Don't miss Dermis: INF Dermis Garcia has hit safely in four straight contests, a new season-high. Over the streak, Garcia has two home runs with four RBI and is hitting .286 with a .353 on-base percentage. Garcia led the Florida State League with 17 home runs in 2019.

Where's Oswaldo?: Oswaldo Cabrera has reached base safely in each of the first 12 games of the Somerset season, including multiple times in three of the team's last four games. The versatile infielder went 7-for-22 (.318) with a home run, three RBI, four walks and a team-best .423 OBP in the series against New Hampshire.

Hits and Misses: The Patriots pitching staff has struck out double digit batters in nine of 12 contests this season, including five of six games in their last series against New Hampshire. Five different pitchers combined to strike out 18 Saturday night, a new season-high and just two off a franchise record (20, 7/8/18 vs. Road Warriors).

How About Hartford: The Patriots take on the Hartford Yard Goats for the first time in franchise history tonight. The Yard Goats sit in third place in the Northeast Division with a 5-7 record and sit two games behind Somerset and Portland. Hartford has won three straight coming into the contest and lead all of Double-A with 27 doubles.

Speed Demons: The Patriots have stolen 16 bases as a team so far this season, more than any other club in the Double-A Northeast League. It's tied for the second-most steals of any Double-A club in the country (19, Northwest Arkansas).

Leading Off: Eight of the 12 home runs that Somerset has hit as a team this year have been to lead off an inning, including Oswaldo Cabrera's 8th inning blast on Saturday night.

Weissert for Dessert: RHP Greg Weissert earned his first save of the season Saturday night. The righty features a slider ranked by Baseball America as the best in the Yankees organization and now has 10 strikeouts over his first 5.2 innings of the year.
