NOTES AND NUGGETS

THE LIGHT SIDE & THE DARK SIDE

Yesterday, the Storm Chasers snapped a season-long 7-game losing streak and won their first game of the season against Louisville.

- After suffering a season-opening weekend sweep in Louisville and starting the season 0-4, the Storm Chasers won 3 straight series against Buffalo, Iowa and Indianapolis ... Omaha won 12 of 17 games between April 1 and 21, before dropping the subsequent 7, April 22 to 29.
- The 7-game losing streak was the longest for a Triple-A team this year and Omaha's longest since a 10-game stretch from August 27 to September 7, 2025.
- Yesterday's win gave Omaha a winning month of April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... last year, Omaha had one winning month, going 15-11 in August ... Omaha last finished above .500 in April in 2024, when the team went 12-9.

HYPERSPACE SPEED

Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by one of the league's best baserunners.

- Omaha's 85.4% stolen base rate (35-for-41) ranks 1st at the Triple-A level and 13th among the 120 full-season Minor League teams.
- John Rave** leads Omaha and is tied 6th in the International League in steals (10), while **Gavin Cross** ranks 2nd on Omaha with 7 stolen bases ... Rave and Cross are 2 of 5 Storm Chasers who have stolen multiple bases without being caught.

JEDI-LEVEL DEFENSE

The Storm Chasers are tied for the 4th-best fielding percentage in the International League (1st: Rochester & Louisville, .986) with a .981 mark, committing just 19 errors in 29 games.

- The clean play extends throughout the roster – of Omaha's 14 qualified fielders (min. 50.0 inn.), 7 have a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage, led by **Kevin Newman** in the infield (174.0 innings) and **Kameron Misner** in the outfield (207.1 innings).
- Omaha's 34 double plays turned are the most of any Minor League team ... 4 Storm Chasers infielders have participated in 10 or more double plays, led by **Abraham Toro's** 22, the 2nd-most of any Minor League player.

PATIENCE YOU MUST HAVE

A constant in 2026 has been Omaha's ability to go deep in plate appearances.

- The Storm Chasers are seeing 4.049 pitches per plate appearance, 3rd-most in the International League and 6th at the Triple-A level.
- Among 329 Triple-A players with 50+ plate appearances this year, **Kameron Misner** ranks 3rd in pitches seen/PA (4.566) while **John Rave** ranks 7th (4.513).

TRUST THE FORCE

The Omaha Storm Chasers are one of the better Triple-A teams at converting A/B/S challenges in 2026.

- Omaha's 59% win rate on challenges ranks tied 4th at the Triple-A level ... 44 successful challenges rank as the 5th-most in Triple-A ... the Chasers are 2-for-8 in challenges over their last 7 games, after averaging 3.05 challenges/game over the first 22 games of the year.
- Omaha's pitchers and catchers have challenged at a 3.0% rate (tied 4th-highest in Triple-A), with 7 strikeout flips and 5 walk flips tied 4th and 5th-most in Triple-A ... the defense has won 29 of 46 challenges, a 63% success rate (tied 8th-highest in Triple-A).
- At the plate, Omaha hitters have converted 15 of 29 challenges (52%, tied 8th in Triple-A) ... 8 strikeout flips from the hitters are tied for 2nd-most in Triple-A.
- This week, the best challenging team in Triple-A comes to Werner Park ... Louisville's 66% success rate (52-for-79) is the best at the level, with a 64.63% success rate (26-for-42) from the hitters tied 1st in Triple-A and 68% success rate (25-for-37) from the fielders 4th in Triple-A.

A NEW HOPE

Yesterday's walk-off win was Omaha's first walk-off victory of the season and the team's first true comeback victory of the year.

- Prior to last night, the Storm Chasers had not won a game when trailing at any point after the 3rd inning ... yesterday, Omaha trailed for 6 1/2 innings and had to overcome 3 separate deficits, although never greater than a 2-run deficit ... it was the 5th game Omaha won after trailing at any point, with 4 previous victories were the team had trailed by 1 or 2 runs within the first two innings of the game.
- Yesterday was the 82nd walk-off in the 15-season history of Werner Park ... it was Omaha's 4th walk-off winner against Louisville, with 3 of the 4 coming in April games ... it was **Drew Waters'** first walk-off hit as a Storm Chaser.

