PAPILLION, NEB. – Despite drawing a season-high 11 walks, the Omaha Storm Chasers only mustered three hits and fell for the third straight game to the Gwinnett Stripers, 9-3.

Nick Pratto drove in two of Omaha's three runs, on a pair of sacrifice flies ... Pratto started the game's scoring in the 3rd inning with a sac fly that scored Maikel Garcia from third base, then added another in the 5th that scored Samad Taylor.

After allowing a pair of baserunners in the 1st, Chasers starter Max Castillo found himself in a groove, with a stretch through the 3rd inning of seven straight retired.

While Pratto gave Omaha a 1-0 lead in the 3rd inning, it did not last long as Castillo loaded the bases to open the 4th and a bases-clearing triple put Gwinnett up 3-1, then the Stripers remained ahead the rest of the evening ... the Stripers added another run in the 4th, then three unearned runs in the 5th off Castillo, through the right-hander finished five innings for the first time this year.

Down by six in the bottom of the fifth, Omaha got to work on a comeback, first loading the bases with no outs for Pratto, who brought home a run on his second sac

Down by six in the bottom of the fifth, Omaha got to work on a comeback, first loading the bases with no outs for Pratto, who brought home a run on his second sac fly ... two more walks brought home another run, as **Freddy Fermin** drew a bases-loaded free pass with two outs, at the time bringing the Chasers within four, 7-3, and the tying run to the plate, but the Chasers could not bring the game any closer. After scoreless innings from **Andrés Núñez** and **Brooks Kriske**, **Ryan Weiss** surrendered a pair of runs in the eighth to stretch Gwinnett's lead to 9-3. Pratto doubled in the eighth inning, Omaha's third and final hit of the game, after singles from Taylor in the first and Garcia in the fifth. After **Nick Wittgren** threw a 1-2-3 top of the ninth inning, the Chasers drew two more walks in the bottom half, but could not inch any closer, falling by six runs and dropping a third straight to the Stripers

## **NOTES AND NUGGETS**

### **WALK THIS WAY**

11 walks drawn last night by Omaha hitters were a season-high ... 5 players drew 2+.

7 The Storm Chasers averaged 4.3 walks per game entering yesterday and nearly tripled their mark ... that a previous season high of 9 on March 31 @ Indianapolis.

7 Omaha drew double-digit walks four time last season, twice in April and most recently September 22 vs. lowa (12).

### **LET'S SCORE MORE**

In looking at the games Omaha has won and lost this season, it's very clear that the

team wins the more they care.

Omaha is 7-0 when scoring more than 6 runs, in fact the team has scored at least 8 runs in every win this season ... Omaha also has 10 or more hits in every win.

Omaha is 0-9 when scoring 6 runs or less, with fewer than five runs scored in 6 of

#### their 9 losses this season. **SUPPORTING STARTERS**

A lack of run support has been a common theme for Omaha starting pitchers this year,

who are receiving an average of 2.25 runs of support per game.

Omaha hitters have provided multiple runs of support to their starting pitcher in 7 of 16 games this season and won the first 5 of those games but lost have lost the last two games, providing Jonathan Heasley 2 runs of support and 3 for Max Castillo.

When providing no support or just one run of support, the team is 2-7 ... the team has not won a game, however, when providing their starter with 0 runs of support.

### **HOMER HAPPY**

Omaha's 26 home runs through the first 15 games of this season have combined to account for 42 runs, or 42.4% of the team's total scoring (99 runs scored).

26 homers are tied for the 2nd-most of any International League team and tied for the 5th-most in all of the Minor Leagues.
 Logan Porter's 5 home runs lead the Chasers and are <u>tied 9th</u> in the league ... Porter's

Logar Porter's 5 home runs lead the Chasers and are <u>ued 9th</u> in the league ... Porter's 5 homers in 11 games give him a .821 slugging percentage that is tops in the International League and 1.234 OPS that ranks 3rd among qualified hitters ... among all Triple-A hitters, he ranks 3rd in slugging and 6th in OPS. After not homering on Opening Day (3/31 @ Indianapolis), Omaha hit at least one home run in 11 straight games (4/1 to 4/13), the longest streak in the league this year ... the team has homered in 12 of 16 games this season, but 1 of the last 4.

