LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox dropped their third game of the series to the Somerset Patriots by a final of 6-2 on Saturday night. The Baysox collected only four hits on the night and went 1-for-7 with runners in scoring position. Somerset jumped out to a 4-1 lead but Bowie closed the deficit to two in the top of the sixth on Samuel Basallo's eighth homer of the season. Spencer Jones tacked on two more runs in the bottom of the sixth with a two-run single and Blane Abeyta pitched six strong innings to help Somerset take the series lead.

BASALLO IS HOT

C Samuel Basallo blasted his eighth homer of the season last night with an opposite field solo shot in the sixth. The Orioles No. 2 prospect is tied with Jud Fabian for the team-lead in homers and tied for fifth in all of the Eastern League. Basallo led Baysox hitters with a .297 AVG in the month of May. His OBP jumped from .276 in April to .373 OBP in May. Over his last 10 games, the 19-year-old is batting .395 (15-for-38) with three homers, two doubles, 10 RBI and an OPS of 1.149.

IT'S BECAUSE THEY GET ON BASE

C Samuel Basallo is on a 10 game on-base streak, which is one game shy of matching his season-long on-base streak of 11 games from April 28 - May 12....IF Collin Burns is on a seven game on base streak, the second longest active streak on the team behind Basallo. Burns is batting .313 over his last five games....IF Anthony Servideo is on a six-game on base streak. Servideo is batting .333 over his last five games.

BUILT BY THE BULLPEN

Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings pitched (238.0) and strikeouts (286). Conversely, Bowie's starters have thrown the fewest number of innings in the league and in all of Double-A (190.2). The bullpen has accounted for 22 of Bowie's 24 wins on the regular season, the most in all of Double-A. The Baysox bullpen owns a 1.21 WHIP, which is good for sixth-lowest in Double-A.

KISSING MAY GOODBYE

After batting a league-best .256 in the month of April, Bowie batted a league-worst .214 in the month of May. Bowie scored the most runs in the league in the month of April (118) but scored the fourth-fewest runs (111) in the month of May. The Baysox also struck out the most times in the month (271).

BRNO ON THE BUMP

RHP Kyle Brnovich makes his fifth start and his 10th appearance of the year. Brnovich recorded the win on Tuesday against Somerset, his first start in over a month, after throwing five innings of one-run ball with three strikeouts. Before the start, the 26-year-old had been used as a long reliever for his previous five outings. The Cincinnati, Oh. native makes his fifth career start against the Patriots. In five career starts vs Somerset, Brnovich has an ERA of 5.76.

PREVIEWING THE PATRIOTS

Entering this week, the Somerset Patriots are fourth in the Northeast Division at 22-23. The Double-A affiliate of the Yankees most recently took three of seven at New Hampshire but have won two of their last three. Nine of the Yankees' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- OF Spencer Jones (No. 2), LHP Brock Selvidge (No. 10), C/1B Ben Rice (No. 12), C Agustin Ramirez (No. 20), RHP Zach Messinger (No. 21), RHP Trystan Vrieling (No. 22), RHP Jack Neely (No. 24), RHP Danny Watson (No. 27), and IF Benjamin Cowles (No. 29).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Brock Selvidge makes his 10th start of the season and his second against Bowie this week. The Yankees No. 10 prospect is coming off his shortest outing of the year where he lasted just 3.2 innings and allowed four runs (three earned) on four hits to receive the loss. After 1.71 ERA in the month of April, Selvidge ended the month of May with a 4.73 ERA in large part because of walks (16 walks in 26.2 innings). The southpaw was drafted in the 3rd round of the 2021 Draft out of Hamilton HS (AZ).

2023: Began season with FCL Orioles on a rehab assignment after recovering from Tommy John surgery. Made four rehab appearances between FCL Orioles, Single-A Delmarva and High-A Aberdeen before being sent to Double-A Bowie on July 25. Made four appearances (two starts) with Baysox and posted a 7.71 ERA in 14 innings, struck out 19 and gave up five homers.

2022: Began season with Triple-A Norfolk. Made two four-inning starts in April before suffering a right elbow injury. Underwent successful Tommy John surgery in May and missed rest of the season.

2021: Began first full season in Orioles system after trade. Started year in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 48 batters over 34.1 innings to an ERA of 2.36. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on June 22. Went five innings in six of his 11 starts and finished season with 75 K over 60.2 IP and an ERA of 3.86.

2019: Did not pitch a game while in LAA organization. Traded to BAL on Dec. 4, 2019, along with RHP Kyle Bradish, RHP Zach Peek, and RHP Isaac Mattson for RHP Dylan Bundy.

Personal: Drafted in the 8th round of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Los Angeles Angels out of Elon University. Pitched three seasons at Elon and was named a Consensus All-American in 2018. Struck out 360 batters in 281 career collegiate innings.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
