RAMIREZ HOMERS IN JUMBO SHRIMP 6-4 WIN

Agustín Ramirez homered and had a three-hit effort for the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp in their 6-4 win over the Toledo Mud Hens Wednesday night. Jacksonville (52-56, 17-16) sent nine men to the plate in the top of the sixth inning, taking the final lead of the night. Deyvison De Los Santos and Tristan Gray singled to start the inning. Ramirez doubled, scoring De Los Santos to tie the game at four. With runners on second and third, Gray scored on a ground out from Javier Sanoja and Griffin Conine singled home Ramirez to put the Jumbo Shrimp ahead 6-4.

ROCKET MAN

At just 21 years old, **Deyvison De Los Santos** has had a monstrous 2024 season between Jacksonville, Triple-A Reno and Double-A Amarillo. Currently, De Los Santos leads all of full season MiLB in home runs (31), RBIs (90) and slugging (.630). He ranks second in both total bases (237) and OPS (1.011), sixth in hits (121) and fourth in extra-base hits (52). Of the top 100 exit velos in the minors in 2024, the Dominican has hit four of them, trailing **Jhonkensy Noel** (6x), **Orelvis Martinez** (6x) and **Pedro León** (5x).

IT'S TEARIN' UP MY START WHEN I'M WITH YOU

In 2005, Jacksonville starting pitchers ranked just 25th in Double-A with 741.0 innings, which represented 60.6 percent of the club's 1223.2 innings. This season, the Jumbo Shrimp's starting rotation has worked 51.2 percent of the club's innings, a total of 482.0 out of 940.2 frames. That figure is the ninth-most in Triple-A. Jacksonville lid-lifters are ranked third in ERA (4.65) while ranking tied for fourth in WHIP (1.40), eighth in BAA (.259), 11th in OPS against (.783) and ninth in walks (194).

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled this season at 121 Financial Ballpark, mustering a meager 24-32 (.429) record. Jacksonville has scored only 236 runs at home (4.2 per game), second-fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are scoring more than a half-run more per game on the road, totaling 247 (4.8 per game). Meanwhile, on the road, Jacksonville has surrendered only 227 runs (4.4 per game), the second-fewest in Triple-A. They've yielded the 12th-fewest runs of any team at home (5.0 per game).

GET PITCH OR DIE TRYIN'

Jacksonville has gone 27-21 (.563) in their last 48 contests, mainly behind some dominant pitching and defense. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp have ceded four runs or fewer in 30 of those 48 affairs (62.5 percent). Since this run began on June 7, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A in fewest runs allowed (197) and ERA (3.91) while ranking third in WHIP (1.37), fourth in BAA (.247), sixth in OPS against (.741) and fourth in hits allowed (385), respectively.

SOULJA TROY

Heading into play on May 25, **Troy Johnston**, the reigning Marlins Minor League Player of the Year, was hitting just .240/.294/.316/.610 with only 12 doubles, one home run, 21 RBIs, nine walks and 16 runs scored in 48 games. However, over the last 59 contests, the Puyallup, Wash., native is a sizzling 69-for-222, slashing .311/.378/.495/.873 with 14 doubles, three triples, seven homers, 30 RBIs, 21 walks and 39 runs scored. Johnston has 18 multi-hit games in his last 40 contests and is ranked second in the IL in hits (116) while also ranking third in doubles (26) and 24th in batting average (.278).

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 64 of his last 75 games, notching 26 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 93-for-293 (.317/.386/.478/.864) with 21 doubles, four triples, six home runs, 43 RBIs, 34 walks and 39 runs scored. On the season, Sanoja ranks sixth in batting average (.298), tied for seventh in doubles (23) and ranked 10th in hits (99).

SHRIMP BITES

The Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in 12 of the last 15 games after doing so just three times in the previous 10 contests... Will Banfield is batting .342/.384/.605/.989 with four doubles, five home runs, 15 RBIs, six walks and 17 runs scored in his last 22 games... Jacksonville has dropped six of their last nine games. This stretch comes on the heels of seven victories in eight contests.
