CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: This past Sunday, the Captains fell in the finale of a six-game road series against the Lansing Lugnuts by a final score of 5-4 at Jackson Field in Lansing, Michigan. This was the fourth one-run game of the series, and first which Lake County lost, as the Captains and Lugnuts split the series.

Offensively, Lake County struck first in the game's opening inning, as a Lansing fielding error allowed two runs to score, making the score 2-0. After falling behind 4-2, **Joe Donovan** hit an RBI single in the top of the 4th inning to make it a one-run game. Then, one inning later, **Dayan Frias** hit an RBI pop out to third base into foul territory, which tied the game at 4-4.

Eventually, a two-out, solo inside-the-park home run from the Lugnuts in the bottom of the 6th inning brought home the game's final run. On the play, Captains outfielder **Jorge Burgos** tried to make a leaping catch, but crashed into the right field wall, and was soon carted off the field.

For Lake County, **Ethan Hankins** was activated from the 7-day injured list, and made his first start since June 2nd. The right-hander pitched a scoreless 1st inning, allowing just one hit in 27 pitches (17 strikes).

Parker Messick then made his first career Minor League relief appearance, suffering his third straight loss. The left-hander pitched exactly 5 innings for his second consecutive outing, allowing season-lows of 7 hits, 5 runs, 2 earned runs, one home run, and no walks, while throwing a season-low 3 strikeouts.

CELEBRATING 20 SEASONS OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: This year marks the 20th season of Lake County Captains Baseball. After the Columbus Red Stixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. This would be the 21st season of Captains Baseball, but the 2020 Minor League Baseball season was cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

NEW SEASON, NEW OWNERSHIP: On January 17th, it was announced that **Alan Miller** and former Seattle Seahawks punter **Jon Ryan** of COLLiDE Sport would become the majority owners of the Lake County Captains. **Miller** and **Ryan** operate the West Coast League's Portland Pickles as well.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

WALKING THE... BASES: In their first 80 games, Lake County hitters have drawn 343 walks this season, which ranks tied 3rd in the Midwest League. 7 current Captains have drawn at least 20 walks this season, with **Will Bartlett** leading the team with 38 walks in 48 games.

DELAUTER DELIVERING EARLY: After being activated from the 60-day injured list on June 29th, **Chase DeLauter**, Cleveland's No. 6 prospect according to MLB.com, has had a stellar start to his High-A career. The 21-year-old is currently on a 7-game hitting streak, during which he is hitting .517 (15-for-29) with 7 doubles, one home run, 7 RBI, and a stolen base. In his first 8 games with Lake County, **DeLauter** has slashed .469/.469/.781, with a 1.250 OPS.

TOLENTINO'S TERRIFIC HITTING: **Milan Tolentino**, Cleveland's No. 20 prospect according to MLB.com, is currently on an 8-game hitting streak, which is tied for the longest by a Captain this season. During this streak, the 21-year-old is hitting .406 (13-for-32) with 4 doubles, 3 RBI, one walk, and 2 stolen bases. This is **Tolentino's** second 8-game hitting streak this season, with his first occurring from June 13th until June 23rd.

PITCHERS OF THE WEEK: On June 26th, MiLB announced that **Juan Zapata** was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week for the week of 6/19-6/25. After making 8 relief appearances as a Captain this season, the right-hander made his first High-A start of the season on June 21st in a road game against the Dayton Dragons. **Zapata** did not record a decision, as he pitched a career-high 6.2 innings, allowing just one hit, no runs, and 2 walks, while throwing a career-high 9 strikeouts in 84 pitches (56 strikes). This was his first High-A start since June 3rd, 2021, which was also for Lake County against Dayton.

Earlier this season, the Captains had pitchers named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week in back-to-back weeks. **Ryan Webb** was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week for the week of 5/29-6/4. On June 3rd, the left-hander earned his second win of the season, pitching a career-high 7 scoreless innings, allowing just 4 hits and 2 walks, and tying his season-high of 8 strikeouts in 94 pitches (64 strikes) against the Quad Cities River Bandits.

