CAREER NOTES

2025: Assigned to Altoona to begin the season... Did not walk a batter in his Double-A debut vs. Chesapeake, walked at least one batter in 23-of-25 starts in 2024 at Greensboro... Allowed 2 HR to Somerset's Spencer Jones on 4/17, 3rd time in his career he allowed 2 HR to same player in same start (last 6/1/24 @ Ashville, Brice Matthews)... Lasted only 8 batters on 4/29 vs Akron before 1:48 rain delay ended his outing...

2024: Spent the entire season in the rotation for High-A Greensboro... Tied for the lead among all Pirates farmhands in starts and ranked among leaders in wins (2nd), strikeouts (6th), innings pitched (6th) and batting average against (.242, 9th)... Also tied for the South Atlantic League lead in wins and ranked among league leaders in starts (2nd), batting average against (5th) and innings pitched (7th)... Was unscored upon in his first three outings of the season, allowed just two runs in four outings in April (1.17 ERA)... Recorded a 4.97 ERA in June, his lowest ERA in a calendar month besides April... Tossed at least 5.0 innings in six of his final 11 outings of the season... Held opponents to a .172 BAA in the first inning of outings...

2023: Spent the entire season in Bradenton's rotation... Was named the Florida State League's Pitcher of the Month for July afer posting a 0.35 ERA (25.2ip/1er) across five appearances (four starts), including a 13.0-inning scoreless streak to start the month...
