Today's Game

The Fightin Phils remain on the road and continue a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. It is the 10th-of-12 games between the teams this season and third-of-six at FNB Field. Harrisburg took the series between the teams from Apr. 29-May 4 in Reading, 4-2 and leads the season-series 6-3. Reading won the 2024 season-series over Harrisburg 7-5, including a 3-3 record in the Capital City.

Game 52 Recap

The Fightin Phils turned in a clean and wire-to-wire 4-1 victory over Harrisburg on Thursday night for their first win of the series. After a leadoff single from Luis Verdugo in the top of the third inning, Cade Fergus launched his fourth home run of the season to right-center field to put Reading up 2-0. Later in the same inning, Aidan Miller walked, took second on a wild pitch and stole third. He would score on a ground out fielders' choice from Hendry Mendez to make it 3-0. One inning later, Leandro Pineda hit his second home run of the season into the seats in right field to make it a 4-0 Reading advantage. Mitch Neunborn started a bullpen game and dominated. Over four innings, Neunborn allowed just one hit and struck out three. He was perfect through three innings before a double from Jacob Young to lead off the fourth, but Young was stranded. Gunner Mayer, who earned the win, tossed two-scoreless innings behind Neunborn, and was able to escape a bases loaded jam in the bottom of the sixth. Andrew Bechtold pitched the seventh, and after allowing two soft hits, he put up two strikeouts to strand runners on second and third to end the seventh. Jack Dallas entered for the bottom of the eighth, and after surrendering a run in the first frame he pitched, he returned for the ninth and sent the Senators down in order to secure the Fightin Phils first win of the week.

It's Miller Time

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller matched a career-high with three walks and also tied a season-high with two stolen bases on Thursday night. The other two times Miller has walked three times in his career were May 28, 2024, vs Lakeland, and Aug. 15, 2024, vs Winston-Salem. His two stolen bases also put him in a tie for first in the Eastern League with 20 stolen bases on the season. Additionally, Miller ranks third in the Phillies organization in stolen bases with his 20. His 20 stolen bases has already matched Reading's high in stolen bases from last season, when Gabriel Rincones Jr. had 20 swiped bags. Lehigh Valley's Oscar Mercado leads the way with 24 and Justin Crawford is second with 23. After hitting just .203 in April, Miller posted a .284/.364/.432 (.796 OPS) slash line over 24 May games, along with 11 runs, four doubles, three home runs and eight RBI.

Anthony Keeps Rolling

Keaton Anthony was named the Phillies Minor League Hitter of May on Wednesday. Despite snapping a 12-game hitting streak on Thursday, Anthony did walk and his on-base streak is up to 21 games. His 21-game on-base streak is the longest by a Fightin Phils since Carlos De La Cruz, who now plays for Harrisburg, reached in 38-straight games from May 12-June 25, of the 2023 season. Anthony enters today with the best average amongst all qualifiers in the Eastern League at .335 and doubles with 20. His other Eastern League ranks are: 7th OBP (.390), 2nd SLG (.524), 3rd OPS (.914), 3rd hits (55), T-2nd XBH (24) and T-5th TB (86). Since May 1 (26 games), Anthony is slashing .387/.441/.613 (1.054 OPS), with 13 runs, 13 doubles, one triple, two home runs and 15 RBI. Anthony had recorded four-straight two-hit games from May 31-June 4, the most since Trevor Schwewe did it from Aug. 15-18, of the 2024 season.

Terrific Tommy

Since returning from Jersey Shore (A+) on May 1, Tommy McCollum has been excellent out of the bullpen. After two-perfect innings on Tuesday night, McCollum now has a 0.68 ERA (1 ER, 13.1 IP) over eight appearances. He has also struck out 10 and now issued a single walk yet. McCollum has not allowed a run over his last six outings (11.1 IP) and has allowed a run in just one of his eight appearances so far.

Money Mitch

Mitch Neunborn tossed another stellar outing at FNB Field in Harrisburg. On Thursday night, Neunborn, who was making a spot start, tossed four-shutout innings, allowing just one hit and striking out three. He was perfect through three innings and faced just one batter above the minimum. At Harrisburg on Sept. 12, 2024, Neunborn earned the win. allowing one run on three hits over six innings of work. So, over two starts at FNB Field in his career, Neunborn has gone: 10.0 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 2 BB, 8 SO.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 6, 2007: At Reading, Kyle Kendrick fires Reading's first 9-inning complete game of the season as the R-Phils beat Harrisburg, 8-1. Kendrick surrenders six hits while striking out five. His next start would come in Philadelphia a week later.

To the Capital City

Harrisburg enters tonight with a 26-28 record, which is third in the Southwest Division and 10 games out of first place. The Senators were in Richmond last week and took four-of-six games at the league-worst Flying Squirrels. After this week, Harrisburg heads back south to take on the Chesapeake Baysox. Harrisburg's roster has five players on the Nationals' top-30 prospects list (MLB Pipeline): Jarlin Susana (2), Seaver King (4), Cayden Wallace (10), Tyler Stuart (14), and Kevin Made (26).

Pitching for the Senators

Righty Kyle Luckham makes the start tonight for Harrisburg. Over 10 starts this season, Luckham is 4-2, with a 2.56 ERA (16 ER, 56.1 IP). He's allowed 58 hits, walked 16 and struck out 35 (5.59 SO/9.0 IP). He earned the win last Saturday at Richmond, allowing two runs on nine hits over five innings. Luckham tossed seven-shutout innings at Reading on May 2, allowing just four hits and striking out two. Luckham spent most of last season with Harrisburg, going 5-8, with a 4.47 ERA over 23 outings/21 starts. The 25-year old was a 15th round pick by Washington in the 2022 draft out of Arizona State.

LAST START: 5/31 vs ERI: L, 5.1 IP, 6 H, 5 R, 2 ER, 0 HR, 1 BB, 6 SO, 88 pitches (61 strikes)... The Fightin' Phils lost to Erie, 11-1, at FirstEnergy Stadium. Cabrera had some of his best command of the season, walking a season-low one for the second-straight outing, but dealt with some misfortune as three of the five runs surrendered were unearned. After posting zeroes in the first three frames, he was tagged for three runs in the fourth. With runners on second and third, a throwing error to home by Aidan Miller cost Cabrera two runs and the SeaWolves tacked on another on a single later in the frame. Cabrera then allowed two singles in the sixth and was lifted for Mitch Neunborn, who allowed two of the inherited runners to score on a home run to the first batter he faced. Cabrera was relieved by Mitch Neunborn in the top of the sixth inning.

2025 Season:

- Prior to the 2025 season, Cabrera was added to the Phillies 40-man roster (on 11/19/24) to protect him from the Rule-5 Draft; optioned to Reading (AA) on March 8
- Appeared in relief for the Phillies in the Spring Breakout Game (3/14 vs PIT) and tossed two innings following Moises Chace, who started the game
- Opened the season ranked as the Phillies No. 11 Prospect (MLB Pipeline)
- Tabbed as Reading's Opening Day starter Apr. 4 vs Portland (ND, 4.2 IP, 2 H, ER, 4 BB, 3 SO)
- Lone win of season Apr. 16 vs Binghamton (5.0 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 2 BB, 7 SO)
- Season-high six innings on two occasions: Apr. 22 at Portland and May 8 at Binghamton
- May 8 at BNG: 6.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 8 SO; eight strikeouts was season-high
- Walked season (and career-high) five batters twice: May 1 vs HBG and May 20 at POR
- Issued season-low one walk in back-to-back starts: May 25 at POR and May 31 vs ERI