Tommy Mace was then named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week for the week of 6/5-6/11. In one of the best starts in Captains history, the right-hander earned his second victory of the season on June 8th, pitching a career-high 8 scoreless innings, allowing just 2 hits and zero walks, and throwing a career-high 11 strikeouts in 87 pitches (60 strikes) against the Great Lakes Loons. **Mace** permitted just 3 baserunners in the start, and was promoted to the Double-A Akron RubberDucks on June 13th.

GOING OVERBOARD: The Lake County pitching staff has allowed 93 home runs this season, the most in the Midwest League. 14 of these home runs have been courtesy of Dayton hitters. No other team in the Midwest League has allowed at least 80 or 70 home runs this season, as the both the Beloit Sky Carp and Peoria Chiefs have allowed the 2nd-most home runs in the league with 66 each.

LAST TIME OUT: Steve Hajjar did not record a decision for his third consecutive start in a road game eight days ago against the Lansing Lugnuts. The left-hander pitched a career-high 6 innings, allowing a season-high 5 hits, one earned run, and no walks (for just the third time in his Minor League career), while tying a career-low with one strikeout in 89 pitches (61 strikes). Hajjar's lone earned run allowed was courtesy of a 2-out, game-tying RBI single in the bottom of the 3rd inning.

MIDWEST LEAGUE EXPERIENCE: Hajjar made 2 starts for the Dayton Dragons last season, finishing with 0-1 with a 6.43 ERA and 10 strikeouts in 7 innings pitched. In his Minor League career, the left-hander has also pitched for the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels (Single-A, MIN) and the Florida Complex League Twins.

TWO TRADES: Hajjar was the player to be named later in the trade that sent former Captain Will Benson to Cincinnati and current Captains OF Justin Boyd to Cleveland on February 8th. Hajjar was officially traded to Cleveland on March 26th. Also, after being drafted by the Minnesota Twins in 2021, Hajjar was traded to the Cincinnati Reds on August 2nd, 2022 as part of the trade that sent RHP Tyler Mahle to Minnesota.

WONDERFUL WOLVERINE: Despite being drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 2018 MLB Draft, Hajjar elected to play college baseball at the University of Michigan, where he was teammates with current Captains C Joe Donovan for 2 seasons. After being redshirted as a freshman in 2019, Hajjar made 4 starts in 2020, finishing 3-0 with a 2.70 ERA and 24 strikeouts, and was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week twice. Then, as a redshirt sophomore in 2021, Hajjar was named 1st Team All-Big Ten after finishing 4-2 with a 3.09 ERA and a Big Ten-leading 110 strikeouts in 14 starts. He was also named 2nd Team All-Region by both ABCA and Rawlings.

HIGH SCHOOL HONORS: For his senior season at Central Catholic High School (MA), Hajjar was named the 2018 Gatorade Player of the Year for the state of Massachusetts. During his time in high school, the left-hander was named 1st Team All-Northeast Region by Rawlings-Perfect Game, as well as a Rawlings-Perfect Game 3rd Team All-American.

LAST TIME OUT: Aaron Davenport recorded his first win of the season six days ago in a road start against the Lansing Lugnuts. This was Davenport's first win since September 4th, 2022, when he threw a 7-inning, complete-game shutout in Game 1 of a doubleheader against the Great Lakes Loons. The right-hander pitched 5 innings, allowing season-highs of 9 hits and 5 earned runs (tied), along with 2 walks and 5 strikeouts in 88 pitches (58 strikes). This was Davenport's second time in three starts in which he surrendered multiple home runs. The 22-year-old allowed a 2-run home run in the bottom of the 1st inning, and a solo shot in the bottom of the 4th inning.

