THE RANDY MAN CAN: Tonight's Patriotst starting pitcher Randy Vasquez was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for his efforts in last week's road series @ Altoona. Vasquez started one week ago tonight (5/13) and threw 5.2 scoreless and hitless innings vs. the Curve. He is the 3rd Patriot to win Player of the Week honors this year, as well as the 2nd pitcher (Jhony Brito).

READING REVENGE: After the Patriots won 4 of their first 5 games vs. Reading to start this season, outscoring them 37-18, the Fightins got their revenge on Thursday night with a 12-4 win. The 12 runs are the most allowed by the Patriots pitching staff this year, while the 8-run margin of defeat is the largest they've suffered this year, with the 7 runs allowed in the 8th inning being the most they've surrendered in an inning this year. Logan O'Hoppe homered for a third straight game (4 total this series out of 7 this year).

BURT IS THE WORD: Max Burt enters today on a season high 4-game hit streak, hitting .462 (6-for-13) over that span with 2 HR, 2 2B, 4 RBI, 6 R and 2 SB. Burt has exactly 1 RBI in 4 straight games, with 2 of those RBIs forcing a tie where the Patriots later won the game.

DUNHAM DOING DAMAGE: With hits in all 3 games this series, Elijah Dunham has now hit safely in every game he's played vs. Reading. He's also collected multiple hits in 4/6 games that he has played vs. them this year. He enters today batting a team-best .385 (10-for-26) vs. the Phils, with 6/10 hits having gone for extra bases: HR, 2 3B, 3 2B. His 9 RBI vs. the R-Phils are tied for the most on the team with Josh Breaux.

RUNNING WILD: With 2 more stolen bases on Tuesday, Anthony Volpe has now swiped a bag in 4 straight games, with 6 total over that span. His 17 stolen bases are now tied for first in the Eastern League (POR, David Hamilton). Despite hitting .163 this month (14 games), Volpe has been an elite run manufacturer, with 9 BB, 1 HBP, 10 SB and 9 R. He has more runs, walks and stolen bases this month than he does hits (8).

RHP #8 RANDY VASQUEZ

CAREER: (11-5, 2.73 ERA, 158.1 IP, 185 K, 0.99 WHIP)

- This week, was named Pitcher of the Week for the 3rd time in his career (all over the last year), after throwing 5.2 scoreless and hittless innings in Altoona on 5/13/22. He is the second Patriot (Jhony Brito) to have been awarded Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honors this year.
- Led all qualifying Yankees Minor Leaguers with a 2.52 ERA in 2021. Began 2021 in Single-A Tampa, where he spent the majority of his season. Pitched in 13 games (11 starts), going 3-3 with a 2.34 ERA and 58 strikeouts in 50.0 IP. Earned a promotion to High-A Hudson Valley, where he started six games and went 3-0 with a 1.75 ERA in six starts for the Renegades. He struck out 53 batters in 36.0 innings pitched for Hudson Valley, before earning an August promotion to Somerset. Vasquez ended the season with the Patriots, going 2-1 in 4 GS with a 4.22 ERA.
- In 2019, he spent the entire season with Rookie-level Pulaski, tying for the team lead with 11 starts, where he went 4-1 with a 3.29 ERA. Ranked second on the club in innings pitched (54.2) and strikeouts (53).
- In 2018, split his first professional season between the DSL Yankees and GCL Yankees. Combined to go 1-1 in nine games (seven starts) with a 1.78 ERA over 30.1 innings pitched.
- Signed with the Yankees as an international free agent at 19-years-old for a \$10,000 bonus on 8/2/18. He will be Rule 5 Draft eligible after this season.
- Averages over 3,000 RPMs of spin rate on both his curveball and slider.

COACHING STAFF



DAN FIORITO ★ MANAGER

Born and raised in Yonkers, NY, Dan Fiorito enters his sixth season with the Yankees organization and his first as Somerset's manager. Fiorito is also the Yankees' Roving Upper Level IF/OF Instructor. He served as the manager of High-A Hudson Valley in 2021, after making his managerial debut in 2019 with the GCL Yankees East. Fiorito also had been slated to manage the Yankees' former short-season Single-A affiliate, Staten Island in 2020,

before the minor league season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. He served as the defensive coach at the Yankees' former Single-A Charleston affiliate in 2018, after making his professional coaching debut as defensive coach with the Yankees' former Rookie-level Pulaski affiliate in 2017.

His playing career began when he was signed by the Yankees as a non-drafted free agent in 2012. Over four seasons as an infielder in the Yankees system, he batted .240 (264-for-1102) with 107 runs, 52 doubles, six triples, seven home runs and 98 RBI in 322 career minor league games. Fiorito played three years at Manhattanville College (Purchase, NY) and is a 2008 graduate of Fordham Prep (Bronx, NY).



GERARDO CASADIEGO ★ PITCHING COACH

Gerardo Casadiego will begin his first season in Somerset and 10th in the Yankees organization. He held the same position in Hudson Valley last season, where the Renegade staff ranked second in the High-A East division in strikeouts (1,308, sixth in MiLB) and third in ERA (4.12). The Venezuela native has also previously served as the pitching coach for former Rookie-level Pulaski (2017-2019), DSL Yankees 1 (2014-2015) and DSL Yankees 2 (2016).

JAKE HIRST ★ HITTING COACH

Jacob Hirst will serve as hitting coach in his first season with Somerset and fourth with the Yankees organization. He was the hitting coach for Hudson Valley in 2021, when the Renegades' batters ranked second among High-A East clubs in triples (33) and OBP (.341), third in doubles (217) and fourth in home runs (156), batting average (.255), slugging percentage (.446) and OPS (.787). The Iowa native served the same role with the GCL Yankees West (2019-2020).



AARON BOSSI ★ DEFENSIVE COACH

Aaron Bossi begins his first season with Somerset after making his coaching debut in the same role with Hudson Valley in 2021. His prior experience for the organization was assisting rehabbing players at the minor league complex from 2017-2019. The St. Louis, MO native was signed as a non-drafted free agent by the Yankees on June 24, 2016 as a catcher/infielder. He played in 22 games for the GCL Yankees East in 2016.


