the Seattle Mariners organization (2021-2024), serving as the hitting coach and interim manager for the Double-A Arkansas Travelers in 2024, when he helped manage the team to a Southern League Championship.

DEMETRE KOKORIS: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Demetre Kokoris enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees. He served as the pitching coach in Hudson Valley in 2025 and guided the team to a league-best 2.82 ERA and 20 shutouts. Prior to joining the Yankees, Kokoris, coached in the Texas Rangers (2022-2024) and Toronto Blue Jays (2019-2021) organizations. He spent the 2023 and 2024 seasons as the bullpen coach for the Triple-A Round Rock Express, and was the pitching coach for the Single-A Down East Wood Ducks in 2022. Prior to joining the Rangers, he was the pitching coach for the Short-Season Class-A Vancouver Canadians (2019-20) and was a rehab pitching coach (2021) with the Blue Jays. Before entering the professional coaching ranks, Kokoris was a college pitching coach at Chemeketa Community College, Point Loma Nazarene University, and Santa Barbara City College. He has also served as the pitching coach for the Greek National Team since 2021.

UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (2nd year)

Uziel Viloria enters his second consecutive season as a defensive coach in Somerset and his second season with the Yankees organization. Under his leadership in 2025, the Patriots posted a franchise record .983 fielding percentage. Viloria began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), reaching High-A Jersey Shore in 2022 and 2023.

CALEB HAMILTON: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Caleb Hamilton enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees organization. After a playing career that included MLB experience with the Minnesota Twins (2022) and Boston Red Sox (2023), Hamilton completed his first year in coaching as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley in 2025. During his final season playing in 2024, Hamilton saw time in 39 games for the Rocket City Trash Pandas, the Double-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels. He was drafted by Minnesota in the 23rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of Oregon State University, where he was an All-Pac-12 performer for the Beavers. Despite not catching in college, Hamilton made 323 of his 574 professional appearances as a catcher, and he played at least one game at all nine positions.

After being traded to the Yankees from the Cubs entering the 2025 season, Arias spent the year on the Yankees' 40-man roster. He broke camp on the 7-day IL for Triple-A SWB, before being reinstated following a minor league rehab assignment on 7/19 and having his option transferred to Double-A Somerset.