RARELY IN RELIEF: Davenport is scheduled to be tonight's piggyback pitcher for the Captains. This marks the right-hander's third career Minor League relief appearance. Back on June 1st, Davenport recorded his first career Minor League save, pitching 3 innings in a home relief appearance against the Quad Cities River Bandits. Before that, his first career Minor League relief appearance on August 23rd, 2021, when he was with the Arizona Complex League Indians. Davenport entered the game at the beginning of the 4th inning and recorded his only victory with the team, pitching 2 scoreless innings, allowing just one hit and one walk, and throwing 2 strikeouts. The 22-year-old also made 2 relief appearances during his freshman season at Hawai'i.

RAINBOW WARRIOR: Davenport pitched 3 seasons at Hawai'i, earning All-Big West Honorable Mention honors his sophomore year. He accumulated 180 strikeouts in 173.2 innings pitched. Davenport was the Friday night starter in 2021, and also earned Academic All-Big West honors.

RED GLOVE: Davenport dons a bright red glove on the mound. The reason? "I've always wanted a red glove. When I was at Hawai'i, we couldn't choose the glove color, so when I got the choice, I got it hooked up for sure." Davenport said.

PRE-GAME WORKOUT: 2 hours before a start, Davenport gets the juices flowing with a high-intensity training session highlighted by throwing a medicine ball off a wall.

TRAVELING SKATEBOARD: On road trips, Davenport will bring his board around and use it to get around the cities that the Captains visit.

THREE-SPORT ATHLETE: Davenport was a member of the Cedarcrest High School (Duvall, WA) baseball, basketball, and football teams. In baseball, he graduated as the school record-holder in career and single-season strikeouts. He was named 2nd Team All-Conference in basketball, and 1st team all-conference in football.

CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

5 former Lake County Captains have made their MLB debut with the Cleveland Guardians in the 2023 season.

RHP Gavin Williams: On Wednesday, June 21st, **RHP Gavin Williams** made his MLB debut at home against the Oakland Athletics. He did not record a decision in his first career Major League start, pitching 5.2 innings and allowing 4 hits, 4 earned runs, and 3 walks, while throwing 4 strikeouts. **Williams** was a Captain in 2022, making 9 starts and compiling a 2-1 record with a 1.40 ERA and 67 strikeouts.

SS Brayan Rocchio: On Tuesday, May 16th, **SS Brayan Rocchio** made his MLB debut on the road against the Chicago White Sox. He entered the game as a pinch-hitter in the top of the 6th inning, recording an infield single in his first career Major League at-bat. **Rocchio** would eventually finish the game as Cleveland's third baseman and go 1-for-2 at the plate, as he grounded into a double play in the top of the 8th. He played 64 games for the Captains in 2021, hitting .265 with 9 home runs, 33 RBI, 13 doubles, and 14 stolen bases in 20 attempts.

RHP Tanner Bibee: On Wednesday, April 26th, **RHP Tanner Bibee** made his MLB debut at home against the Colorado Rockies. He earned the victory in his first career Major League start, pitching 5.2 innings and allowing 6 hits, one earned run, and zero walks, while throwing 8 strikeouts. **Bibee** was a Captain in 2022, making 12 starts and compiling a 2-1 record with a 2.59 ERA and 86 strikeouts.

LHP Logan Allen: On Sunday, April 23rd, **LHP Logan Allen** made his MLB debut at home against the Miami Marlins. He earned the victory in his first career Major League start, pitching 6 innings and allowing 5 hits, one earned run, and one walk, while throwing 8 strikeouts. **Allen** was a Captain in 2021, making 9 appearances (5 starts) and compiling a 5-0 record with a 1.58 ERA and 67 strikeouts.

LHP Tim Herrin: On Sunday, April 2nd, **LHP Tim Herrin** made his MLB debut on the road against the Seattle Mariners. He pitched 1.1 innings of relief, striking out all four hitters he faced. **Herrin** became the first pitcher in the MLB since 1901 to face at least four hitters in his MLB debut and strike them all out. The next day against Oakland, also on the road, he struck out the first hitter he faced, meaning that he struck out the first five MLB hitters he faced. **Herrin** was a Captain in 2019 and 2021, where he made a combined 48 relief appearances, compiling a 5-3 record and earning 3 saves.
