FRES-NOTES

DIALING UP DALIS: Wilder Dalis provided the offensive spark in last night's 6-4 loss, going 2-for-4 with a home run — his 8th of the season — continuing what's been a standout July. Dalis is hitting .355 with a 1.091 OPS and 4 home runs in 15 games this month, by far his hottest stretch of the year. It's a notable turnaround against Rancho Cucamonga specifically, a team he'd struggled against earlier in the season — last night's homer was just his second hit of the season series, but it came at a big moment.

RIDING THE WAVE: Dalis isn't alone — Cameron Nelson (.317 AVG, .997 OPS, 5 HR in July) and Carlos Renzullo (.311 AVG, .799 OPS) have both been hot this month as well, and both factored into last night's game: Nelson doubled and drove in a run, while Renzullo added two hits. Fresno's .275 team average in July ranks second among all eight California League clubs this month — a step up from third place in that category for the full season — and this trio has been the driving force behind it.

CLIMBING ON THE MOUND: Fresno's raw ERA has actually ticked up this month (5.67 in July vs. 5.33 for the season), but that number tells only part of the story — offense has spiked league-wide in July, and Fresno's staff has climbed the relative rankings because of it. The Grizzlies now sit third in team ERA for the month, up from fifth for the season overall, trailing only San Jose and Rancho Cucamonga. Easton Marks was a big part of that story last night, following a rocky start from Austin Newton with 4.2 innings of one-run relief to keep the game within reach.

A COMPLETE TEAM EFFORT: Between the bats and the arms, Fresno has genuinely tightened its standing across the board this month — a top-three offense and a top-three pitching staff in July, compared to a more middle-of-the-pack profile for the season as a whole. With Dalis, Nelson, and Renzullo all clicking and the pitching staff trending the right direction relative to the rest of the league, tonight is a real opportunity to turn that improved form into results against Rancho Cucamonga specifically.
