LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn earned their 3rd-straight win on Saturday night vs. Hudson Valley...The Cyclones scored the game's only runs in the bottom of the 1st...C **Kevin Parada** powered an RBI triple and scored on a sacrifice fly by RF **Abraham Almonte**...RHP **Joshua Cornielly** (3.0 IP), RHP **Dylan Tebrake** (2.1), LHP **Eli Ankeney** (1.2), and RHP **Wilkin Ramos** (2.0) combined for a 4-hit shutout in a bullpen game for Brooklyn...Tebrake earned his first career victory, Ankeney garnered a hold, and Ramos collected his first save of 2023...RHP **Juan Carela** composed a quality start with 6.0 innings of 2-run ball, but suffered his 3rd loss for the Renegades.

DINKY DONUTS: RHP **Joshua Cornielly** (3.0 IP), RHP **Dylan Tebrake** (2.1), LHP **Eli Ankeney** (1.2), and RHP **Wilkin Ramos** (2.0) combined on a 4-hit shutout in Brooklyn's 2-0 win vs. Hudson Valley on Saturday evening...That marked the Cyclones' 1st donut of an opponent since a 5-0 victory at Aberdeen last Saturday...RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7.0 IP) and Tebrake (2.0) united on a 4-hit blanking of the IronBirds...It was also the Cyclones second shutout of Hudson Valley this season...RHP **Tyler Stuart** (6.1 IP) and RHP **Jace Beck** (0.2) picked up 4-hitter in Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 21...The 'Clones have accumulated 6 shutouts through the first 67 games of 2023...Brooklyn pitching tallied 7 shutouts throughout the entirety of the 2022 campaign.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: LHP **José Quintana** and RHP **Elieser Hernández** both join the Cyclones on Major League rehab assignments this Sunday...Quintana made 2 appearances (1 start) in the Florida State League, allowing 2 unearned runs on 4 hits with 4 strikeouts over 4.2 innings...Quintana has made 315 Major League appearances (289 starts) over an 11-year career with the Chicago White Sox, Chicago Cubs, Los Angeles Angels, San Francisco Giants, Pittsburgh Pirates, and St. Louis Cardinals...The left-hander was named a 2016 American League All-Star with the White Sox...Quintana signed a 2-year contract with New York back on December 9...He was placed on the 15-day injured list on March 30 (retro 3/27) with a left rib fracture...Quintana was transferred to the 60-day IL on April 11...Hernández made 3 rehab starts with St. Lucie, tossing 31 shutout and hitless innings, walking 1 and striking out 4...The 28-year-old has pitched in 90 MLB games (48 starts) over 5 seasons with the Miami Marlins...Hernández was acquired by New York with RHP **Jeff Brigham** for minor league RHP **Franklin Sánchez** and OF **Jake Mangum** on November 18, 2022.

BULLS ON PARADA: C **Kevin Parada** has picked up the pace offensively over the last few weeks...Dating back to June 6 vs. Greenville, the 21-year-old is slashing .339/.391/.610 with a 1.001 OPS and 169 wRC+ in 15 games...Parada has accrued 8 runs scored, 2 triples, 4 home runs, 12 RBI, 4 walks, and a hit-by-pitch...Additionally, the Pasadena, Calif. native enters Sunday on a 7-game hitting streak (12-for-28; 429) and an 12-game on-base streak (.348/.412/.630)...The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket enters Sunday tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in doubles (14), tied for 7th in extra-base hits (24), 8th in total bases (103), tied for 8th in hits (62), and tied for 8th in total bases (100).

A-RAM IT: OF **Alex Ramírez** worked another walk on Saturday vs. Hudson Valley...In the month of June, the 20-year-old is tied for 2nd in the South Atlantic League in runs scored (15), and tied for 3rd in walks (16)...Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Sunday, the Dominican native is 3rd in franchise history in RBI (65) and is 4 behind INF **José Peroza** (69) for the all-time mark...He is also 4th in hits (118), 4th in total bases (176), and 6th in doubles (26).