### SAMAD (TAYLOR'S VERSION)

Samad Taylor has led off all 16 games this season for the Omaha Storm Chasers and gone 2-for-70 at the plate, with 7 extra-base hits and 14 runs batted in.

Taylor is one of two players (with Tyler Gentry) that has played in all 16 games so far.

He has collected multiple hits in 7 different games this season, including each of the first 4, with hits in 13 of the 16 games he's played ... he's reached base in 15 of 16.

His 21 hits rank tied 8th in the International League, while he ranks tied 6th with 7 steals and just outside the top 10 in runs batted in and total bases.

## MANAGER: Mike Jirschele • 23

- Mike Jirschele returns for his 15th season as Omaha's manager, his 18th season managing in Minor League Baseball and 32nd season overall with the Royals organization, named to the position of Storm Chasers manager on January 13, 2023, after previously managing Triple-A Omaha from 1995-97 and 2003-13.
- Jirschele served on the Kansas City Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015. Jirschele most recently served as the bench coach under manager Chris Widger during the 2022 season with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals. He spent the 2021 season as Widger's bench coach for the High-A Central champion Quad Cities River Bandits and served as Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020.
- In his second stint as Omaha's manager, over 11 years from 2003 to 2013, he led the team to four division titles, three consecutive trips to the Pacific Coast League Championship Series (2011-2013), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and the team's first of two Triple-A National Championships in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field and he is a four-time recipient of the Dick Howser Award (1992, 1994, 2005, 2011), recognizing outstanding work in player development within the Royals organization.
- Prior to his time with Omaha and Kansas City, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years, from 1998-2002, and he held managerial positions with Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- Frame He appeared 999 games in the Minor Leagues across 13 years, between 1977 and 1990, including 22 games with the Omaha Royals between 1988 and 1989.

- **pane Johnson** enters his fourth year in the Royals organization and as the Storm Chasers pitching coach, after joining Kansas City ahead of the 2020 season. 2023 marks his 24th season coaching overall.
- g He previously spent one season in the Miami Marlins organization (2019) as a Pitching Consultant and 19 seasons with the Toronto Blue Jays as a Minor League Pitching Coach from 2000-03, Pitching Coordinator from 2004-14 and Major League Bullpen Coach from 2015-18.
- Prior to entering coaching, spent 15 years as a player, including over 280 games in the Minor Leagues and parts of three seasons in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox (1994), Blue Jays (1996) and Oakland Athletics (1997), also playing two seasons (1990-1991) in the Chinese Professional Baseball League.
- Johnson and his wife, Gina, reside in Palm Harbor, Florida. They have two children: a daughter, Madison (31), and son, Cobi (27).



## HITTING COACH: BIJAN RADEMACHER • 52

- **Bijan Rademacher** (bi-ZHON RAH-de-moch-err) joins the Royals as the Omaha Storm Chasers Hitting Coach this year after spending the last two years with the Arizona Diamondbacks as their Minor League Hitting Coordinator (2021) and ACL Hitting Coach (2022).
- Prior to coaching, he spent eight years playing professionally (2012-2019), spanning seven seasons in the Chicago Cubs organization (2012-18) and slashed .280/.361/.402 over 702 career MiLB games, reaching as high as Triple-A. He also played one season in independent baseball (2019) with the New Britain Bees in the Atlantic League, in addition to an offseason in the Mexican Pacific Winter League.

Before signing with Detroit in 2018, Noworyta graduated from the University of Hawaii with a bachelor's degree in communications and journalism, and played in parts of three seasons for their baseball team.
- g Noworyta attended Holy Cross Academy (N.J.), where he played baseball and basketball, and was selected by the Royals in the 37th round of the 2014 MLB Draft. He resides in Hainesport, N.J. in the offseason.

- Stone worked three seasons in the Florida Marlins organization, with stops in Jupiter (2008), Greensboro (2007) and Jamestown (2006), winning New York-Penn League Trainer of the Year honors in 2006.
- He was the Strength and Conditioning Coach for the Baltimore Orioles Class-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, in 2005.
- Stone graduated with a bachelor's of science in kinesiology from Cal State-Northridge. He resides in Simi Valley, California with his dog, Ozzie.