- ♣ Mitch Spence is making his **3rd start with the Storm Chasers** this year and his **4th overall appearance** of the season.
- ♣ Playing his **7th professional season** this year ... the Royals are his 3rd Major League organization, after being drafted by the Yankees and spending the last two years with the Athletics.

A NEW SPENCE OF PURPOSE

- ♣ **MAKING SOME SPENCE:** This is just Spence's 4th game this season ... his first outing of the year came in Omaha's 8th game, working 5.0 innings with just 1 unearned run allowed ... he was recalled by the Royals on April 9, but did not get in a game for over a week, pitching in a long relief/mop-up role on April 18 ... was optioned back to Omaha on Sunday, April 19.
- ♣ **START ME UP:** Spence bounced between the rotation and bullpen in the A's organization the last two years ... he almost exclusively started with the Yankees in the Minors between **2021** and **2023** ... his first month and a half of **2024** with the Athletics came as a reliever before moving to the rotation in June ... he again opened **2025** in the A's bullpen before moving to the rotation in June ... he remained a starting pitcher after he was optioned to Triple-A last year, but 2 of 3 MLB outings in September were in relief.

LAST OUTING: SATURDAY, APRIL 25 @ TOLEDO

- ♣ Opened his second Triple-A start with 2.0 scoreless innings, retiring 6 of his first 7 batters, including a 1-2-3 inning in the 2nd ... allowed a double and a walk in the 3rd, then a 2-run double from **Gage Workman** plated the only runs of the game ... worked another 1-2-3 inning in the 4th, then loaded the bases with 2 walks and an error in the 5th but stranded the bases loaded to end his night.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- ♣ Was designated for assignment by the Athletics on February 10 and traded to Kansas City on February 12 in exchange for RHP **A.J. Causey**.
- ♣ Appeared in 3 Cactus League games for the Royals, pitching to a 10.29 ERA (8 ER in 7.0 IP) with 11 hits allowed and 2 strikeouts ... optioned to Omaha on March 18.

CAREER NOTES

- ♣ Spent much of the year in the Major Leagues with the Athletics, splitting time as a starter and reliever ... made the A's Opening Day roster for the second straight year and opened the season as a reliever, making 22 relief appearances with a 4.38 ERA (19 ER in 39.0 IP) and 37 strikeouts before June 2.
- ♣ Made his first start of the year June 5 and worked a 1.20 ERA (2 ER in 15.0 IP) in his first three games as a starter ... optioned to Triple-A Las Vegas on July 10 and pitched in 8 games (7 starts) before the Athletics recalled him on September 10 for the remainder of the season.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- ♣ Was the 1st overall pick by the Athletics in the Rule 5 Draft on December 6, **2023** ... spent all of **2024** in the Major Leagues with Oakland and posted a 4.58 ERA (77 ER in 151.1 IP) with an 8-10 record and 126 strikeouts to 44 walks (2.86 K/BB) across 35 games (24 starts).
- ♣ Pitched part of **2022** and all **2023** in with the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders (AAA) in the Yankees organization, producing an 11-10 record with a 4.33 ERA (103 ER in 214.1 IP) and 201 strikeouts to 69 walks (2.91 K/BB) across 39 Triple-A starts.
- ♣ In **2023**, led the minors with 163.0 innings ... also ranked 3rd in MiLB in pitches (2,564) and tied for 3rd in starts (29) ... led the International League in innings and starts and ranked 2nd in strikeouts (153).
- ♣ Opened **2022** with the Somerset Patriots (AA) and pitched in 17 games (15 starts) before his promotion to Triple-A on August 2 ... spent all of **2021** with the Hudson Valley Renegades (A+) and put up a 3.94 ERA (46 ER in 105.0 IP) with 118 strikeouts to 37 walks (3.19 K/BB) in 23 games (20 starts) at High-A.
- ♣ Made his professional debut in **2019** with the Pulaski Yankees (R) after New York drafted him in the 10th round of the 2019 MLB Draft ... pitched exclusively out of the bullpen and earned 4 saves.

- ♣ Pitched 3 seasons (**2017-19**) for the University of South Carolina-Aiken (Peach Belt Conference, D2) ... worked a career 17-10 record with a 3.83 ERA (86 ER in 202.0 IP) and 243 strikeouts (10.8 K/9) for the Pacers ... in **2018**, struck out 117 batters in 92.0 innings (11.4 K/9) with a 3.03 ERA (31 ER in 92.0 IP).