RELIEF READY: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Sunday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.12) in the entire South Atlantic League and among all High-A teams...The Twins' High-A Cedar Rapids is 2nd (3.22) in the classification, while Hudson Valley (3.33) is 2nd in the circuit...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and 2nd best in all of MiLB...Kansas City's Single-A Columbia leads MiLB (3.00).

DYLAN THROWS HOT FIRE: RHP **Dylan Tebrake** has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 11 relief appearances...Tebrake has a 0.95 ERA (2 ER in 19.0 IP) on 7 hits and 9 walks, registering 28 strikeouts (13.26 K/9)...That equates to a 38.4 K% (28/73).

WILKIN'S WAY: RHP **Wilkin Ramos** has been exquisite in relief for the Cyclones in 2023...Over his last 4 outings, Ramos has not permitted a run over 9.1 innings, earning a save and allowing only 3 hits, 4 walks, and striking out 9...For the season, the right-hander is averaging 10.29 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 28.6% strikeout rate with a 11.4% walk rate.

HOMER HAPPY: On Friday night, the Cyclones set a team season-high with 4 home runs vs. Hudson Valley...Brooklyn's previous high water mark was 3 on June 13 at Aberdeen...It was the first time the 'Clones had clubbed at least 4 home runs in a single game since July 31, 2022, at Hudson Valley...RF **Alex Ramírez** homered twice on a solo shot in the 4th and a 2-run blast in the 6th...C **José Mena** and 1B **Joe Suozzi** went back-to-back in the 7th...Brooklyn's 3-home run 3rd inning on Friday was also the first for the franchise since the team smashed a trio in the top of the 5th on July 27, 2021, at Jersey Shore...DH **Edgardo Fermin** (2-run) and SS **Ronny Mauricio** went back-to-back before 2B **Luis González** added a 2-run shot of his own later in the frame...Friday also marked the first time the Cyclones have poked 4+ home runs at Maimonides Park since a 5-homer barrage on September 18, 2021, vs. Jersey Shore...CF **Jaylen Palmer**, C **Oscar Campos**, 2B **Luke Ritter**, DH **Francisco Álvarez**, and 1B **Wilmer Reyes** all went deep.

TOUCH 'EM ALL: C **Kevin Parada** capped his first career multi-home run game with a 2-run inside-the-park home run in the 6th inning of Friday's win vs. Hudson Valley...It was the first inside-the-park home run by a Cyclones player since Minor League Baseball's stat portal began in the 2005 season...The first one in franchise history was clubbed by **Joe Giannetti** on July 19, 2001.

BLADE RUNNER: RHP **Blade Tidwell** is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 22-year-old has tossed consecutive quality starts dating back to last Saturday at Aberdeen...Tidwell has earned the win in both outings, permitting just 1 run on 7 hits over 13.0 innings...He has walked 4 and struck out 15 in those contests...He tied a career-best with 10 strikeouts on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 7 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 4-0 with a 1.35 ERA (5 ER in 33.1 IP) with just 17 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 24 and struck out 48 (12.96 K/9)...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 35.0% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .150 batting average (17-113) against him...Tidwell leads the South Atlantic League in batting average against (.150) and is 2nd in ERA (1.35) and strikeouts (48) since that date (min. 30.0 IP)...On the season, the Loretto, Tenn. native is 9th in the SAL in punch outs (75).

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn returns home to open up a 12-game homestand, starting with 6 contests against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades possess 3 of new York's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: OF **Spencer Jones** (7), RHP **Drew Thorpe** (8), and C **Antonio Gómez** (29)...Brooklyn and Aberdeen are meeting at Maimonides Park for the first time in 2023...Brooklyn captured the first series at Heritage Financial Park from May 16-21...The Cyclones went 4-2 in the set, taking 4-straight games from May 17 until Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 21...The Cyclones are 132-138 (.489) all-time against the Renegades dating back to their inaugural season in 2001.

