THE SURGE - The Wichita Wind Surge and Northwest Arkansas Naturals will meet tonight in the fifth game of a six game set, the series has the Naturals leading three games to one. Wichita has dropped eight of ten in the current 12 game home series. The team has dropped 31 of its last 38 games. The team has dropped seven consecutive series and have the fewest wins in all of Minor League Baseball (Asheville, 29 wins). Wichita is 15-45 since April 30th.

VS NATURALS - The Wind Surge host the KC Royals affiliate. The teams met in April and the 2026 season series has the Naturals lead 8-5. NWA won two of three in Wichita opening weekend. In 2025 Wichita went 10-8 vs the Naturals and 3-3 at home. The all-time series is even at 60. The Naturals did defeat Wichita for the AA Central Championship Series in 2021.

OVER 'N OUT - Wichita is second in the Texas League with 118 long balls this season 21 of 25 players have hit HR and 6 players with double digit bombs this year 73 have been solo shots..

ON THE BUMP: Preston Johnson will make his ninth start of the season and appear in his 12th game of the season. In his last start he pitched four innings and allowed one run on three hits in a no- decision vs NWA. The five inning start on July 2nd was his season long in a no decision vs Tulsa.

NATURALS MAKE IT THREE IN A ROW - The Wichita Wind Surge (3-13) dropped game four of a six-game series to the Northwest Arkansas Naturals (6-10), 8-1, on Friday night at Equity Bank Park despite a strong start from Cory Lewis, who allowed just one earned run over four innings while striking out four. The Wind Surge managed just one run on five hits, but Caden Kendle continued his hot start with Wichita, going 2-for-4 with an RBI. Kendle has collected eight hits and driven in five runs through his first four Double-A games. Marek Houston extended his on-base streak to 10 games despite seeing his nine-game hitting streak come to an end. Wichita's pitching staff allowed eight runs on 10 hits and issued six walks. Lewis surrendered just one earned run on two hits over four innings before Kyle Bischoff added his 14th scoreless relief appearance of the season in the loss.

LIGHT UP THE KINDLE- Caden Kendle has recorded a hit in each of his first four Double-A games, has driven in five runs through his first four games with Wichita and has recorded three multi-hit games in his first four games with the Wind Surge.

A FINE PLACE TO VACATION- Jaime Ferrer extended his on-base streak to nine games.

THE FUTURE! A pair of former Wind Surge players will be represented in the upcoming MLB Futures Game! Kaelen Culpepper and Walker Jenkins. The pair are currently playing for Class AAA St Paul.

HOUSTON, WE HAVE LIFT OFF - Marek Houston hitting streak ended at nine games, but has reached base in 10 consecutive. He has had a hit in 13 of his first 15 Double-A games.

ICT NOTES -Wichita has dropped six straight Saturday games, 4-9 on the day..... The team is 0-16 when allowing double digit runs, NWA is 0-18. The teams 14 home wins are the fewest in all of MiLB. 25 of the 28 wins the team have scored five or more runs. The Surge are 7-11 in one run games. Wichita is last in the league in batting average, 4th in walks, 1st HBP, and 9th in ERA, allowed most hits in all of AA. The team has 69 errors, 9th in the league.

RUNNING WITH THE BULLS - Garrett Spain extended his on-base streak to 12 games, recorded his 16th multi-hit game of the season. He hit his 14th home run of the season on Wednesday and recorded multi-hit performances in three consecutive games and matched a season high with three hits.

AMICKS AMBUSH - Billy Amick extended his on-base streak to nine games. He leads the team with 20 home runs and 59RBI. 20 HR is third in Texas League and 59 RBI is sixth in the league, 9th in runs scored. He leads the Twins Organization in HR and RBI.

PHILADELPHIA FREEDOM- Andrew Cossetti has hit five home runs in this homestand and matched his career high with 14 home runs in a season. In June he hit 6HR, 20RBI and a .379 OBP. Has hit two grand slams this season, the first two of his career and has belted a pair of multi-homer games. Since May 7, he is batting .251, (39x158) with all 14 homers, 36RBI, and 37 BB and leads the team in all categories.

HARVEST TIME- The Surge have added seven players from Cedar Rapids since June 12. Twins number 10 prospect Riley Quick added today from Cedar Rapids. The team added #21 Khadim Diaw last month, #15 Brandon Winokur earlier this week and #7 prospect Marek Houston last week. Rankings are according to *MLB Pipeline*. Quick made his professional debut in April and this season has made 14 starts, and in 49.1 innings has punched out 74 batters while walking 26 and is 0-2 with a 3.47 ERA.

MID SUMMER CLASSIC - Former Wind Surge pitcher Louie Varland was named to the American League All Star team. It's the second Wind Surge alumni to play as Yennier Cano pitched in the 2023 game.

THE PEN- Wichita relievers have pitched a league leading 423 innings so far this season. An average of 5 plus innings per game. The teams pen has earned the win in 26 of the 28 team wins, the bullpen has a 6.30 ERA last in TL, starters are at 4.82. Surge starters are 2-29, fewest wins in the league.

Q THE STREAK- Quinn McDaniel extended his on-base streak to 17 games.

STRIKE EM OUT! - The Wind Surge have 32 games this season recording double-digit strikeouts. The team has 743 K's seventh most in the league. The Wind Surge hitters lead the league with 853K's.