POWER OF PAUL: RHP **Paul Gervase** garnered a career-high 6 strikeouts over 3.0 spotless innings of relief on June 9 vs. Greenville and has tossed 5-straight scoreless outings since that date (9.0 IP)...Among South Atlantic League relief pitchers with at least 25.0 innings pitched in 2023, Gervase has the league's lowest ERA (1.17)...Gervase averages 13.79 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 34.3% strikeout rate.

STU-PEUDOUS: RHP **Tyler Stuart** set career-highs in innings pitched (7.2) and strikeouts (11), earning his 2nd win of the year on Thursday night vs. Hudson Valley...The 23-year-old is the first Cyclone to record 11+ strikeouts in a single game since RHP **Carson Seymour** accomplished the feat on July 15, 2022, vs. Greensboro...Stuart is also the first Brooklyn arm to work into the 8th inning since RHP **Conner Grey** tossed 8.1 innings vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...The Southern Miss alum is the first Cyclone to work 7.0+ innings and record 10+ strikeouts in a single game since LHP **Kevin Canelon** whiffed 10 over 8.0 frames at Hudson Valley on August 25, 2015...Stuart leads all qualifiers in the SAL, High-A, and all of Minor League Baseball in ERA (1.44)...The Kankakee, Ill. native leads the league in LOB% (89.5%) and FIP (2.88), 2nd in xFIP (3.18), 3rd in strikeout rate (31.0%), 4th in WHIP (1.09), 5th in batting average against (.209) and strikeouts per 9 innings (11.20), tied for 5th in strikeouts (78), and 6th in innings pitched (62.2).

GARCÍA LATER: RHP **Benito García** has come into his own in Brooklyn's bullpen over the last few weeks...The 23-year-old tossed 11 innings of scoreless relief on Thursday and has not allowed a run over his last 4 appearances dating back to June 9...In that span, García has allowed just 5 hits in 5.1 innings with no walks and 5 strikeouts...Benito also accrued his first save with the franchise on June 14 at Aberdeen...Since returning from Single-A St. Lucie on May 30, García holds a 1.17 ERA (1 ER in 7.2 IP) and 6 strikeouts in 6 relief outings.

OH YEAH, OMAR: OF **Omar De Los Santos** has added 26 stolen bases in 2023 and remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 95 stolen bases in that span, which is 6th most in MiLB...Only Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (103), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (103), D'Backs prospect OF **Wilderd Patiño** (99), Mariners farmhand OF **Jonathan Clase** (97) and Red Sox INF **David Hamilton** (97) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 55 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 41...Omar is already 6 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin's** franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

YO-JOANDER: RHP **Joander Suárez** continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...The 23-year-old set a new-career-high with 6+ innings of work in Tuesday's defeat...Suárez allowed just 1 run on 2 hits, walking 3 and striking out a season-high-matching 8...His 91 pitches also set a career-high...Over his last 2 starts, Suárez has a 1-1 record and a 3.27 ERA (4 ER in 11.0 IP)...The Cumaná, Venezuela native has punched out 16 and walked 6, allowing just 6 hits...Suárez holds a rate of 13.09 strikeouts-per-9-innings and a strikeout rate of 35.6% (16/45) in that span.

DOWN TO THE WIRE: DH **Kevin Parada** delivered Brooklyn's 5th walk-off victory of 2023 with a bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 9th on June 7 vs. Greenville...C **José Mena** added game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on May 26...1B **Chase Estep** delivered a game-ending, bases-loaded walk in the 11th on Opening Day vs. Jersey Shore...LF **Alex Ramírez** registered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF **Omar De Los Santos** provided a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year...Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaign...In addition to 5 walk-off wins, the Cyclones have suffered 9 walk-off defeats after last Friday's loss at Aberdeen...20.9% (14-of-67) of Brooklyn's games this season have ended in walk-off fashion, including 24.3% (9-of-37) of all defeats and 42.9% (9-of-21) of road losses...37.3% (25-of-67) have been determined by just 1 run.

CROWN PRINCE OF CONEY ISLAND: IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Sunday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (199), at-bats (652), plate appearances (780), runs scored (100), walks (107), and stolen bases (48)...Palmer passed INF **Ronny Mauricio** '21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (68) on May 23 and is 1 behind INF **José Peroza** (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (201), tied for 3rd in home runs (17), and 5th in hits (117).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects last week...6 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C **Kevin Parada** (No. 2), OF **Alex Ramírez** (5), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (15), RHP **Christian Scott** (16), and RHP **Tyler Stuart** (18)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 1), RHP **Mike Vasil** (4), OF **Matt Rudick** (13), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (14), RHP **Junior Santos** (19), RHP **José Butto** (23), RHP **Luis Montas** (24), OF **Rowdy Jordan** (25), and RHP **Matt Allan** (30)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his 2nd rehab appearance out of the bullpen for Single-A St. Lucie last Sunday at Palm Beach...Entered in relief of RHP **Sean Reid-Foley** with the game scoreless after the game was suspended on Saturday...Allowed 2 unearned runs on 2 hits over 3.1 innings...Did not walk a batter and struck out 4...Charged with a balk and induced a double play...Tossed 46 pitches and 30 strikes (65.2%)...Relieved by RHP **Eric Foggo** with the bases empty and 1 out in the bottom of the 5th and the game tied at 2...Mets scored a run in the 8th to defeat the Cardinals, 3-2.

MAJOR LEAGUE REHAB: Quintana joined the Cyclones when his Major League rehab assignment was transferred from Single-A St. Lucie on Sunday...The 34-year-old made 2 appearances (1 start) with the club, permitting 2 unearned runs on 4 hits over 4.2 innings...Quintana was placed on the Mets' 15-day injured list on March 30 (retro 3/27) with a left rib fracture...He was transferred to the 60-day IL on April 11 before starting his tenure in St. Lucie on June 13.

2022: Quintana split his Major League season with Pittsburgh and St. Louis...The left-hander started the year with the Pirates, making 20 starts and registering a 3-5 record plus a 3.50 ERA (40 ER in 103.0 IP) with 89 strikeouts...Traded to the Cardinals on August 1 with RHP **Chris Stratton** for RHP **Johan Oviedo** and 3B **Malcolm Núñez**...Tallied a 3-2 mark with a 2.01 ERA (14 ER in 62.2 IP) and 48 K's in 12 starts for St. Louis...Started Game 1 of the NL Wild Card Series vs. Philadelphia...Took a no-decision after tossing 5.1 scoreless, 2-hit innings.

SHINING STAR: Quintana was named an American League All-Star in 2016 with the Chicago White Sox...The southpaw compiled a 13-12 mark with the Pale Hose that season, accruing a 3.20 ERA (74 ER in 208.0 IP) with 181 strikeouts...Quintana finished 10th in the AL Cy Young Award voting in that campaign.

REMEMBER ME?: Quintana made his professional debut after signing with the New York Mets as an international free agent on April 26, 2006...Pitched 1 season in the Venezuelan Summer League...Went 0-1 with an 8.44 ERA (5 ER in 5.1 IP) and 5 K's in 3 relief appearances...Released by the organization on July 31, 2007.

NEW TEAM? NEW PROBLEM: The left-hander struck out 10 hitters in his final start for the Chicago White Sox on July 8, 2017, and punched out 12 in his first start for the Chicago Cubs on July 16, 2017, following a trade...He joined LHP **Randy Johnson** (Seattle and Houston) as the only pitchers in Major League history to record consecutive double-digit strikeout games for separate teams.
